BOEM Issues a Notice of Availability and Public Meetings for the Draft Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement for Geological and Geophysical Activities in the Gulf of Mexico

The U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Ocean Energy Management (BOEM) announces the availability of the Draft Gulf of Mexico Geological and Geophysical (G&G) Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement (EIS). This Programmatic EIS addresses potential environmental impacts of BOEM's oil and gas, renewable energy, and marine mineral resource programs and focuses particularly on the environmental impacts of off-lease and on-lease geological (bottom sampling and test drilling) and geophysical surveys (deep-penetration, high-resolution geophysical, electromagnetic, deep stratigraphic, and remote sensing).



BOEM and the National Marine Fisheries Service published a combined Notice of Intent to Prepare an EIS and Notice of Scoping in the *Federal Register* on May 10, 2013. The Notice of Intent sought input on the scope of the Programmatic EIS for proposed G&G activities in the Gulf of Mexico.

BOEM will hold public meetings to obtain comments regarding the Draft Gulf of Mexico G&G Programmatic EIS. These public meetings are held in an open-house format, and may be attended any time between 4:00 p.m. CST and 7:00 p.m. CST. They are scheduled as follows:

BOEM will be printing and distributing a very limited number of paper copies. In keeping with the Department of the Interior's mission of the protection of natural resources and to limit costs while ensuring the availability of the document to the public, BOEM will primarily distribute digital copies of the Draft Gulf of Mexico G&G Programmatic EIS on compact discs. However, if you require a paper copy, BOEM will provide one upon request if copies are still available.
