

Florida Manatee Movement and Habitat Use in the Northern Gulf of Mexico

BOEM Information Need:

Manatees are an ESA listed species that appear to be expanding their range in the northern GOM, potentially increasing the likelihood of impacts from BOEM activities.

Date Information is Required:

Data needed for ESA and MMPA consultations as well as current and future NEPA analyses.

Tentative Ranking: 11



Background:

- Potential impacts to manatees from vessel traffic associated with BOEM activities
- More than 100,000 service vessel round-trips for a typical lease sale in the Central Planning Area





Study's Objectives:

- 1) Determine manatee movements/spatial distribution and habitat use in the northern GOM, specifically in areas west of the Suwannee River, FL
- 2) Conduct health assessments on tagged animals





Study's Methods:

- Satellite telemetry of up to 20 manatees annually for 3 years (N=60)
- 2) Habitat characterization of areas used by manatees
- Health assessments of captured animals –including gender, blood/urine samples, fat thickness, scar photos, and skin samples for genetic analyses.
