MMS MAKES ROYALTY FAIRNESS AND SIMPLIFICATION ACT INFORMATION AVAILABLE ON THE INTERNET

The U.S. Department of the Interior's Minerals Management Service (MMS) is using the World Wide Web to keep states, industry, and other customers informed about the agency's activities to implement the Federal Oil and Gas Royalty Simplification and Fairness Act (RSFA) of 1996.
