Meeting Protocols

- Testimony to the court reporter will be limited to 5 minutes for each commenter because of the expected amount of comments.
- No solicitation of funds will be permitted or you may be asked to leave.
- Please be courteous to other meeting participants and their right to participate in the process. By entering the meeting room, you agree to abide by these ground rules. Individuals or groups who disrupt the public meeting will be asked to leave.
