
Science helps us to predict environmental impacts & to monitor for changes over time









Using BOTH Knowledge Systems

Cross Island Subsistence Bowhead Whale Hunt Mapping



- TK about whale behavior underscored lñupiat concerns that industrial activities would impact hunting success.
- Hunters provided GPS Units to record boat tracks and whale strikes from 2001-2012.
- Result: convergence of BOTH knowledge systems, enabling conflict avoidance.





Using TK / IK in Design of the Science


Why did the Arctic cisco of the Colville River, an important subsistence fishery, crash?

- BOEM hosted a workshop of Iñupiat expert fishers, elders, and scientists to prioritize concerns about the 3-year demise of Arctic cisco.
- A panel of indigenous experts guided the research from the hypothesis stage to preparing the final report.

- Sometimes perceived as difficult to integrate with "Science"
