

Format for Submitting Data

There are 2 requirements for the BOEM bi-weekly navigation data submitted on the 1st and 15th of each month.

BOEM requires *one* UKOAA P1/90 formatted navigation data file for each source vessel utilized in the seismic survey during each two week reporting period. This file should consist of all the shot point files concatenated with only one header (i.e. if there are 5 source vessels utilized in a seismic survey, 5 separate navigation files would need to be submitted). Either the NAD27 datum or WGS84 datum are acceptable for the navigation data.

BOEM also requires a table listing the total number of hours of active acquisition per day for each source vessel. This information will be used to verify whether time gaps exist in the navigation data provided. A sample is shown below--an excel file or simple list is acceptable.

Date	Comment
16-Aug	In production for 0.000 hrs
17-Aug	In production for 18.183 hrs
18-Aug	In production for 8.250 hrs
19-Aug	In production for 14.000 hrs

BOEM requests that the required bi-weekly data be submitted via zip files through the ggpermitsgomr@boem.gov email address. This is preferable so the data can be processed as soon as possible. If the data must be sent on CD for security reasons, you can mail it to BOEM at the following address
