

LOUISIANA GULF COAST INDEX





All blocks are based on the Louisiana (Lambert) Plane Coordinate System, South Zone, with X origin = 2,000,000' at 91 $^{\circ}$ 20' W and Y origin = 0.00' at 28° 40' N.

The boundaries of the regular blocks are 14,758.00 feet on a side, and contains 4,999.97 acres. The areas of the irregular blocks are as indicated.

The Limit of "8(g) Zone" line depicted hereon reflects the official federal position for OCS Lands Act purposes. The areas of the fractional blocks abutting this line have been determined and are as depicted on the Supplemental Official OCS Block Diagrams (SOBD's). Consult the SOBD's for official descriptions and approval dates.

This revised map supersedes leasing map WEST DELTA AREA SOUTH ADDITION, LA-MAP No. 8A, approved 08-SEP-1959, revised 24-NOV-1961, revised 01-JUN-1988, and LA8A revised 01-SEP-1999.




