## PROPOSED NOTICE OF SALE 233 Western Planning Area

Attached is the Proposed Notice of Sale (NOS) Package (Package), for the Western Planning Area Oil and Gas Lease Sale 233 (WPA Sale 233) proposed to be held on Wednesday, August 28, 2013, in New Orleans, Louisiana.

#### **Please Note:**

Terms and conditions for Proposed NOS 233 are generally the same as for the November 2012 WPA Lease Sale 229; the exception being that royalty relief for shallow water, deep gas is no longer being offered. The following noteworthy matters are highlighted for your attention:

#### **Updated Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Instructions**

Bidders are advised that the EFT instructions have been updated for WPA Sale 233. Please refer to the following website: <a href="http://www.boem.gov/sale-233/">http://www.boem.gov/sale-233/</a> for complete information.

#### **Geophysical Data and Information Statements**

Bidders are advised that updated requirements for the submission of the Lease Sale GDIS and Proprietary Geophysical Data have been updated for WPA Sale 233. The changes include:

- 1. The GDIS must be submitted digitally beginning this sale.
- 2. A suitable blank Excel Spreadsheet is available at <a href="http://www.boem.gov/sale-233/">http://www.boem.gov/sale-233/</a> that may be filled out and submitted.
- 3. Unless notified otherwise by BOEM (within 15 days of the sale date) bidders must submit their proprietary/reprocessed geophysical data sets to BOEM within 30 days of the Sale date. Please read the GDIS portion of the NOS for details concerning data submission and reimbursement. Bidders will not be reimbursed for submission of speculative data.
- 4. Bidders must submit live trace maps showing the extent of their proprietary/reprocessed geophysical data sets. These should be submitted in the preferred PDF and shape file formats. Please look at the GDIS examples for additional details.
- 5. Technical details for the submission of geophysical data are included the GDIS example.

#### **U.S. and Mexico Treaty**

The U.S. and Mexico exchanged instruments of ratification in January 2001, and a continental shelf boundary treaty entered into force in the Western Gap area. This treaty contained provisions for a ten year moratorium on drilling within 1.4 nautical miles of the maritime boundary on both the U.S. and Mexican sides of the boundary. While this moratorium was initially scheduled to expire in January 2011, the U.S. and Mexico mutually agreed to extend the moratorium in the Western Gap buffer zone for an additional three years. This moratorium in the buffer zone remains in effect until January 2014, or until the Transboundary Agreement enters into force. Because the 1.4 nm buffer in the Western Gap could become available to lease in Sale 233, it is included in this Proposed Notice of Sale. If the Transboundary agreement will not enter into force before Sale 233, the buffer area will be removed from the Final Notice of Sale.

#### U.S.-Mexico Maritime and Continental Shelf Boundary

Bidders are advised to refer to the Proposed Notice of Sale and clause (1) in the Information to Lessees portion of this package for detailed information pertaining the transboundary agreement. Bids submitted on blocks in the "Boundary Area" will not be opened on the date scheduled for the sale, but may be opened at a later date. On or before 30 days following Congressional approval of the Transboundary Agreement or by February 28, 2014, whichever occurs first, the Secretary of the Interior will determine whether it is in the best interest of the United States either to open bids for Boundary Area blocks or to return the bids unopened.
