MMS SCHEDULES ADDITIONAL WORKSHOPS ON ALTERNATIVES TO CRUDE OIL VALUATION

The U.S. Department of the Interior's Minerals Management Service (MMS) today announced the dates and locations of three additional workshops it will host to discuss royalty valuation alternatives to its recently proposed rulemaking for valuing crude oil production from federal leases. These new workshops will provide an opportunity for information exchange with small oil producers at locations near their operations. A notice announcing the workshops will be published in the *Federal Register* on October 8, 1997.
