As BOEM prepares for future renewable energy projects offshore the West Coast and Hawaii, we are initiating a proactive outreach initiative with the Department of Energy's National Renewable Energy Laboratory (NREL) to educate both our BOEM OCS Renewable Energy Task Force members and the public on offshore renewable energy technologies best suited for areas on the Pacific Outer Continental Shelf, and the multifaceted complexities of such marine-based energy systems.

The two-day training session will include presentations by experts from NREL on offshore wind and marine hydrokinetic (MHK) technologies and will also include technical expert panel discussions. The first day of the training, August 13, 2013, will focus on offshore wind technology and the second day, August 14, 2013, will focus on MHK technology. Registration will be held from 8:00-8:30 am on both days of the workshop. The workshop sessions will begin at 8:30 am and be adjourned at 5:30 pm on day one and 5:00 pm on day two.
