
General BOEM Lease Process



BOEM Lease Process Responding to an Unsolicited Request

1. BOEM consults with intergovermental task force

- 2. BOEM publishes Request for Competitive Interest (RFCI)
- 3. BOEM determines whether or not there is competitive interest

BOEM Lease Process Responding to an Unsolicited Request

If BOEM determines there is no competitive interest—

- BOEM publishes determination
- Lease requestor submits site assessment plan (SAP)
- BOEM analyzes lease issuance and SAP approval under NEPA and other laws

BOEM Lease Process Responding to an Unsolicited Request If BOEM determines there is competitive interest—

- BOEM follows competitive leasing process:
 - Area Identification
 - Proposed and Final Sale Notices
 - Lease Sale (Auction)
- BOEM analyzes lease issuance and site characterization/assessment activities under NEPA and other laws
