MMS to Hold Public Hearing in Larose on Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement for Proposed Lease Sale in the Eastern Gulf of Mexico

NEW ORLEANS — The Minerals Management Service (MMS) will hold a public hearing in Larose, Louisiana, on July 24, 2007, to obtain input from the public on the Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) for a proposed oil and gas lease sale in the Eastern Planning Area of the Gulf of Mexico. Lease Sale 224, mandated by the Gulf of Mexico Energy Security Act of 2006, is scheduled for March 2008.

What: Public Hearing on the Draft SEIS for Eastern Gulf Sale 224

When: Tuesday, July 24, 2007, at 7:00 p.m.

Where: Larose Civic Center 307 East 5th Street Larose Regional Park Larose, LA 70373

Why: To receive comments from State, Federal, and local agencies and the public on information and analyses presented in the Draft SEIS. The meetings will also inform participants about the proposed sale and the SEIS process. This SEIS updates the environmental and socioeconomic analyses in the EIS completed in 2001 for the original Sale 181 area.
