**Outage of Fees for Services due to Fiscal Year-end Closeout**

The Bureau of Ocean Energy Management (BOEM) is issuing this Notice to Lessees and Operators (NTL) to notify you that, due to fiscal year-end closeout, BOEM will disable the Fees for Services Refund Request Form from 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time, Friday, September 14, 2018, to 9:00 a.m. Monday, October 1, 2018.

In addition, BOEM will disable the Pay.gov Application forms from 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time, Friday, September 21, 2018, to 9:00 a.m. Monday, October 1, 2018. September 21<sup>st</sup> is the final day for accepting payments.


Payments are to be made to BOEM through <http://www.boem.gov/Fees-for-Services> both before and after the blackout period. BOEM recommends that companies plan appropriately in advance of the blackout period.
