


LOUISIANA **GULF COAST INDEX**





All blocks are based on the Louisiana (Lambert) Plane Coordinate System, South Zone, with X origin = 2,000,000' at $91^{\circ} 20'$ W and Y origin = 0.00' at 28° 40' N.


Onshore planimetric base compilation is from USGS 1:100 000 Digital Line Graph (DLG) files.

Regular blocks are 14,750.00 feet on a side and contain 4,994.55 acres, except block 146, which contain 4,560.81 acres and blocks 149, 150 and 153 which contain 4,999.97 acres each.

The Submerged Lands Act Boundary and Limit of "8(g) Zone" lines depicted hereon reflect the official federal position for Submerged Lands Act and OCS Lands Act purposes. The areas of the fractional blocks abutting these lines have been determined and are as depicted on the Supplemental Official OCS Block Diagrams (SOBD's). Consult the SOBD's for official descriptions and approval dates.

This revised map supersedes leasing map MAIN PASS AREA, LA-MAP No. 10, approved 08-JUN-1954, revised 22-JUL-1954, revised 01-JUN-1988, and LA10 revised 01-SEP-1999.
