

LOUISIANA GULF COAST INDEX





All blocks are based on the Louisiana (Lambert) Plane Coordinate System, South Zone, with X origin = 2,000,000' at $91^{\circ} 20'$ W and Y origin = 0.00' at 28° 40' N.

Onshore planimetric base compilation is from U.S.G.S. 1:100 000 Digital Line Graph (DLG) Files.

The Submerged Lands Act Boundary and Limit of "8(g) Zone" lines depicted hereon reflect the official federal position for Submerged Lands Act and OCS Lands Act purposes. The areas of the fractional blocks abutting these lines have been determined and are as depicted on the Supplemental Official OCS Block Diagrams (SOBD's). Consult the SOBD's for official descriptions and approval dates.

This revised map supersedes leasing map BRETON SOUND AREA, LA-MAP No. 10B, approved 01-JUN-1988, and LA10B revised 01-SEP-1999.

LA10B was created by removing the BRETON SOUND AREA from map LA10, MAIN PASS AND BRETON SOUND AREAS, dated 08-JUN-1954 and revised 22-JUL-1954.
