## Characterization of Northern Gulf of Mexico Deepwater Hard-Bottom Communities with Emphasis on Lophelia Coral

## **OCS Study MMS 2007-044**

The Minerals Management Service (MMS), Gulf of Mexico OCS Region, announces the availability of a new study report, *Characterization of Northern Gulf of Mexico Deepwater Hard-Bottom Communities with Emphasis on Lophelia Coral.* 

Interest in deepwater corals has increased rapidly in the last decade as more coral systems are discovered worldwide and their importance in providing habitat for diverse communities is realized. This report presents the results of a study of 10 sites on the northern Gulf of Mexico continental slope consisting of hard-bottom areas that generally include dense assemblages of the coral *Lophelia pertusa*. Study elements include geological characterization; biological characterization, imaging, and sampling; water chemistry; and physical oceanography including short-term and long-term current meter deployments. This was the first comprehensive study of the distribution of *Lophelia pertusa and* its biology and ecology in the Gulf of Mexico. Results suggest that *Lophelia pertusa* plays a significant role in the ecology of hard-bottom habitats on the upper slope. Results of this study will be used to develop additional studies of hard-bottom habitats in the deep Gulf of Mexico and will also enhance the ability of MMS to protect sensitive deepwater biological features.
