


What is a Call?


- Request for comments on specific area of OCS being considered for leasing


Renewable Energy Process: Area Identification

- Stakeholder outreach


Renewable Energy Process: Environmental Assessment

- Comment periods, opportunities for stakeholder involvement










Balance of factors, including, but not limited to:


- Commercial Fishing

Indicative Areas


Space is illustrated with the requested new WEAs and how they could be located within the Area for Consideration. The WEAs depicted may be shifted, reshaped or both.


