OCS Study MMS 2008-012

The Minerals Management Service (MMS), Gulf of Mexico OCS Region, announces the availability of a new study report, *Proceedings: Twenty-Fourth Gulf of Mexico Information Transfer Meeting, January 2007.*

The proceedings from the Twenty-Fourth Information Transfer Meeting held January 9-11, 2007, in Kenner, Louisiana, are now available. Highlights this year included results from a major study, the *Sperm Whale Seismic Study (SWSS)*, which is nearly complete, as well as sessions devoted to deepwater *Lophelia* coral and deepwater technology. The Minerals Management Service has been tasked by Congress to oversee the Coastal Impact Assistance Program; a session was devoted to the program which authorizes funds to be distributed to Outer Continental Shelf (OCS) oil and gas producing states to mitigate the impacts of OCS oil and gas activities. Deepwater current dynamics were of particular interest as industry moves into waters farther offshore. Other topics included air quality, deepwater habitats, platform ecology, hydrates, coastal wetlands, offshore ecology, and chemosynthetic communities.

The next Information Transfer Meeting is scheduled for January 2009.
