MMS to Hold Scoping Meetings and Prepare an Environmental Impact Statement

for Proposed Western and Central Lease Sales in Gulf of Mexico

NEW ORLEANS – The Minerals Management Service (MMS) has published the Notice of Intent (NOI) to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for 11 proposed oil and gas lease sales in the Western and Central Planning Areas (WPA and CPA) of the Gulf of Mexico. These sales are scheduled for 2007-2012 in the draft proposed *Outer Continental Shelf Oil and Gas Leasing Program: 2007-2012*. The NOI was published in the *Federal Register* on March 7, 2006. The sales are proposed WPA Sales 204, 207, 210, 215, and 218, and proposed CPA Sales 205 (portion), 206, 208, 213, 216, and 222.

MMS offers three ways interested parties to provide written comments on the scope of the EIS, significant issues that should be addressed, and alternatives that should be considered.

The preferred method is to use <u>MMS's Public Connect on-line commenting system</u>. Select "WPA and CPA Multisale EIS 2007-2012" from the "Projects Open for Comment" menu.

Written comments can also be mailed or hand carried in an envelope labeled "Comments on the Multisale EIS" to the Regional Supervisor, Leasing and Environment (MS 5410), Minerals Management Service, Gulf of Mexico OCS Region, 1201 Elmwood Park Boulevard, New Orleans, Louisiana 70123-2394.

Finally, comments may be submitted electronically to the MMS e-mail address.

Comments should specifically address factors related to the scope of the draft EIS and are due by April 21, 2006.

The MMS will hold scoping meetings to obtain additional comments and information regarding the scope of the EIS. The scoping meetings are scheduled as follows:

In addition, MMS is preparing a separate EIS for the new 5-year OCS oil and gas leasing program for proposed lease sales to be held from 2007-2012. The MMS will also use the scoping meetings on the multisale EIS as an opportunity to solicit comments on the scope of the 5-year program EIS. <u>Additional information</u> concerning the 5-year program and EIS is also available.
