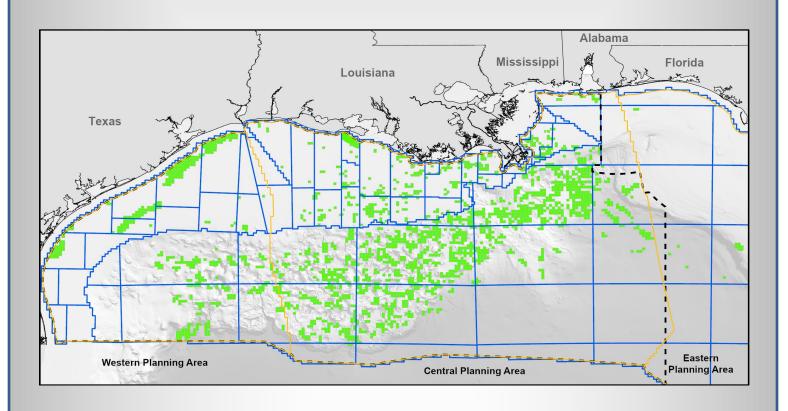

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2025 Report Overview

The Bureau of Ocean Energy Management's (BOEM), Office of Resource Evaluation (RE), Geological and Geophysical (G&G) Section annually compiles a Top 40 Company Report (formerly known as the Top 50 Company Report). This report aids in understanding company activity and interest in geologic trends, as well as short-term changes in company ownership, acquisitions, and mergers. It also assists in the evaluation of Fair Market Value (FMV). The report graphically illustrates the top 40 oil and gas companies by lease ownership within the Gulf of America Outer Continental Shelf (OCS). Lease ownership is determined by the company or companies listed as the Record Title Owner in the Serial Register. Leases owned by subsidiary companies are listed under their respective parent companies. For leases with multiple owners, lease acreages have been weighted according to each company's interest in the lease.

Corrections have been made to account for (1) leases that have been partitioned into aliquots by normalizing a lease owner's aliquot acreage to the total lease acreage and (2) leases that have more than one subsidiary company owning a percentage of the same lease by combining their individual leased acreages. Attempts have been made to accurately link subsidiary companies to their parent organization, but some errors may still exist.

This report has previously (before 2023) analyzed the fifty companies who own the most leased acreage in the Gulf of America. Over the past decade, the number of companies that own and operate leases has steadily declined, primarily due to mergers, bankruptcies, and companies ceasing operations in the Gulf altogether. To better highlight those with significant or larger lease holdings, the number of companies included in the report has been reduced from fifty to forty.

All lease and ownership information in this report are static as of January 2, 2025.

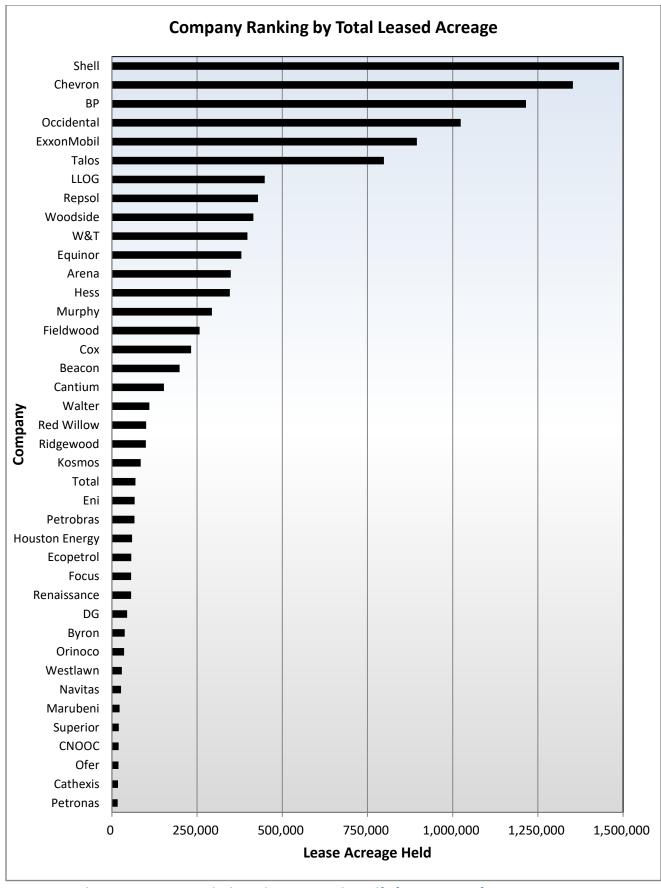


Figure 1. The top 40 companies by leased acreage in the Gulf of America as of January 2, 2025.

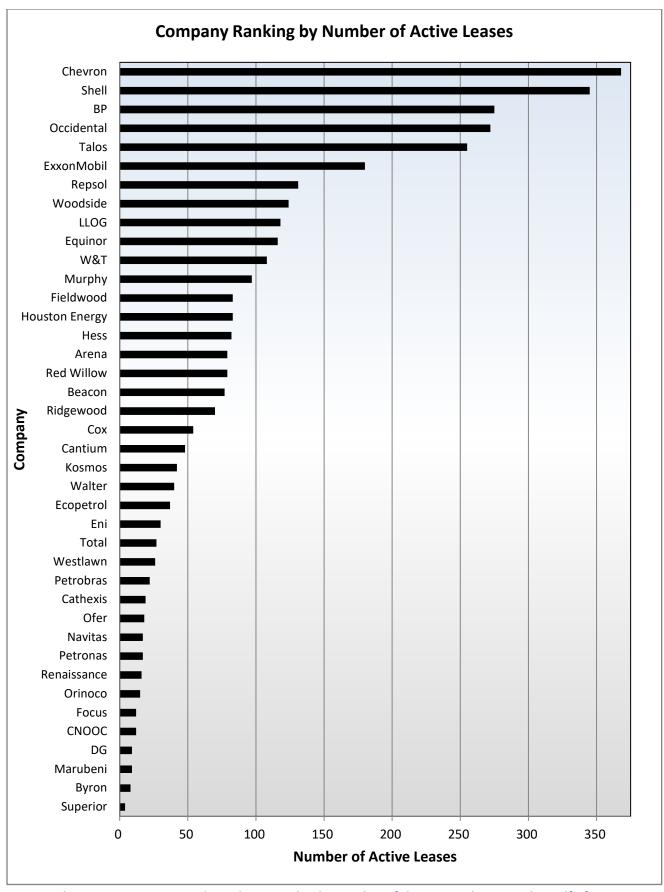


Figure 2. The top 40 companies in leased acreage by the number of their active leases in the Gulf of America as of January 2, 2025.

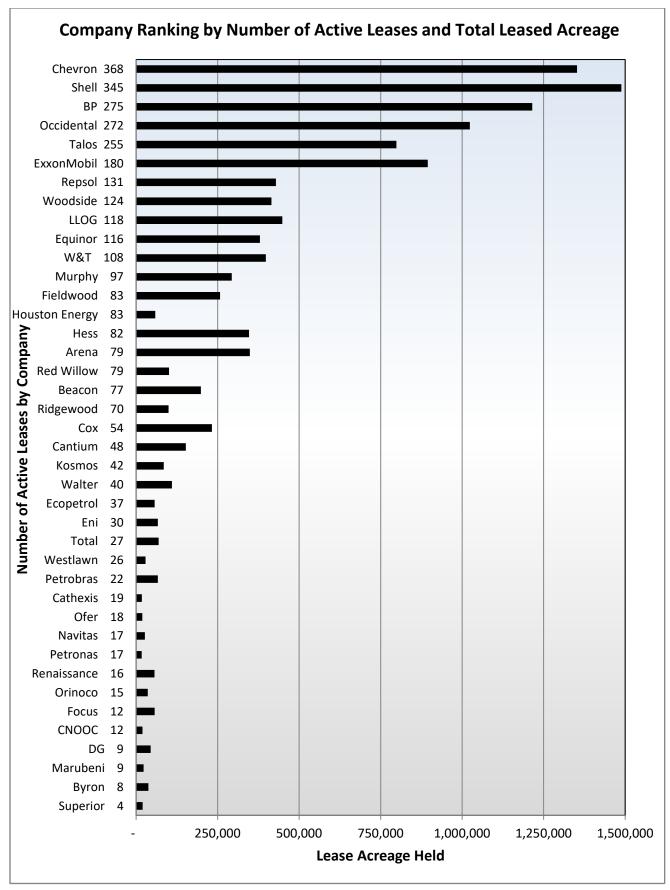
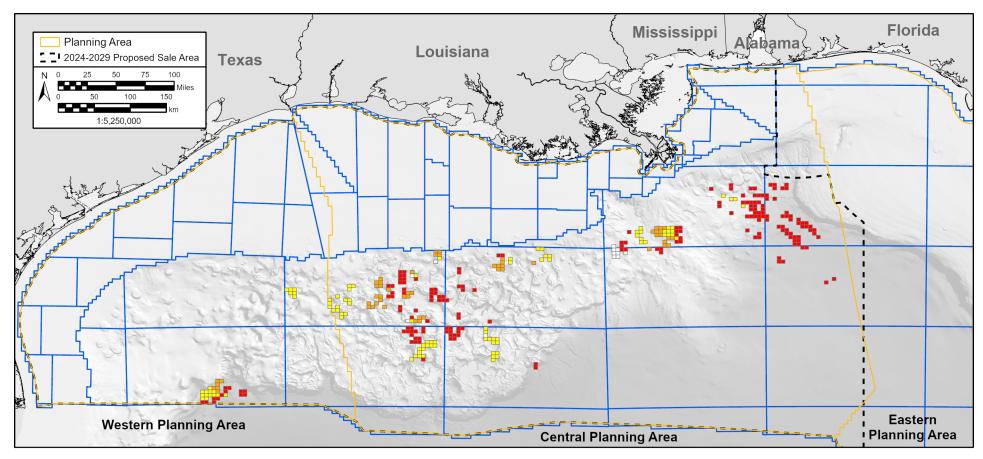


Figure 3. Comparison of the top 40 companies in leased acreage by the number of their active leases with their leased acreage in the Gulf of America as of January 2, 2025.



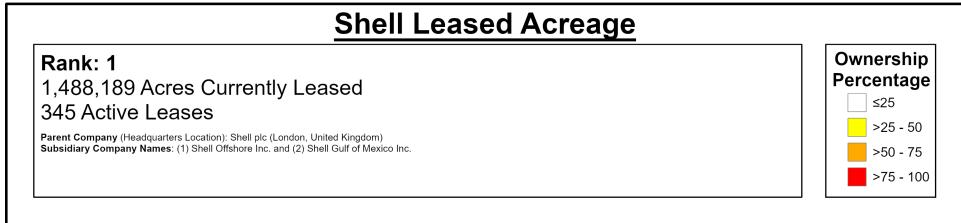
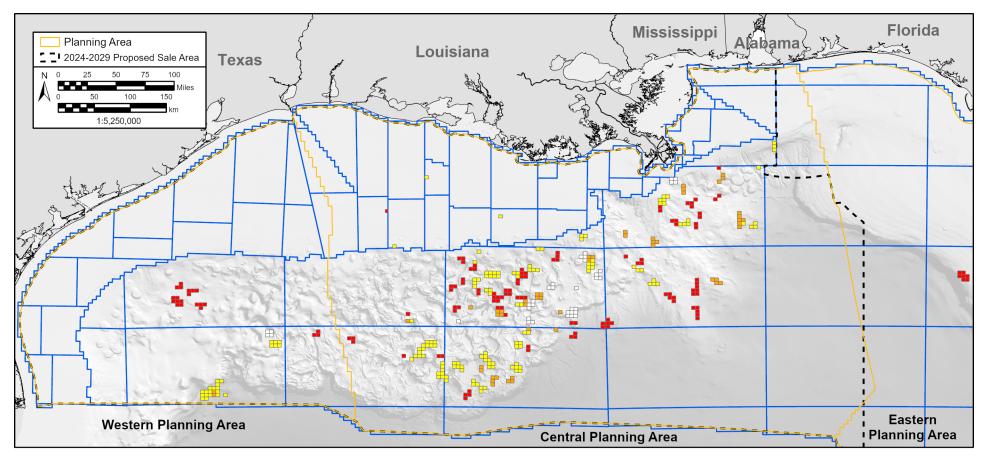


Figure 4. Shell's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



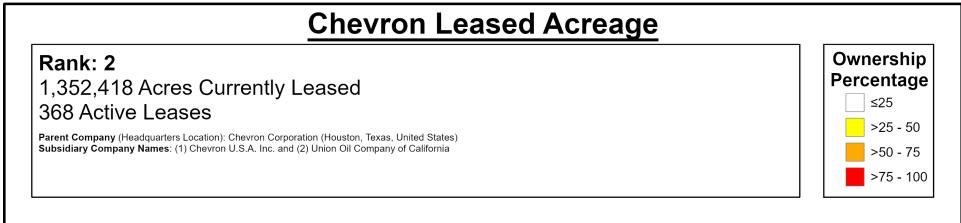
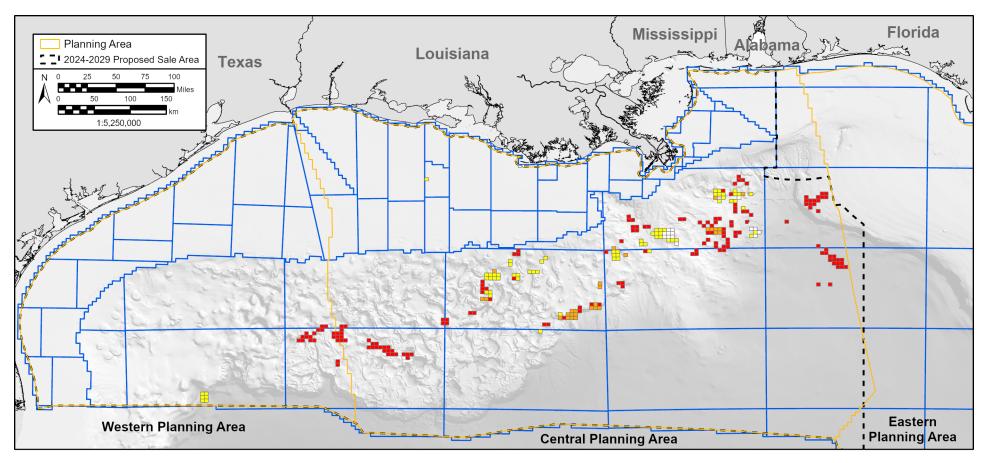


Figure 5. Chevron's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



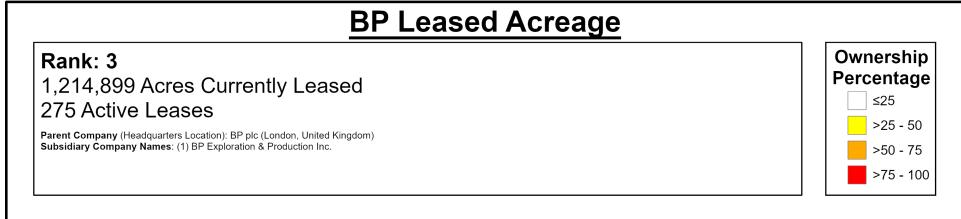
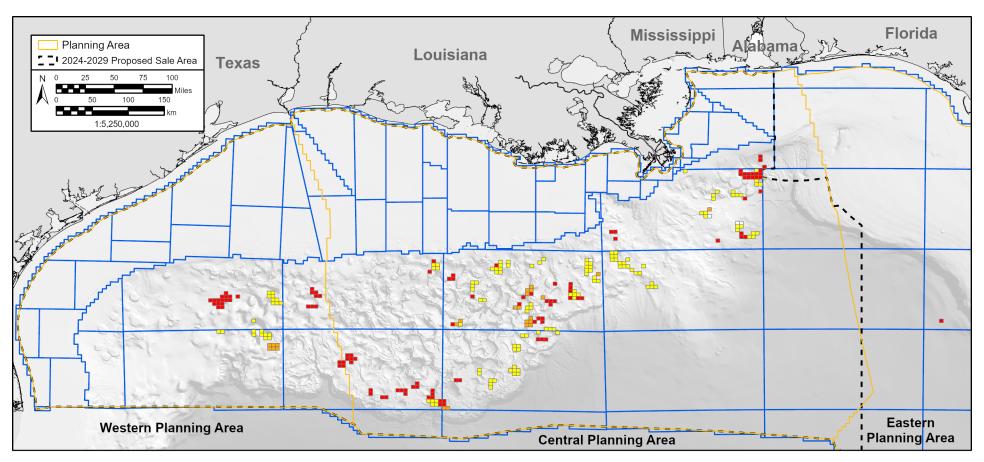


Figure 6. BP's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



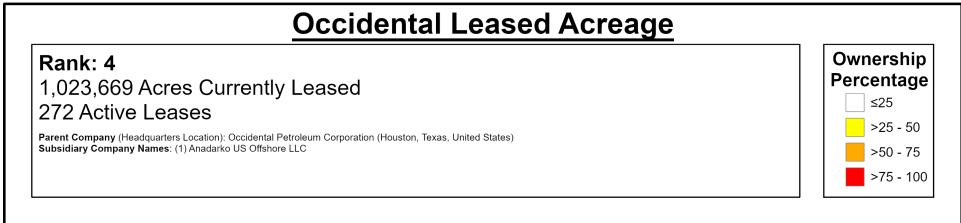
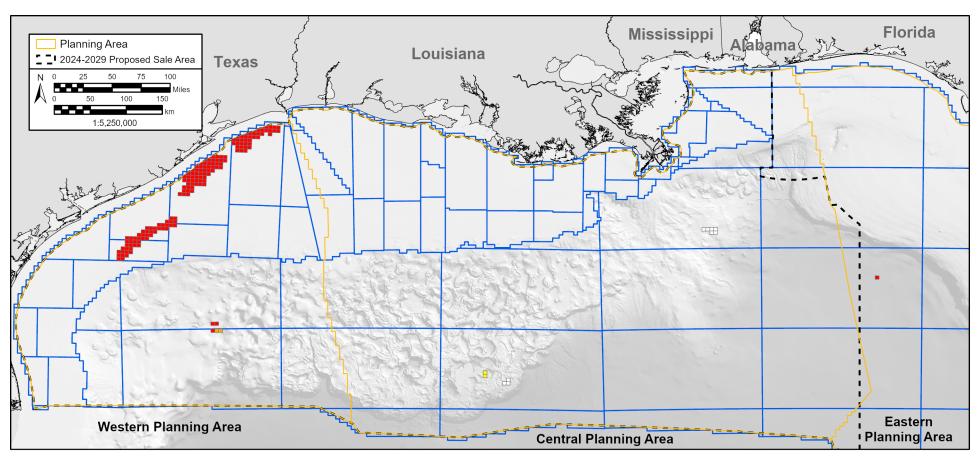


Figure 7. Occidental's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



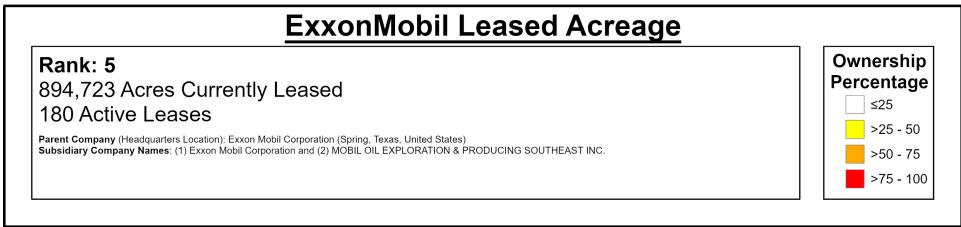
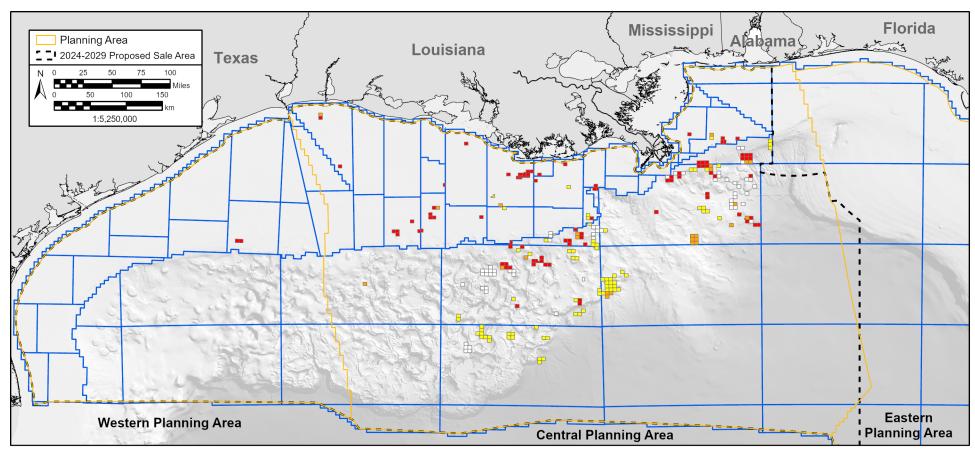


Figure 8. ExxonMobil's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



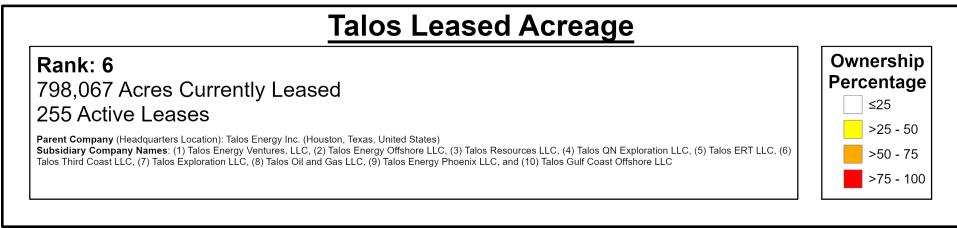


Figure 9. Talos' leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.

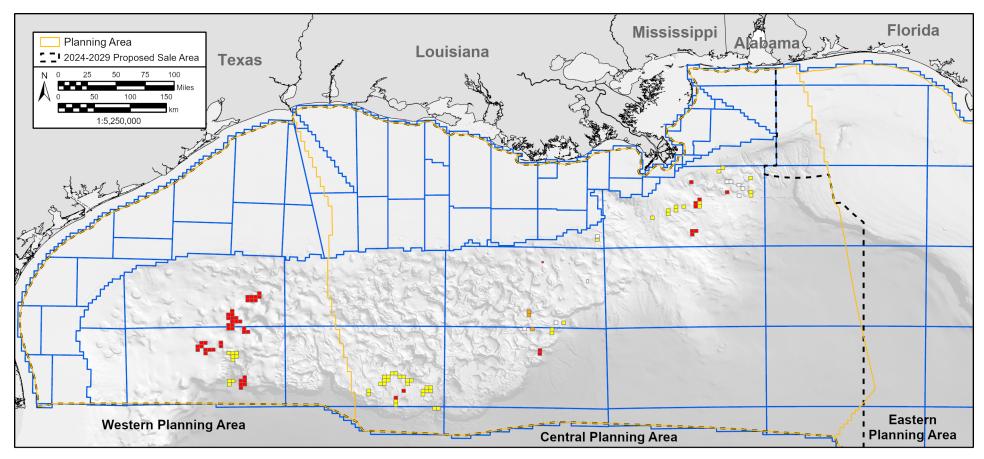




Figure 10. LLOG's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.

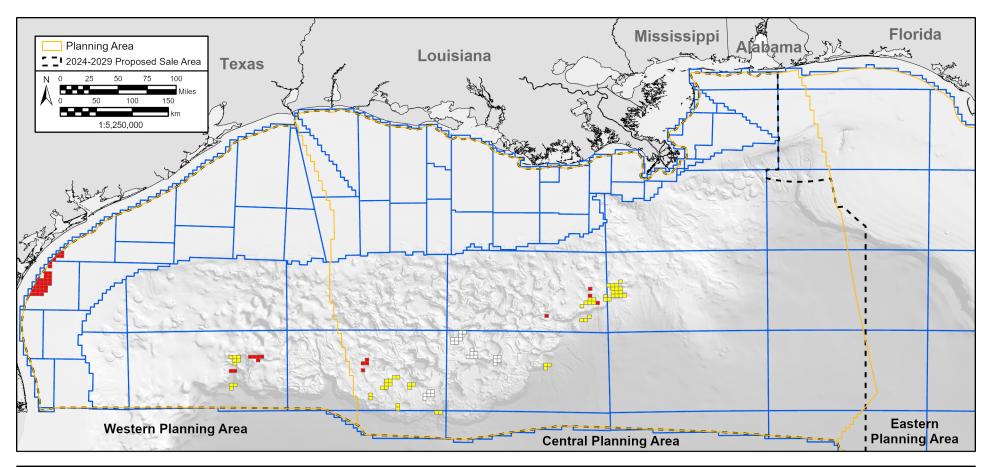
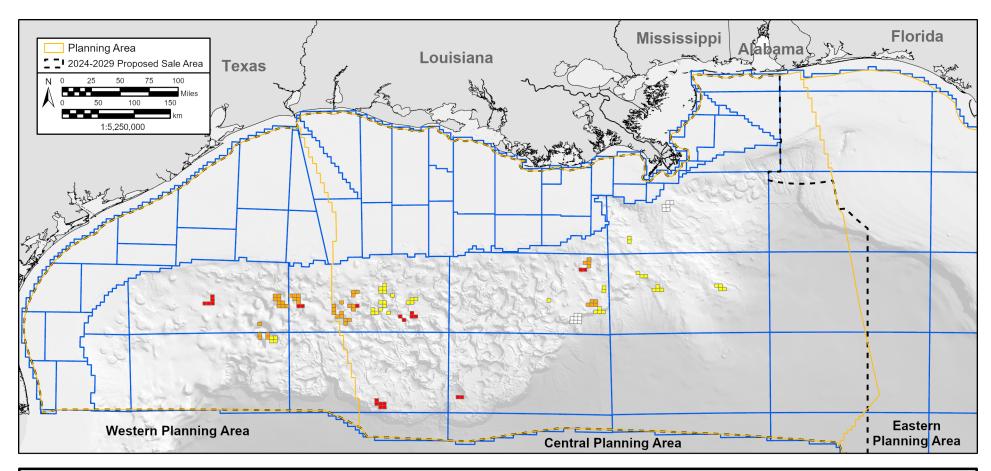




Figure 11. Repsol's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



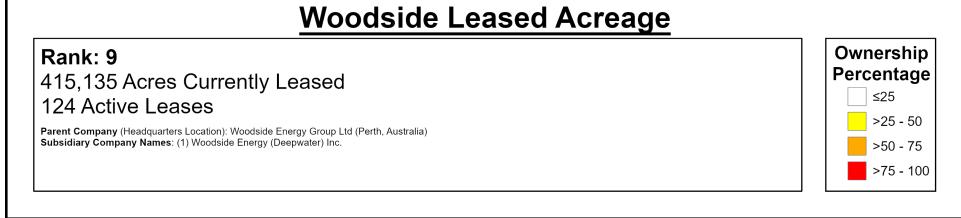
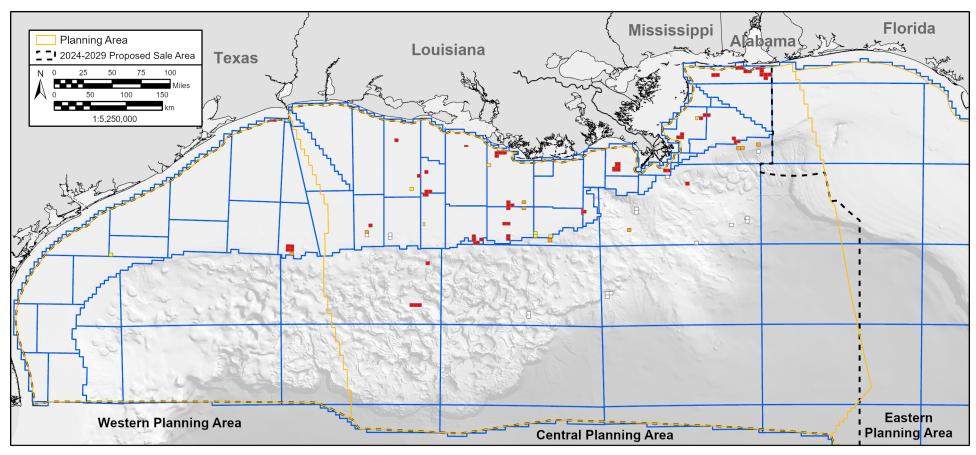


Figure 12. Woodside's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



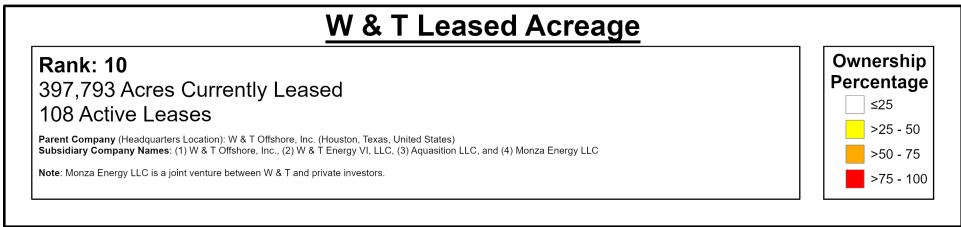


Figure 13. W&T's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.

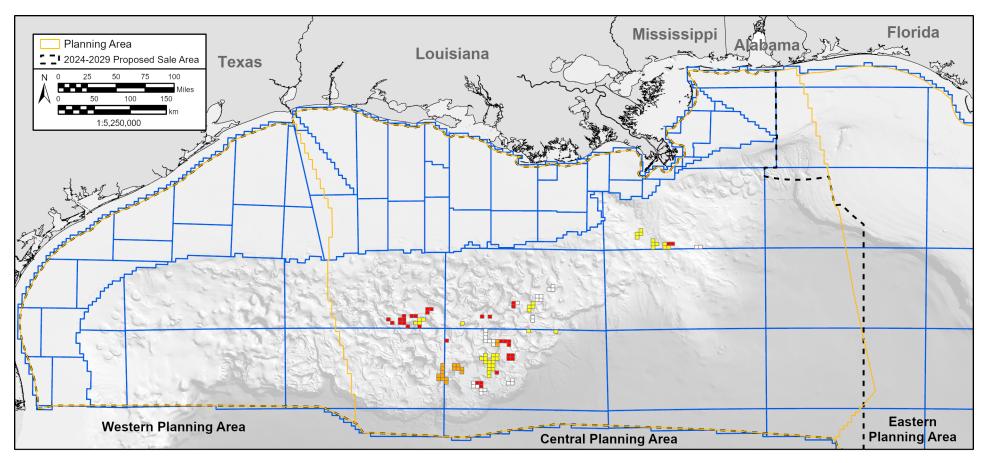
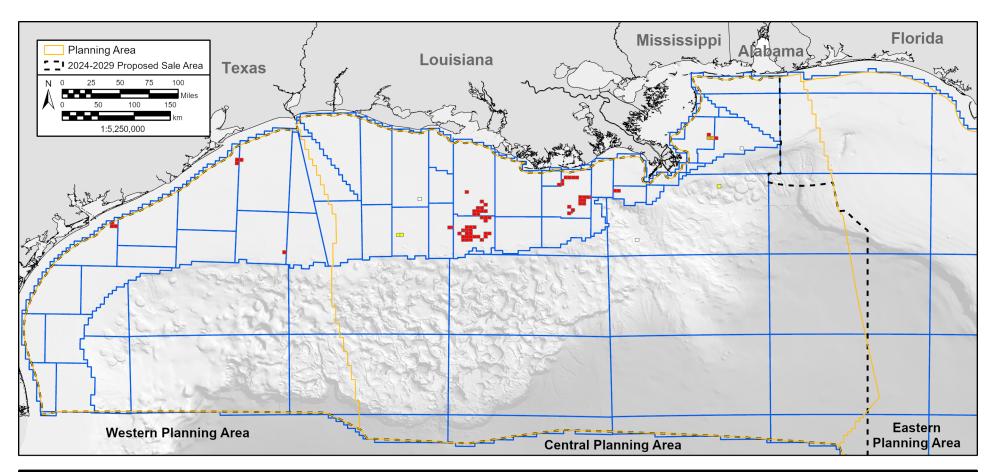




Figure 14. Equinor's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



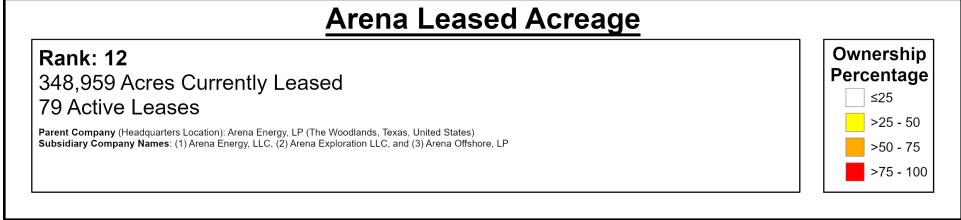
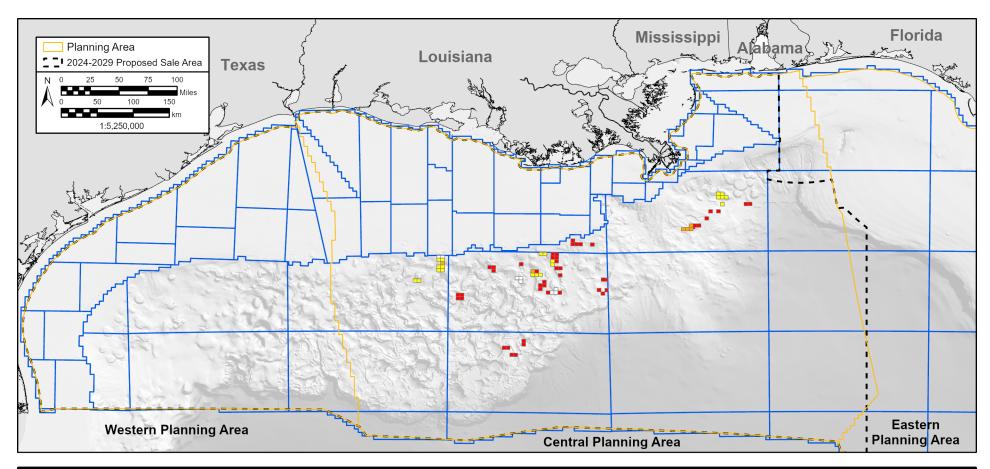


Figure 15. Arena's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



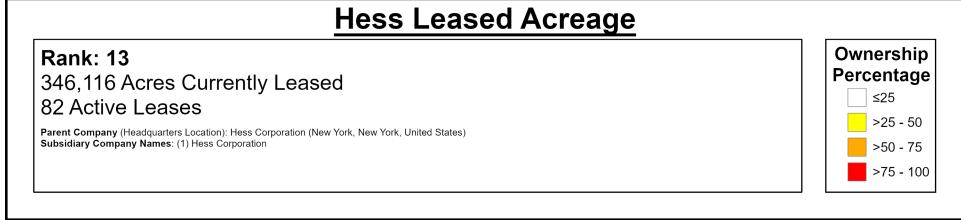


Figure 16. Hess' leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.

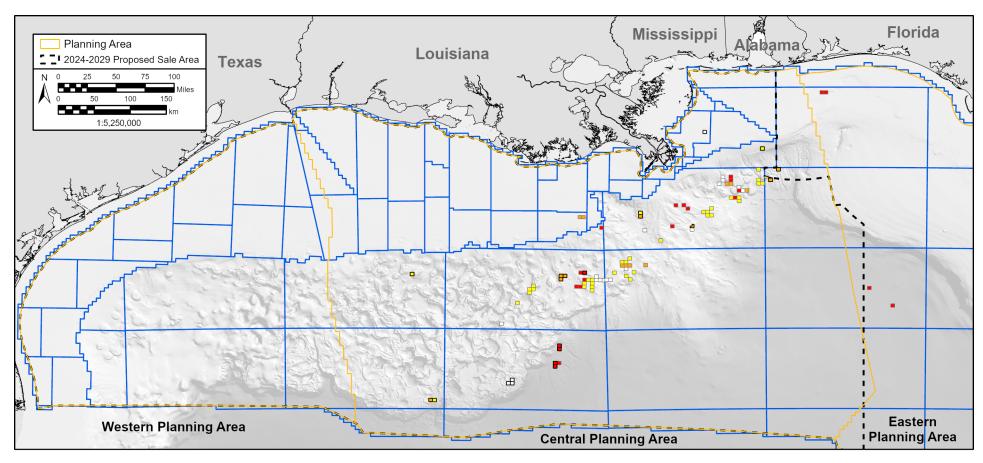
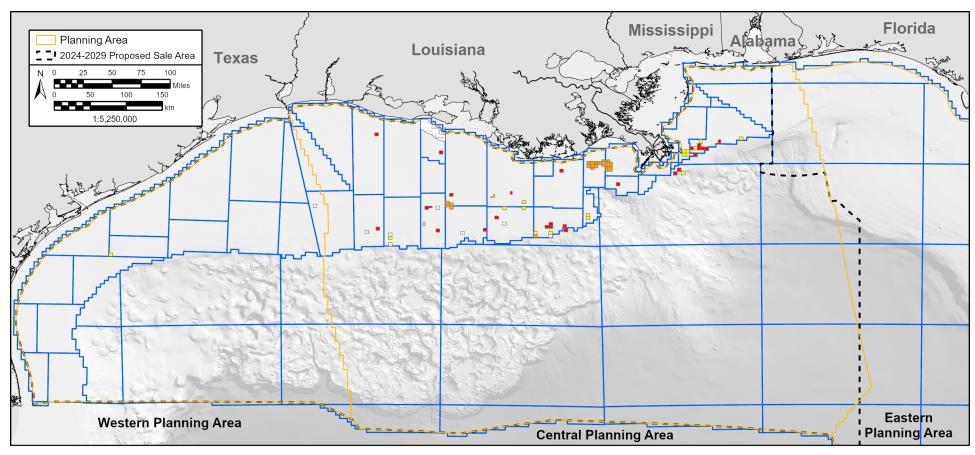




Figure 17. Murphy's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



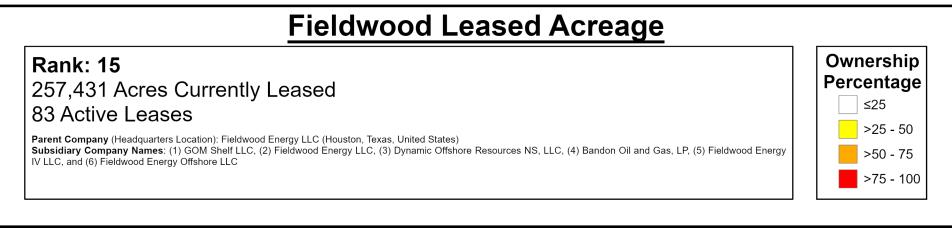
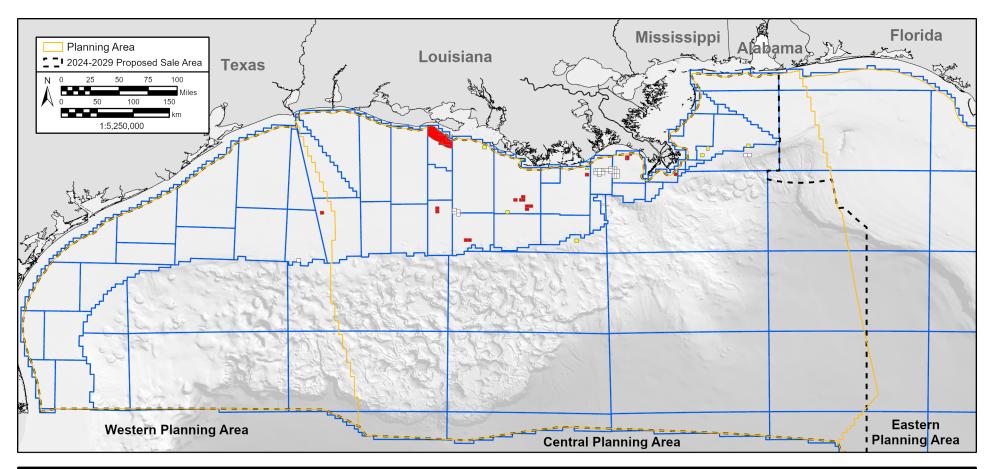


Figure 18. Fieldwood's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



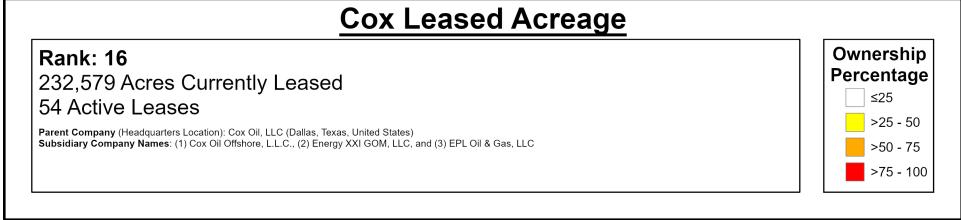


Figure 19. Cox's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.

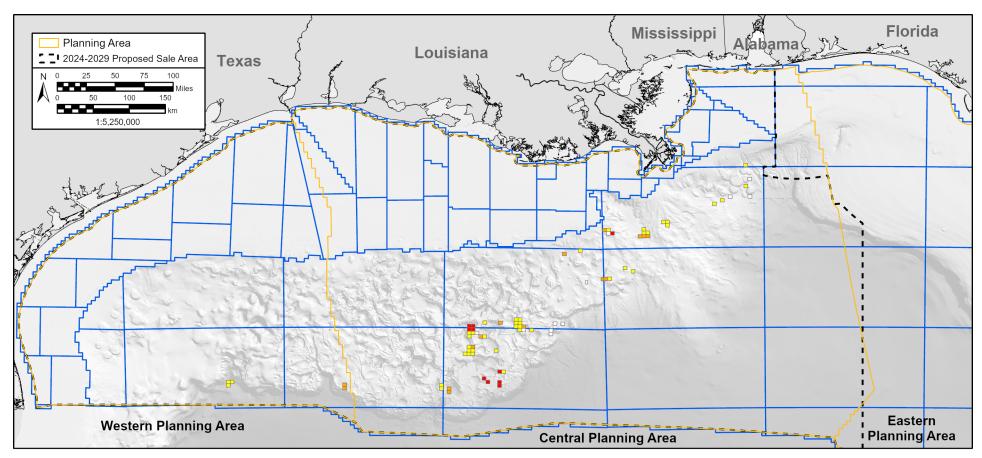
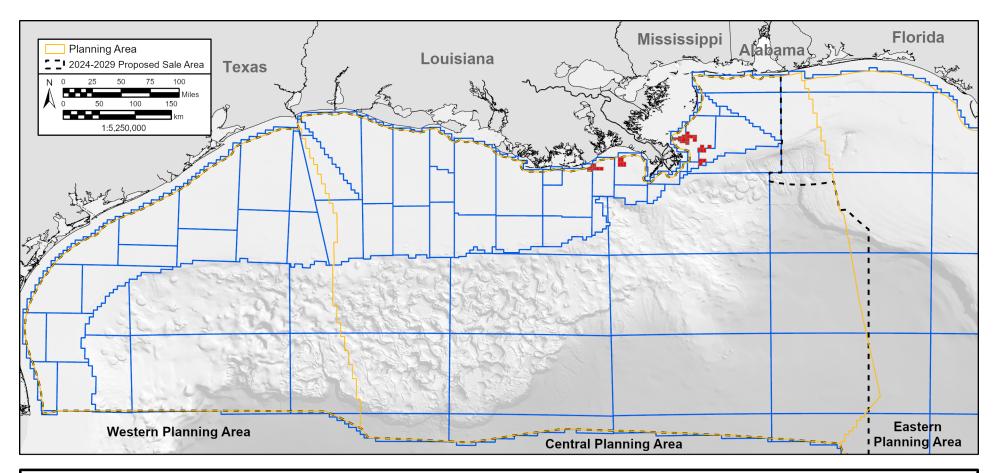




Figure 20. Beacon's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



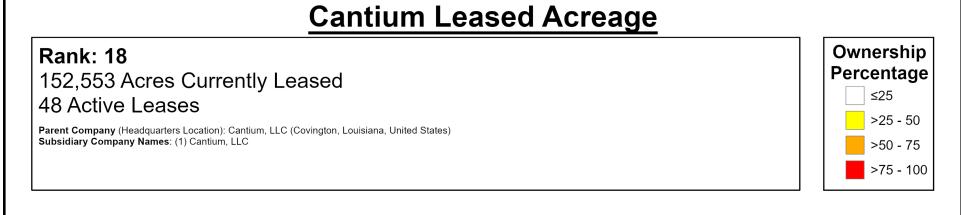


Figure 21. Cantium's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.

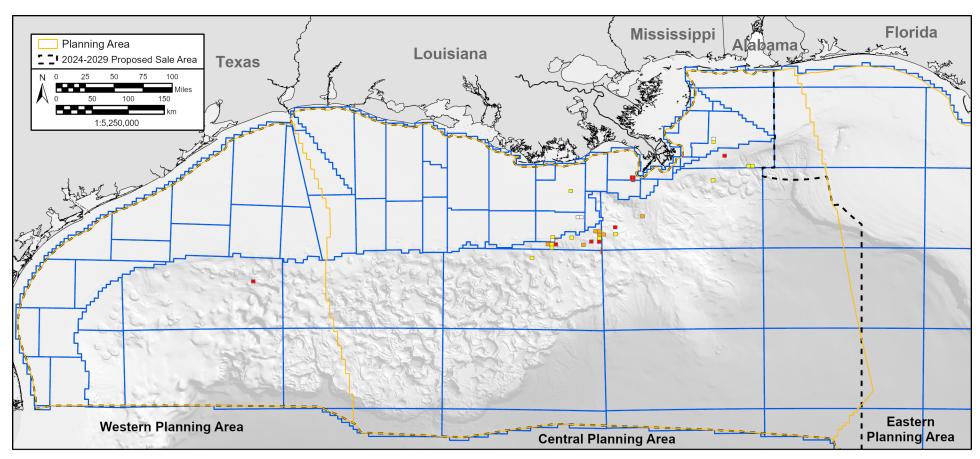
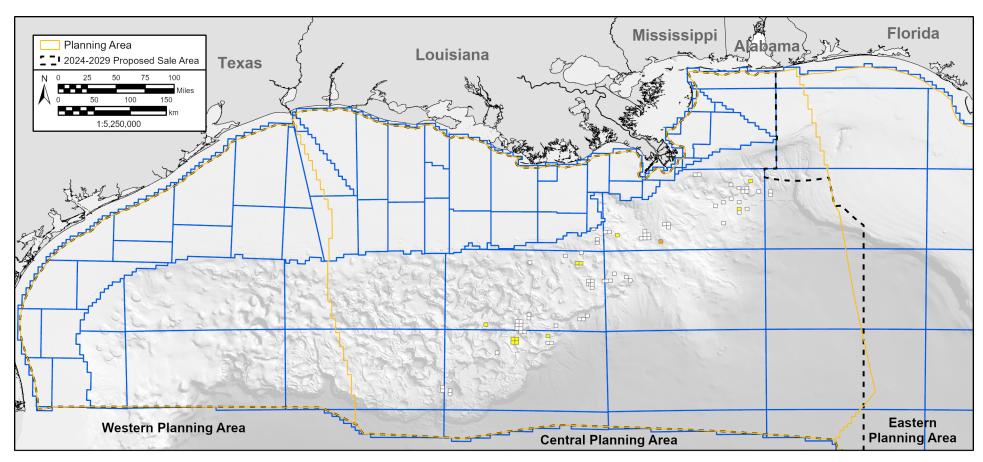




Figure 22. Walter's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



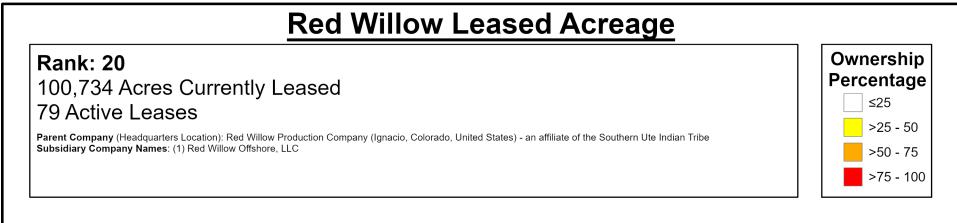
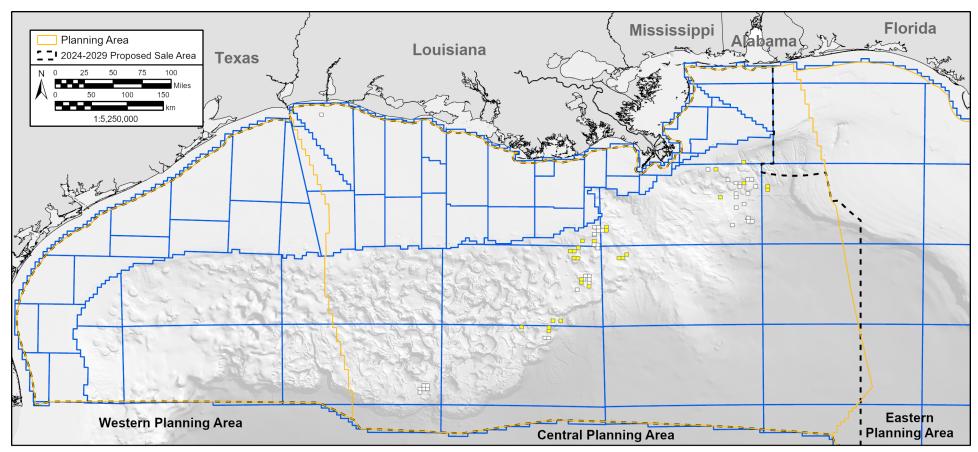


Figure 23. Red Willow's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



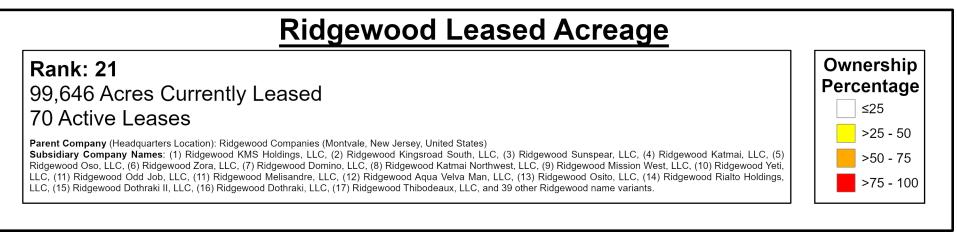
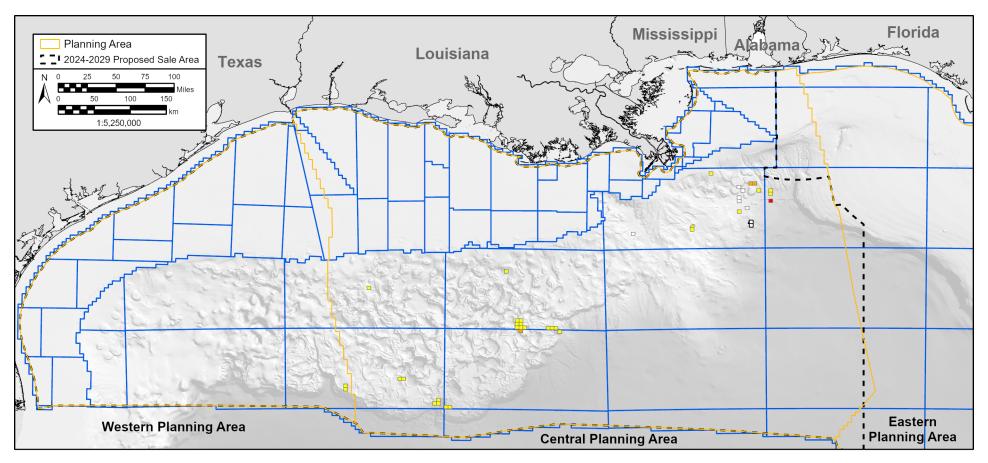


Figure 24. Ridgewood's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



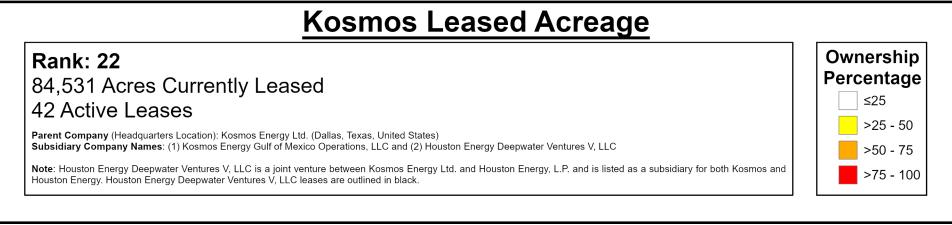
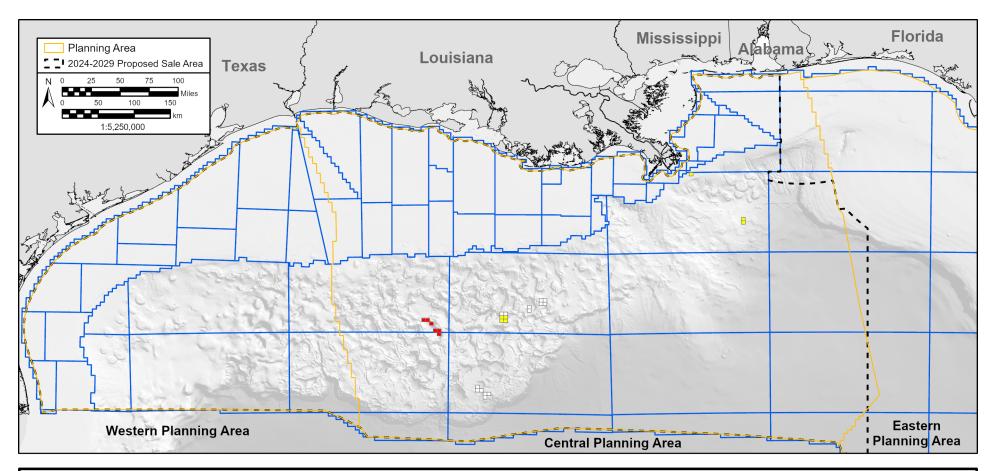


Figure 25. Kosmos' leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



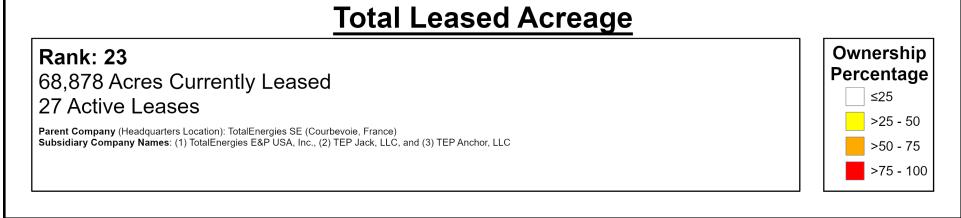
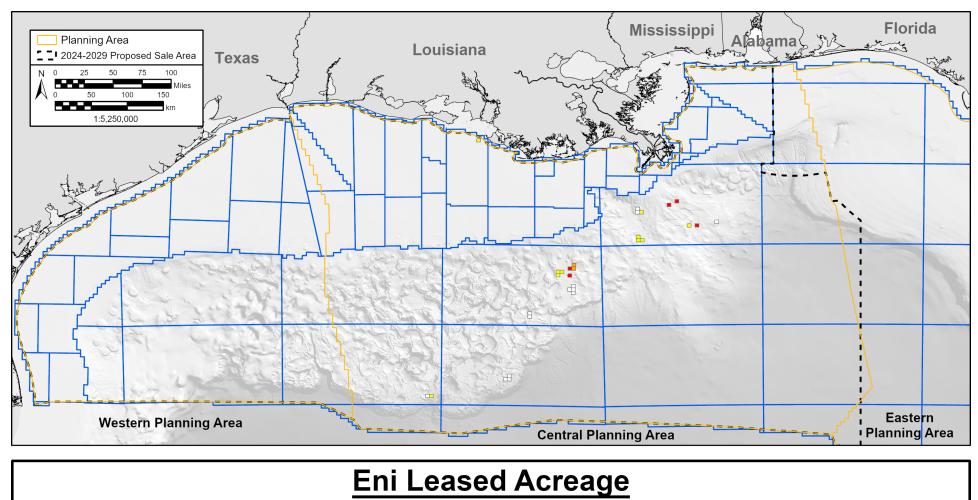


Figure 26. Total's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



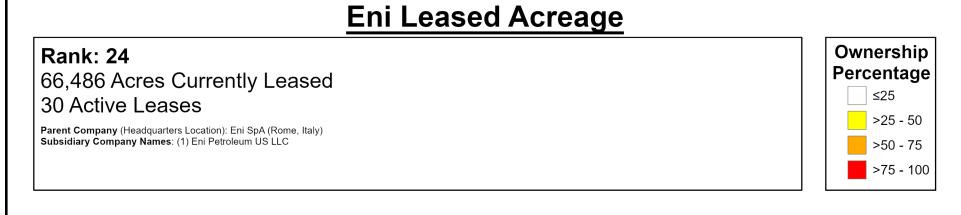
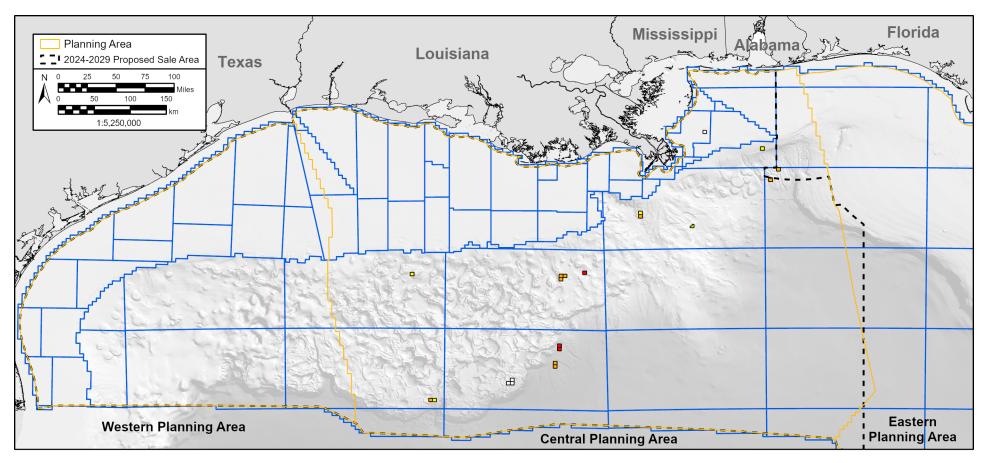


Figure 27. Eni's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



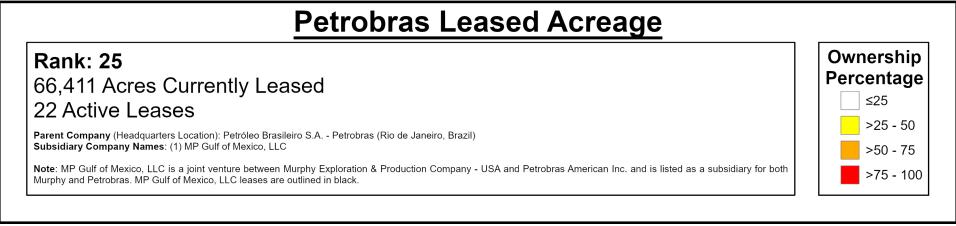
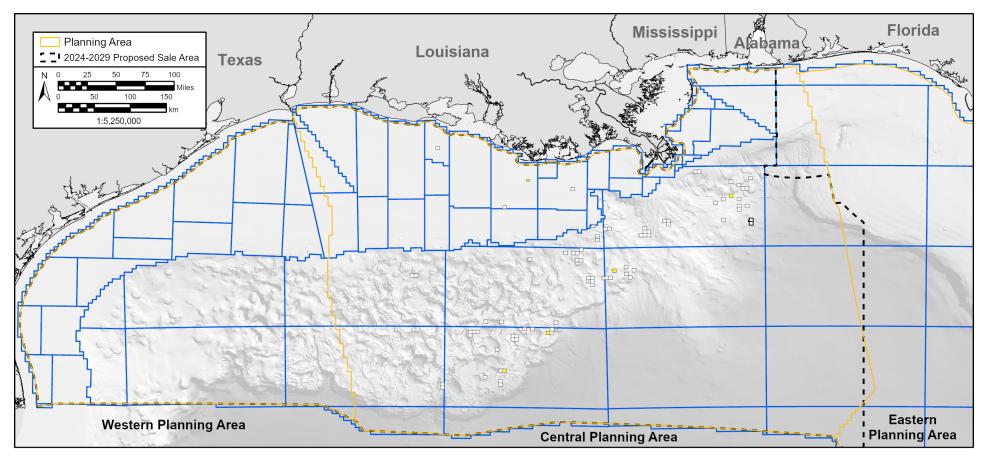


Figure 28. Petrobras' leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



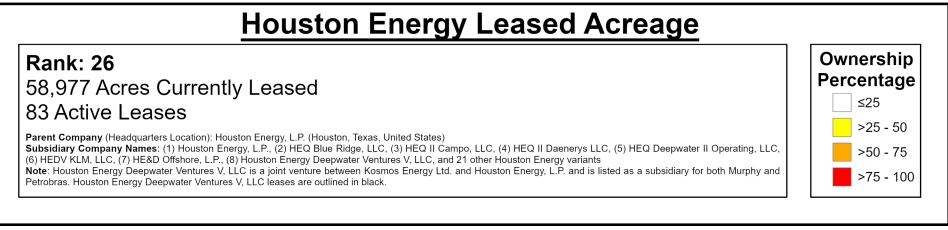
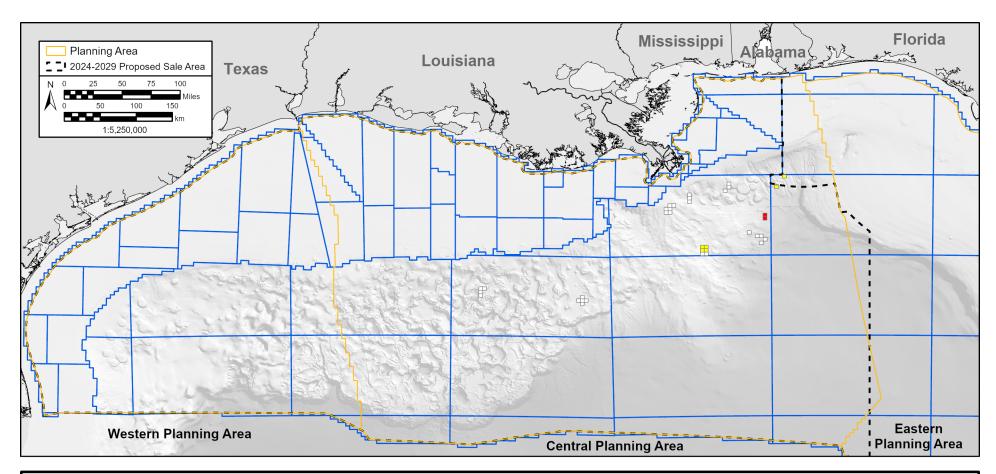


Figure 29. Houston Energy's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



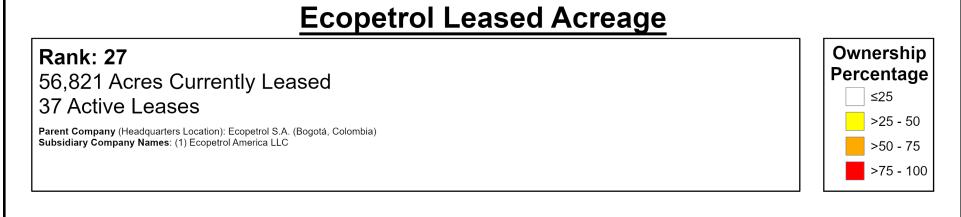
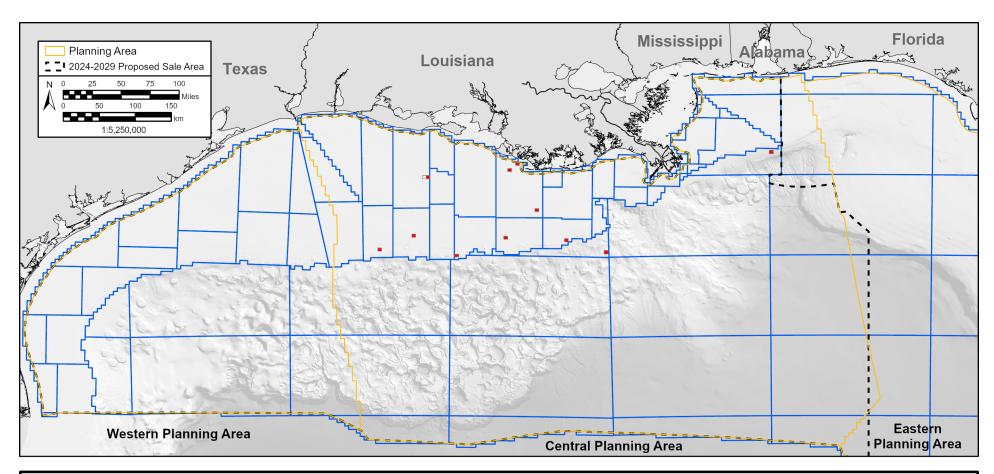


Figure 30. Ecopetrol's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



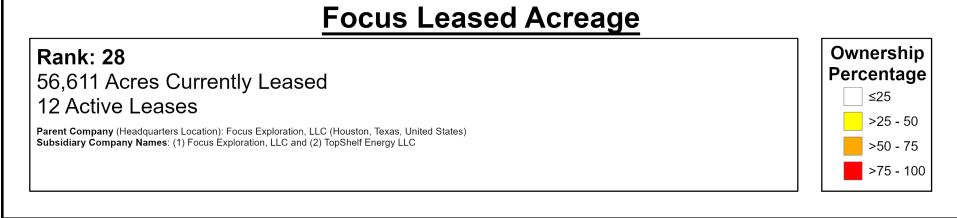
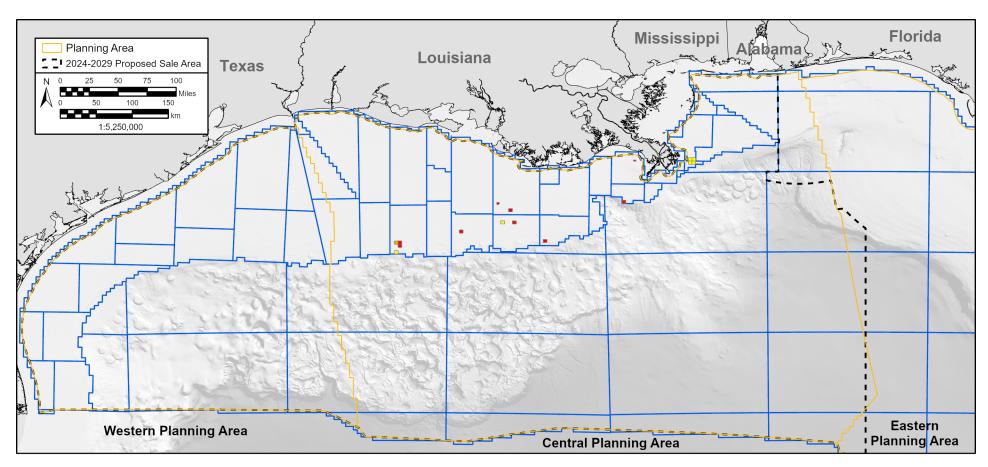


Figure 31. Focus' leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



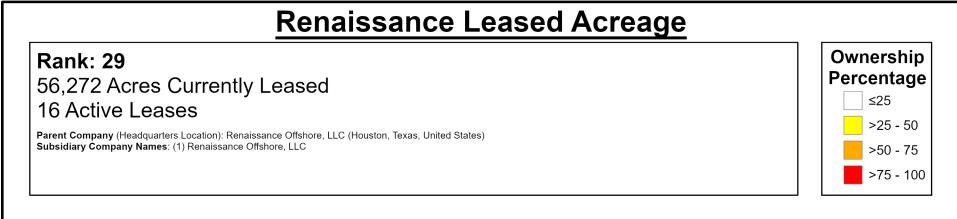
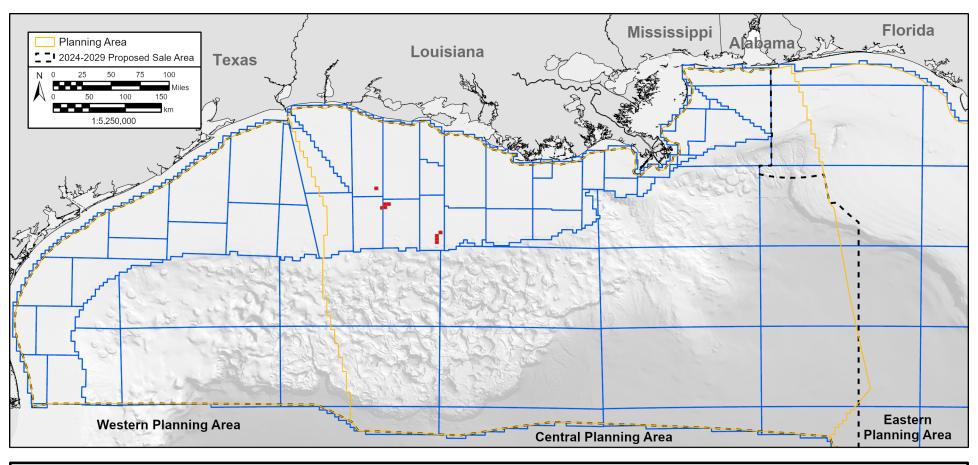


Figure 32. Renaissance's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



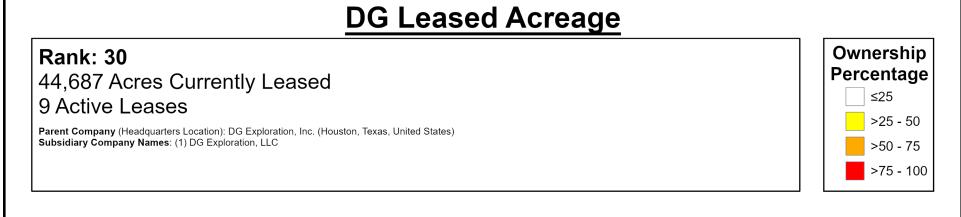


Figure 33. DG's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.

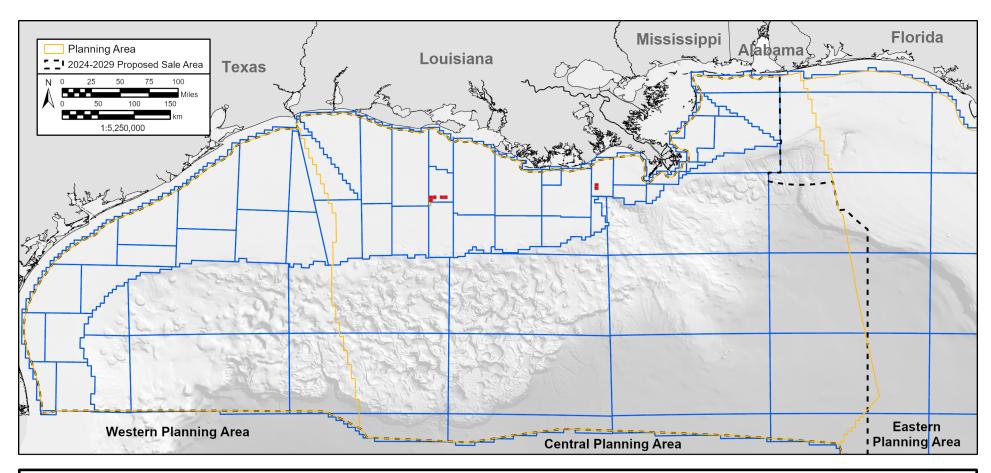
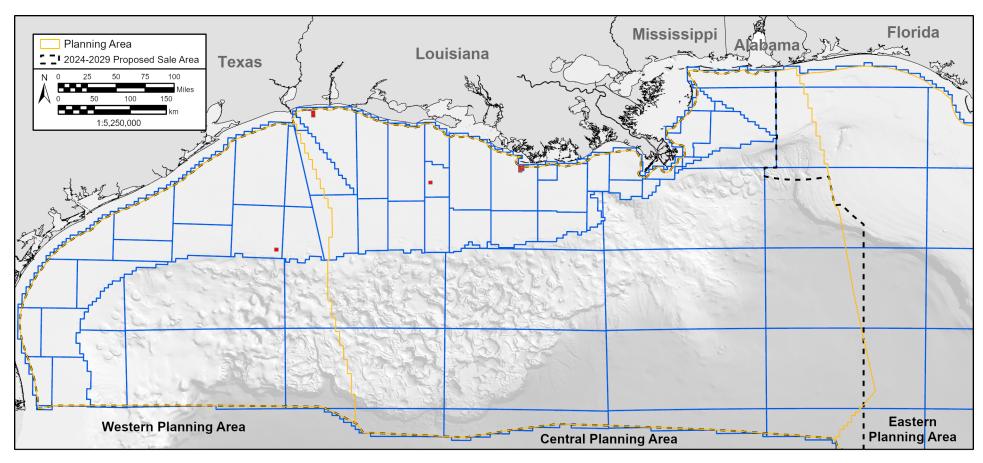




Figure 34. Byron's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



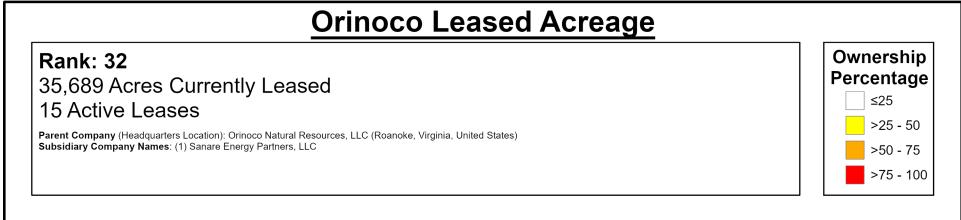
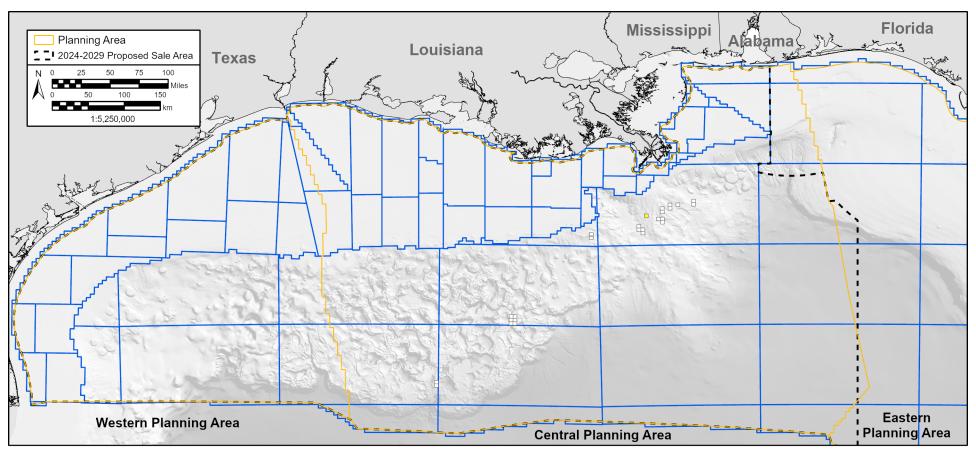


Figure 35. Orinoco's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



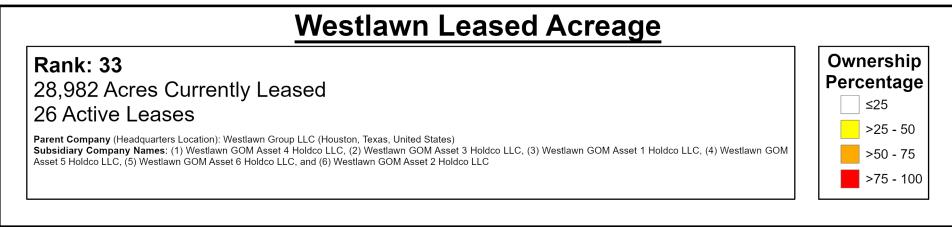


Figure 36. Westlawn's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.

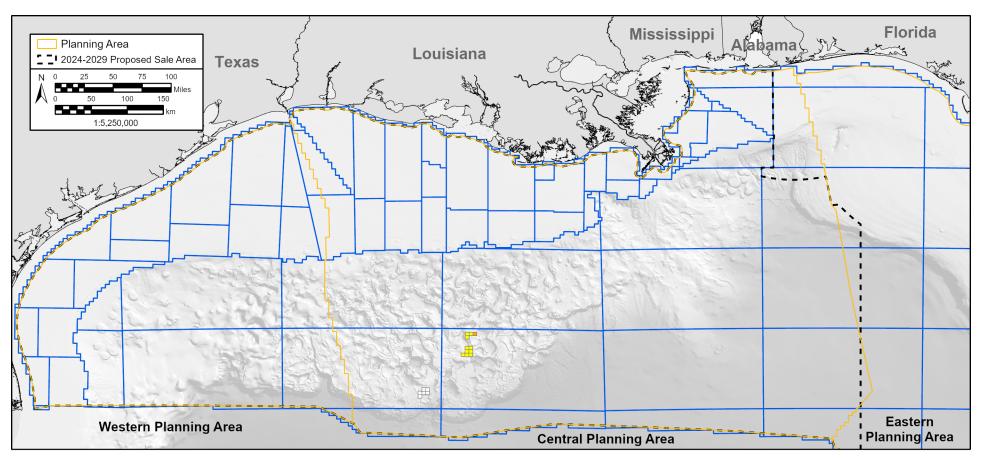
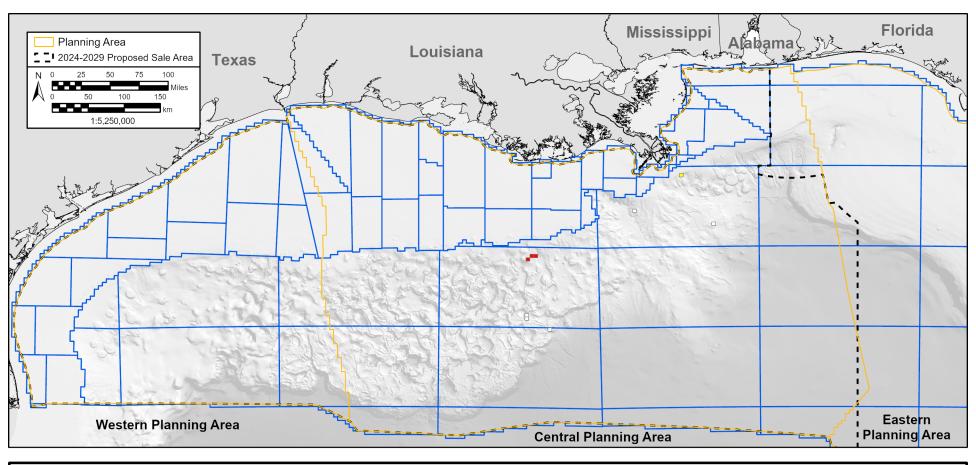




Figure 37. Navitas' leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



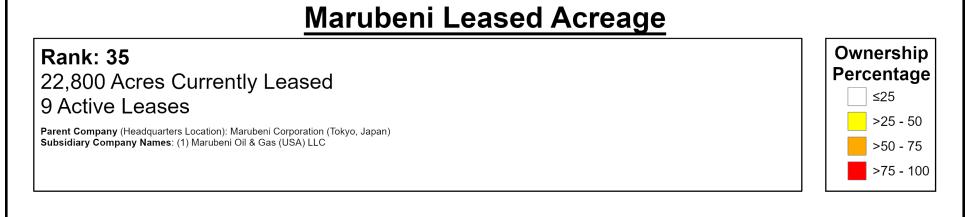
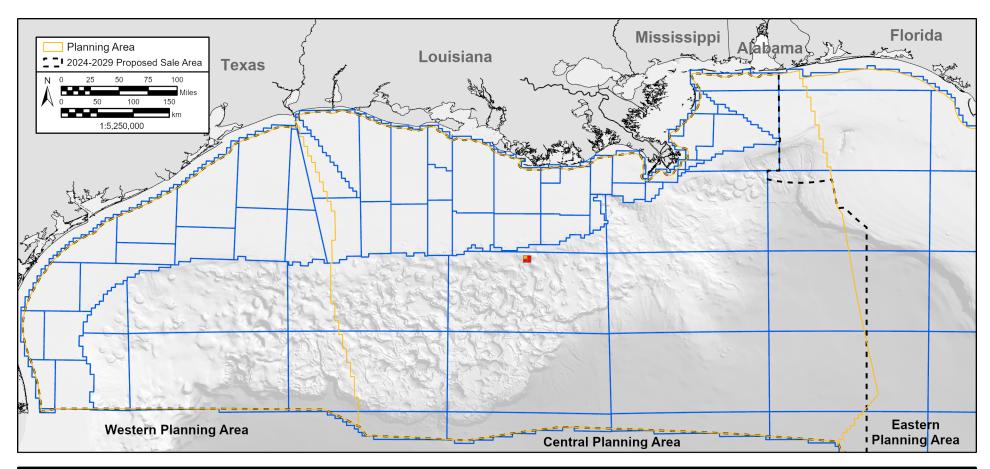


Figure 38. Marubeni's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



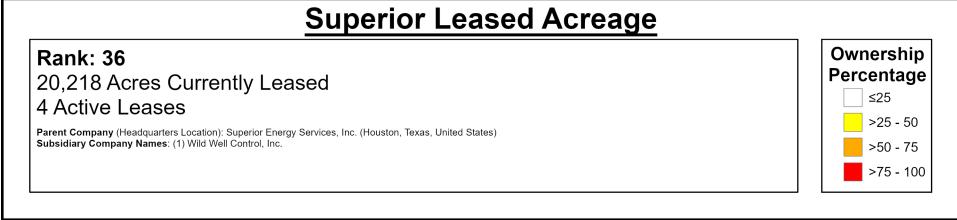
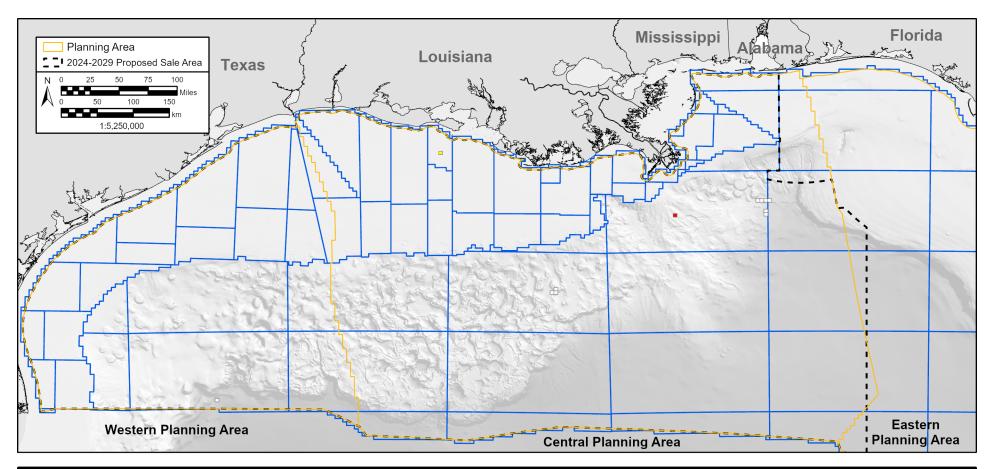


Figure 39. Superior's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



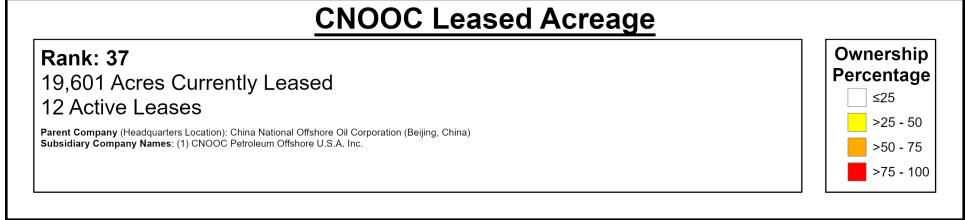
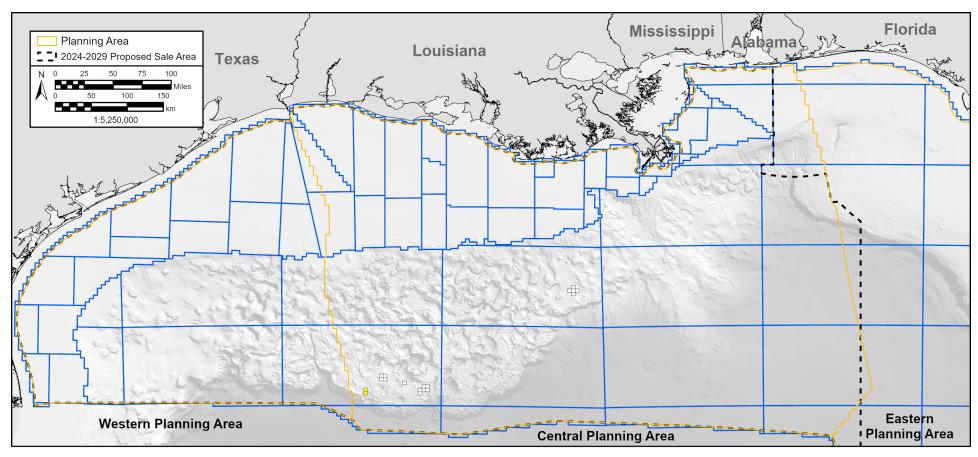


Figure 40. CNOOC's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



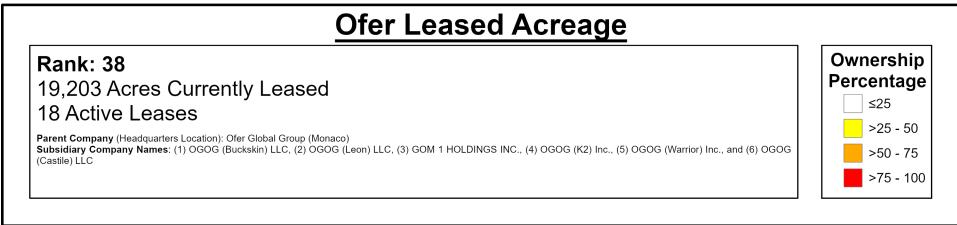
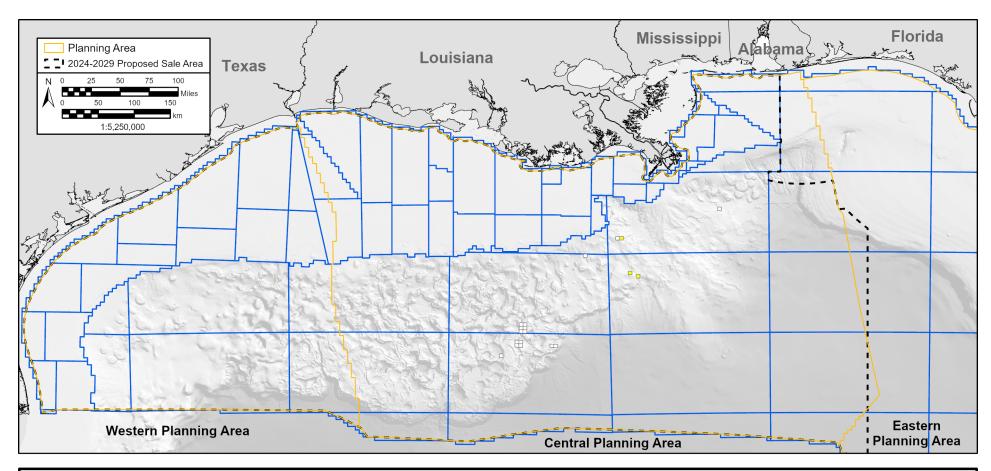


Figure 41. Ofer's leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.



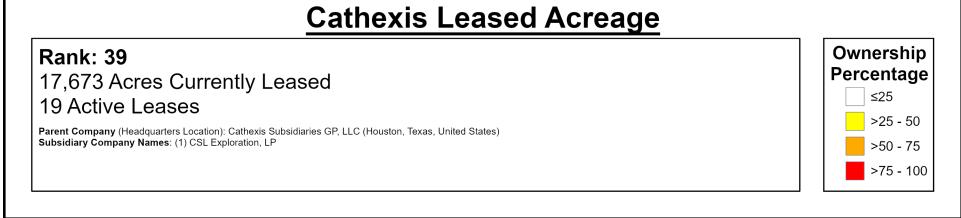


Figure 42. Cathexis' leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.

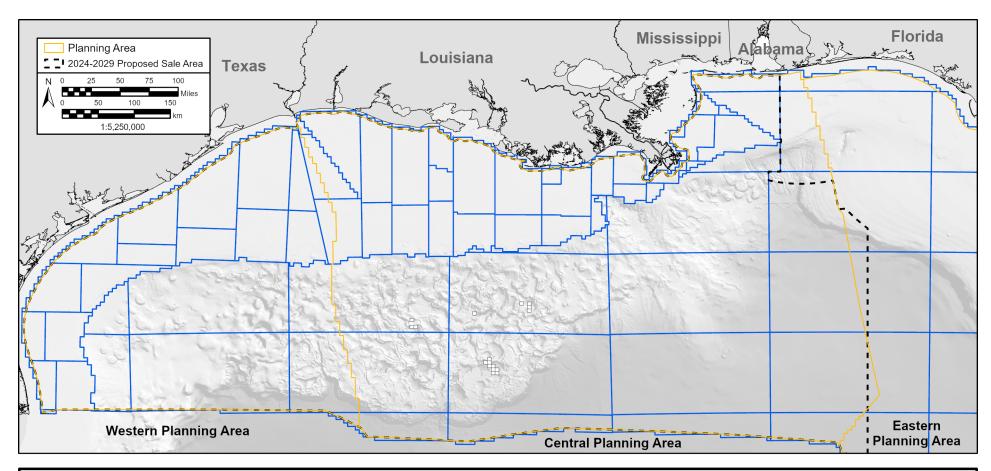




Figure 43. Petronas' leased acreage in the Gulf of America, 2025.

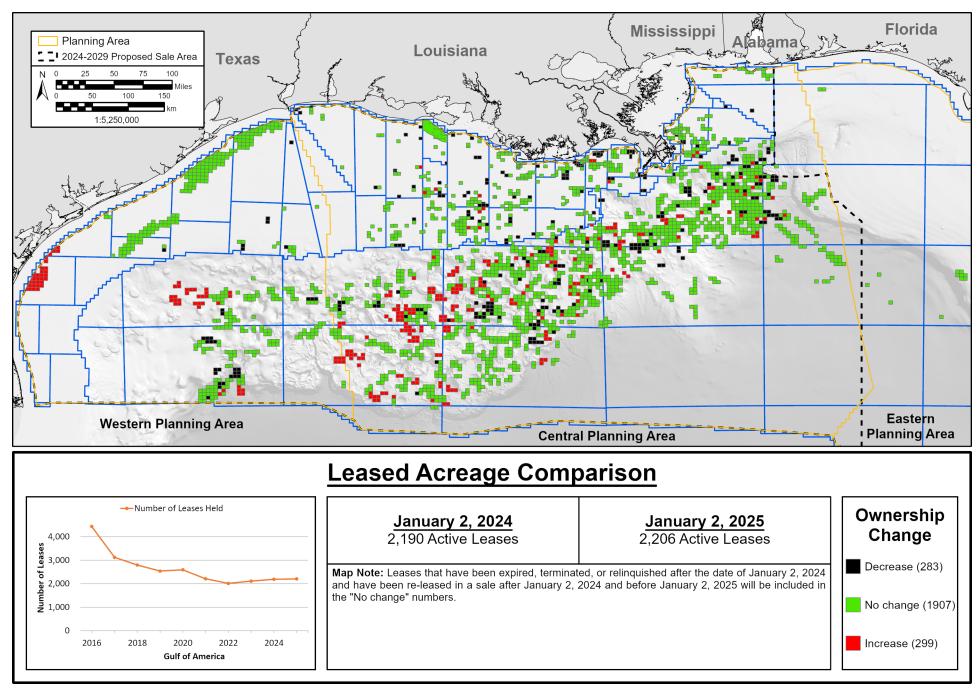


Figure 44. Comparison of the leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

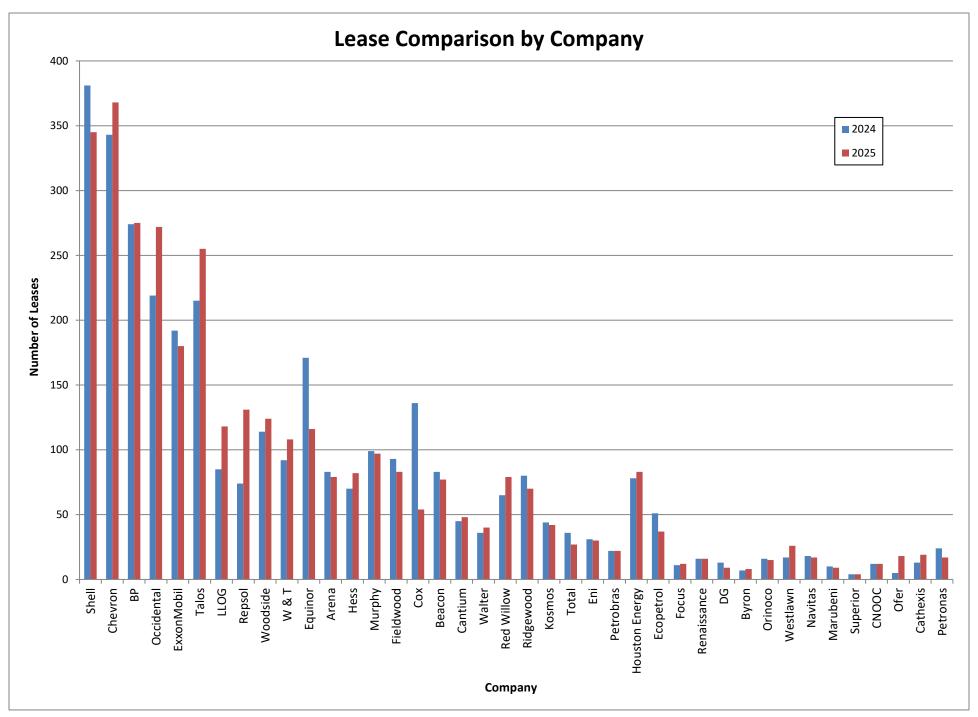


Figure 45. The number of active leases in 2024 and 2025 for the top 40 companies by leased acreage in the Gulf of America.

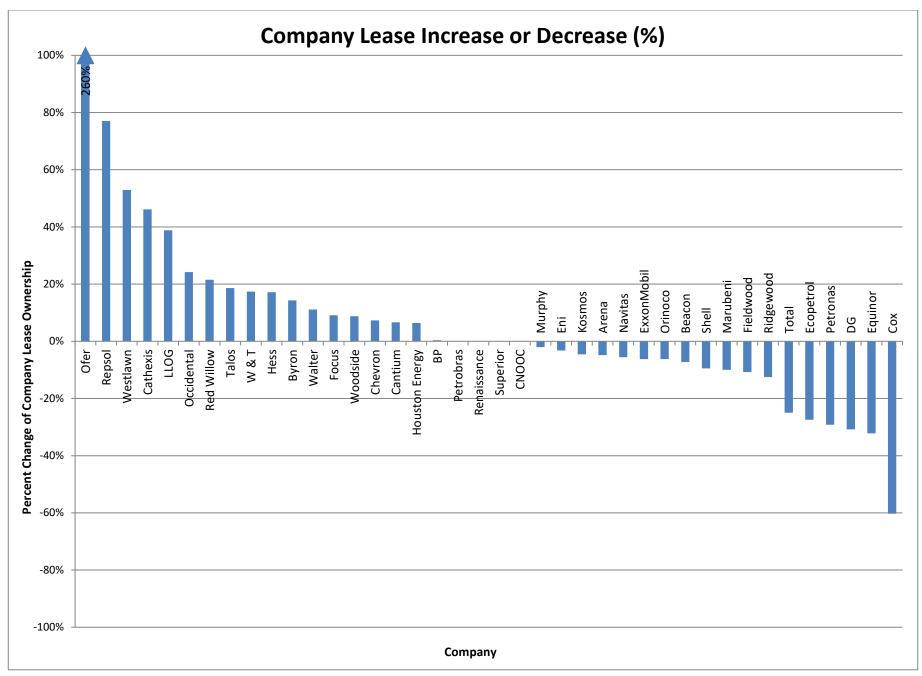


Figure 46. The percentage (%) change in the number of leases from 2024 to 2025 for the top 40 companies in the Gulf of America.

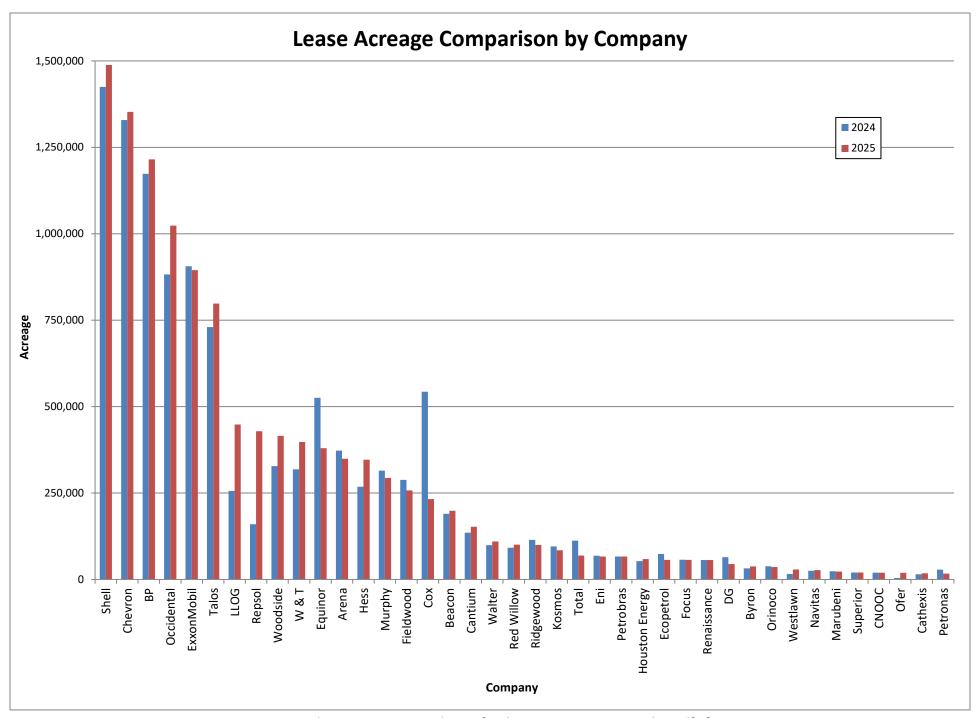


Figure 47. Leased acreage in 2024 and 2025 for the top 40 companies in the Gulf of America.

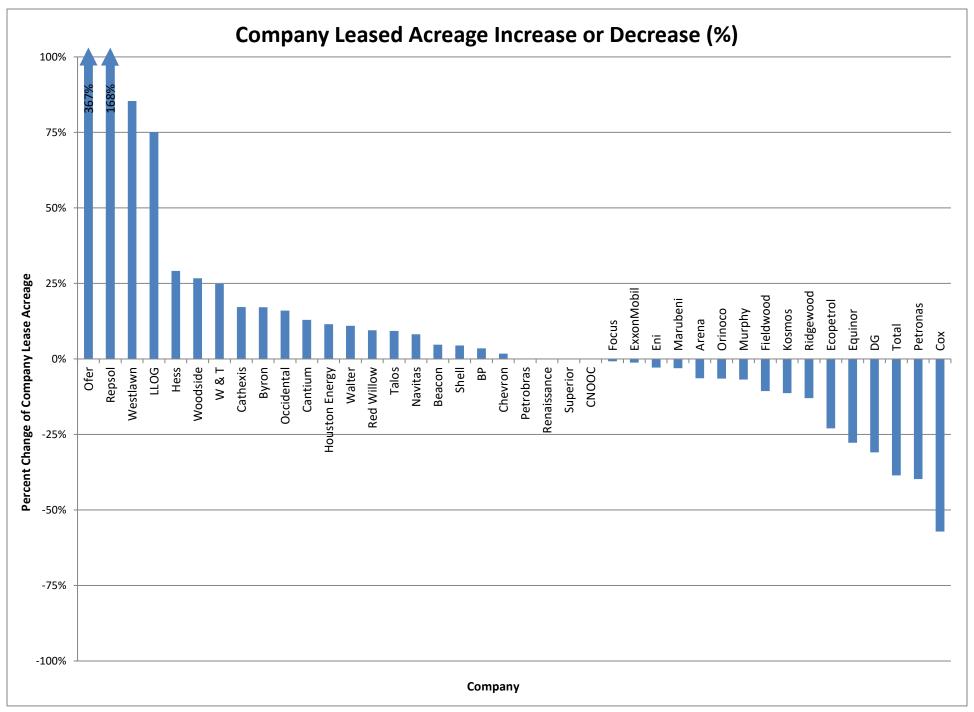


Figure 48. The percentage (%) change of leased acreage from 2024 to 2025 for the top 40 companies in the Gulf of America.

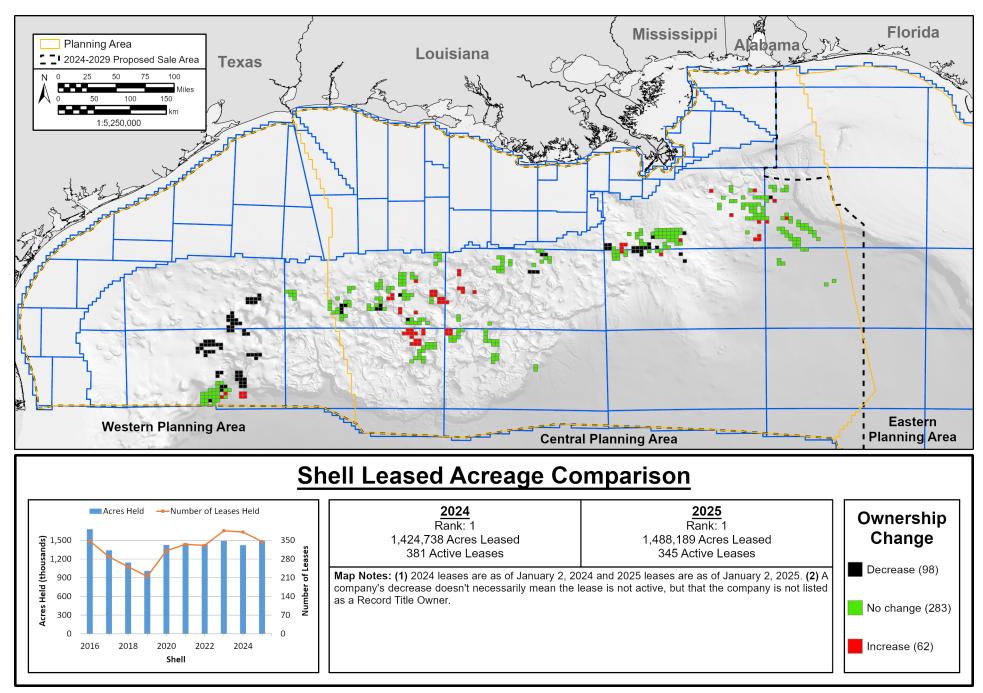


Figure 49. Comparison of Shell's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

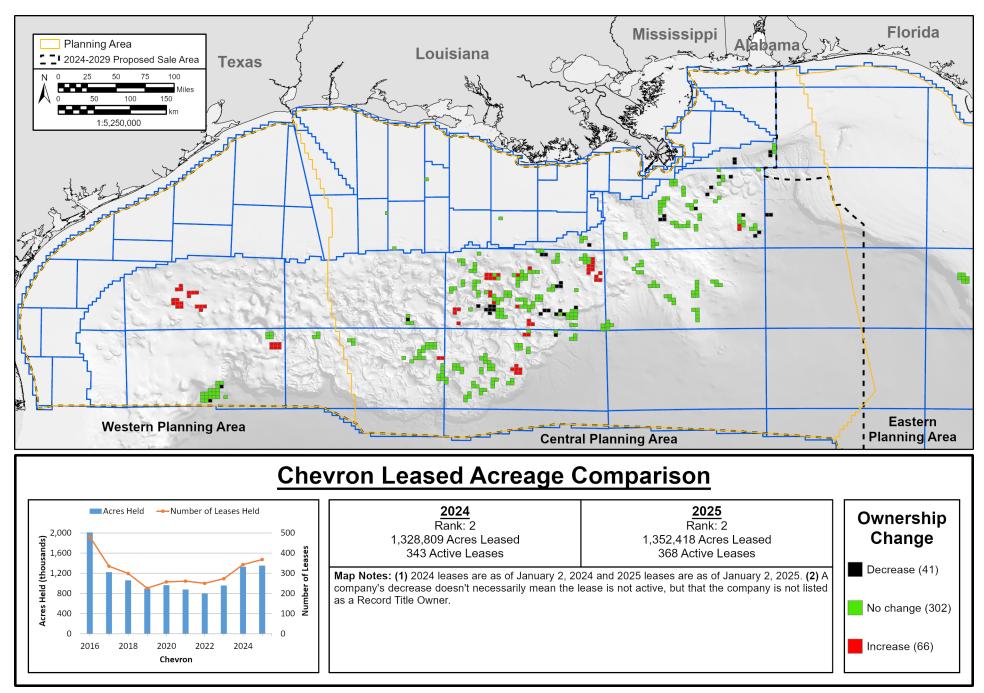


Figure 50. Comparison of Chevron's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

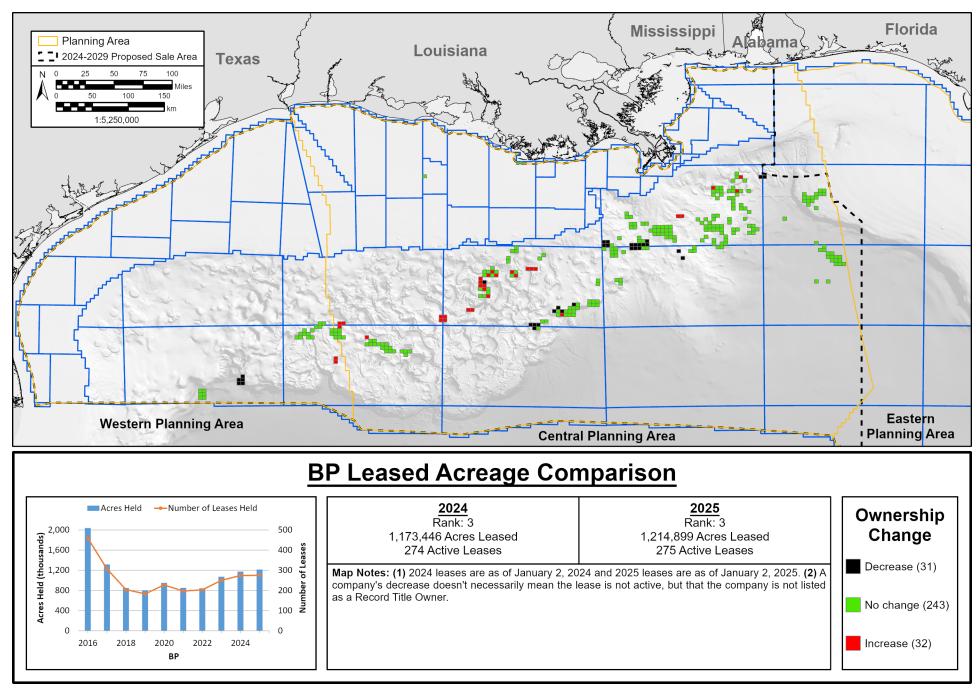


Figure 51. Comparison of BP's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

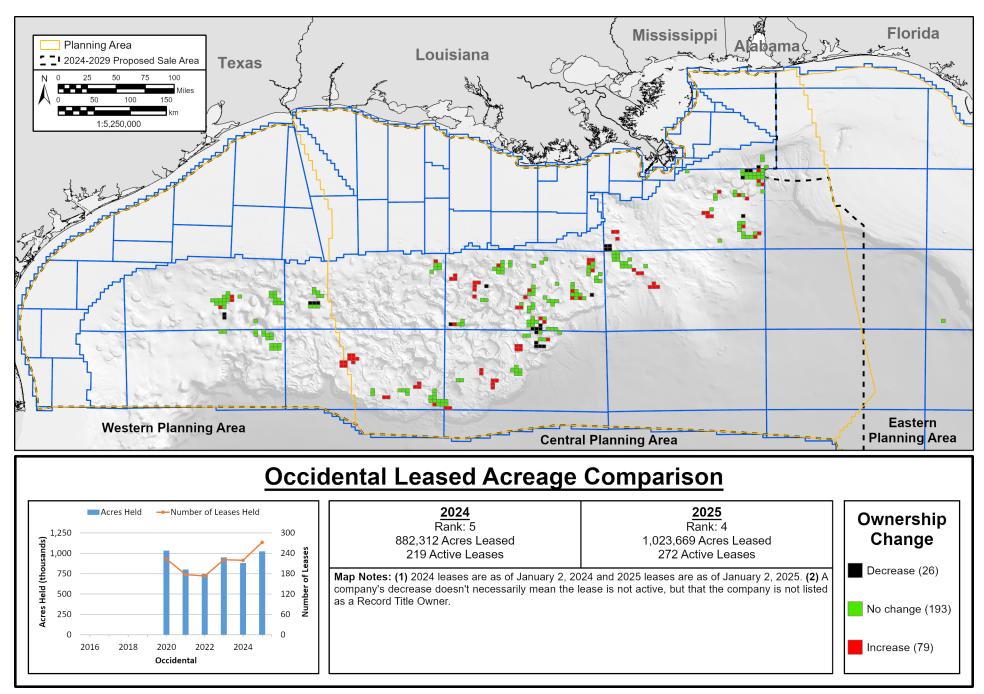


Figure 52. Comparison of Occidental's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

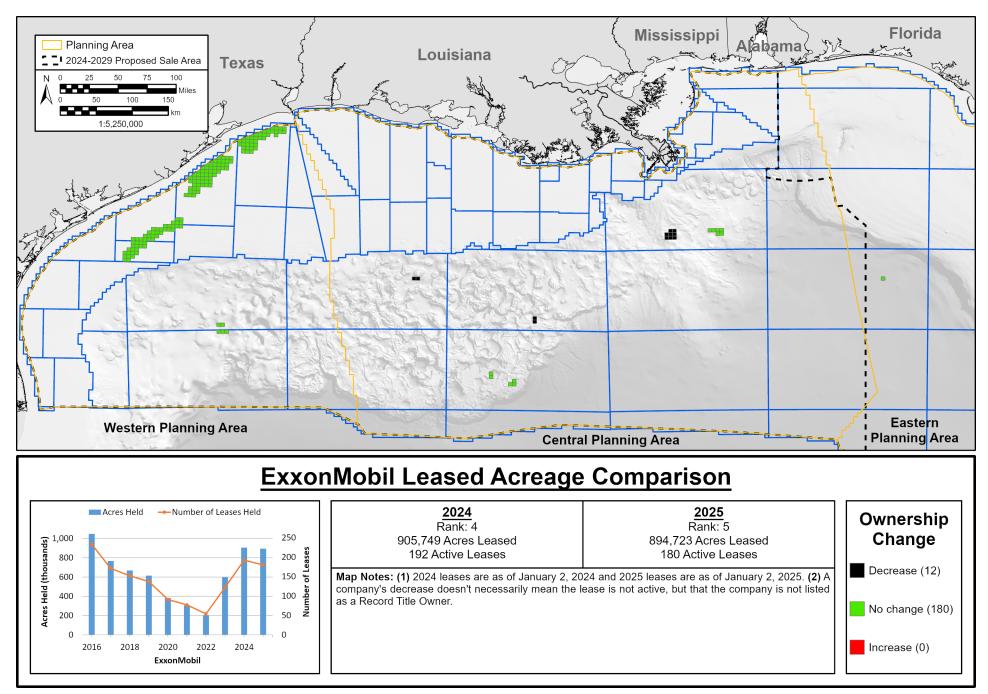


Figure 53. Comparison of ExxonMobil's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

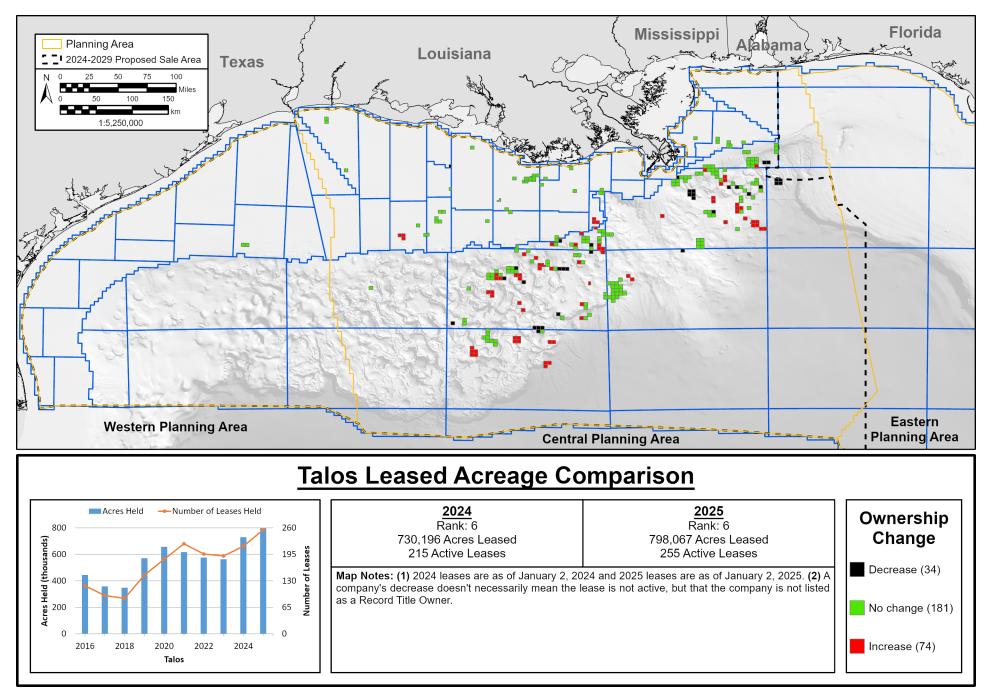


Figure 54. Comparison of Talos' leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

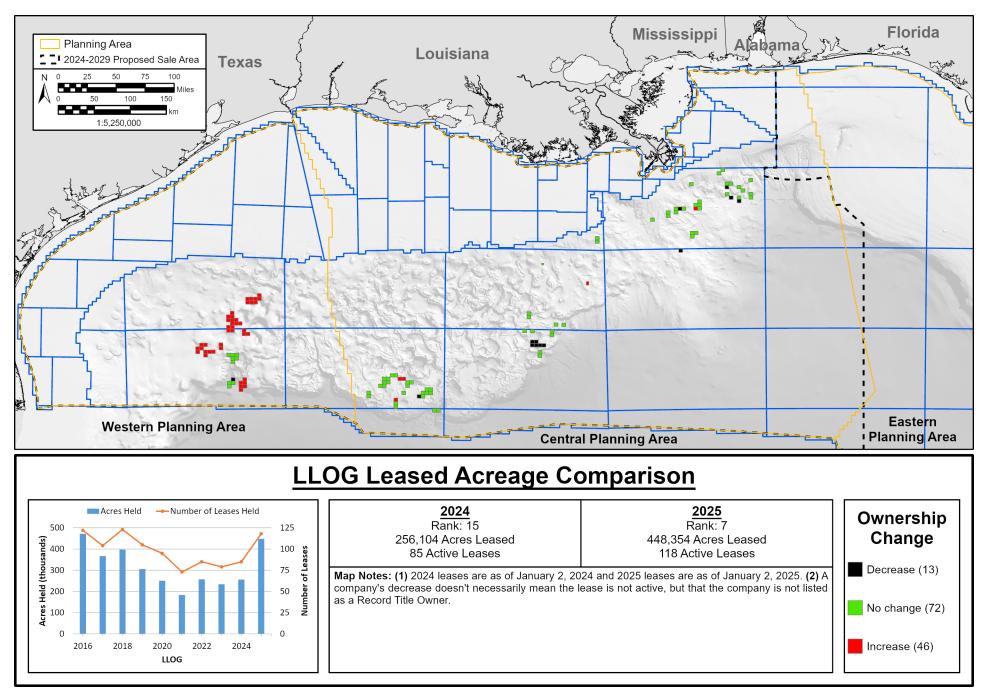


Figure 55. Comparison of LLOG's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

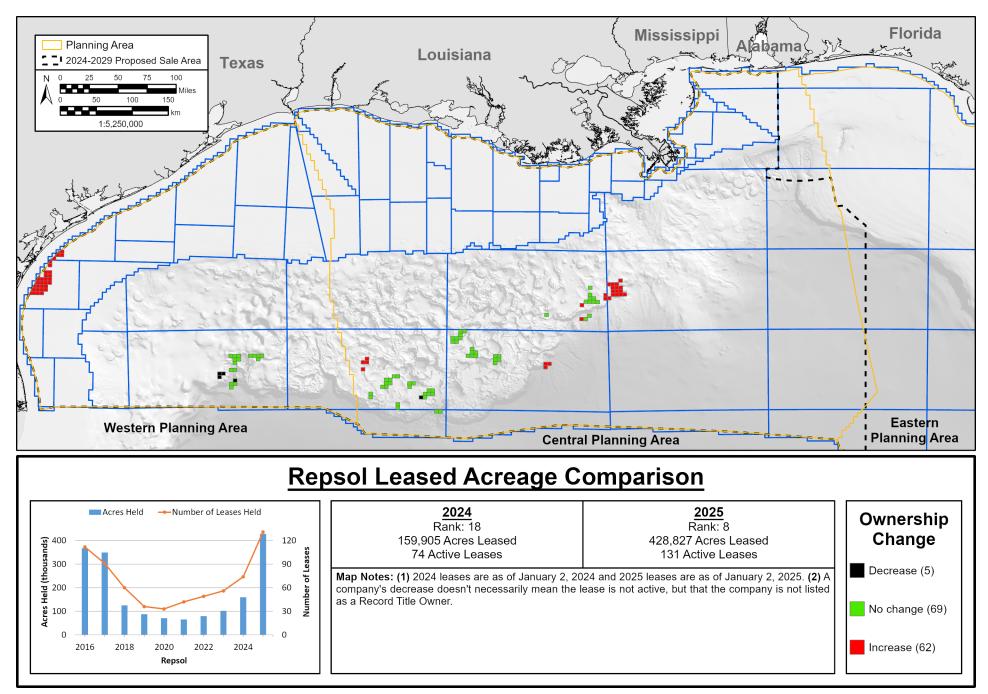


Figure 56. Comparison of Repsol's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

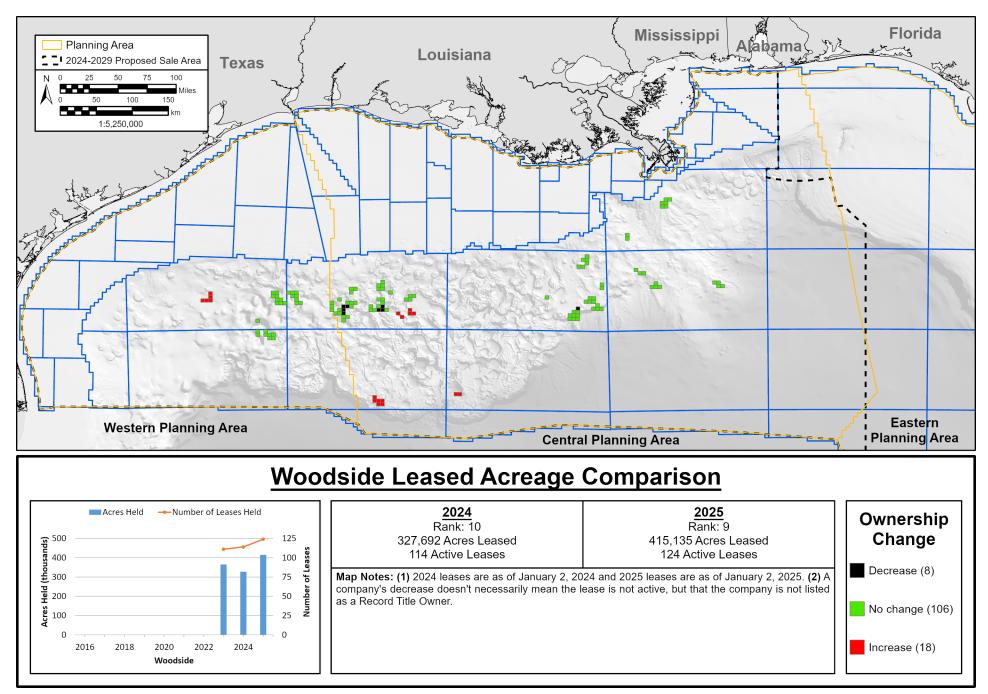


Figure 57. Comparison of Woodside's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

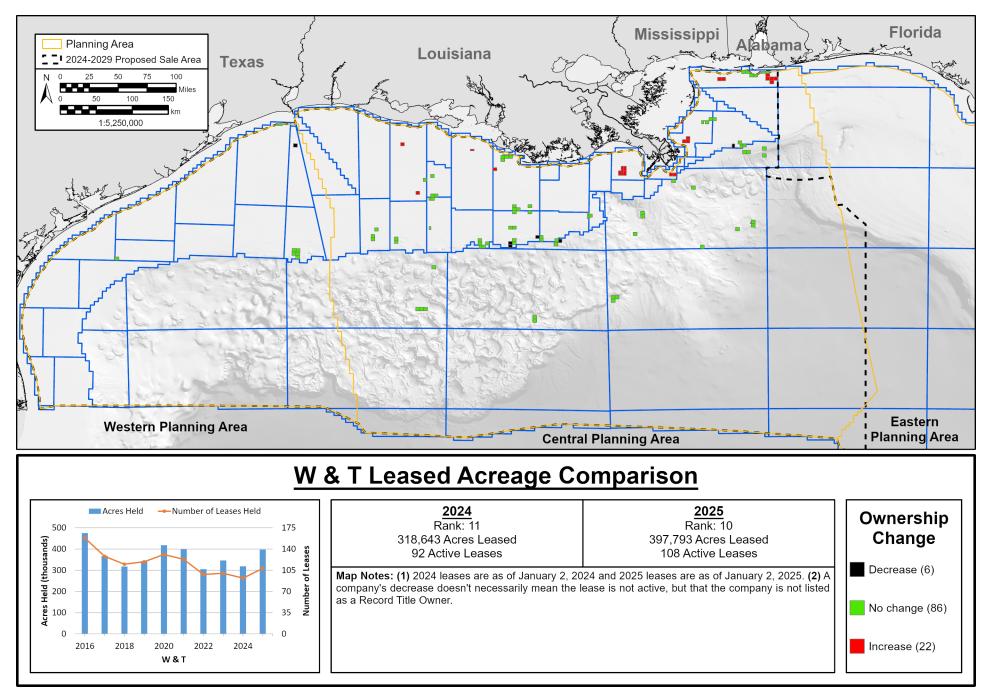


Figure 58. Comparison of W&T's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

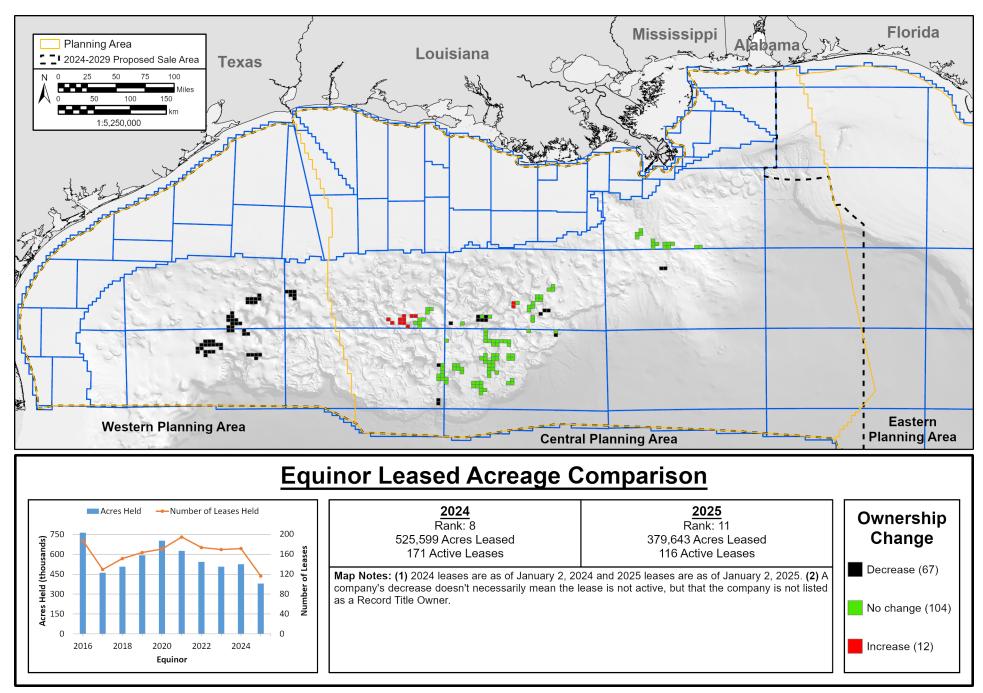


Figure 59. Comparison of Equinor's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

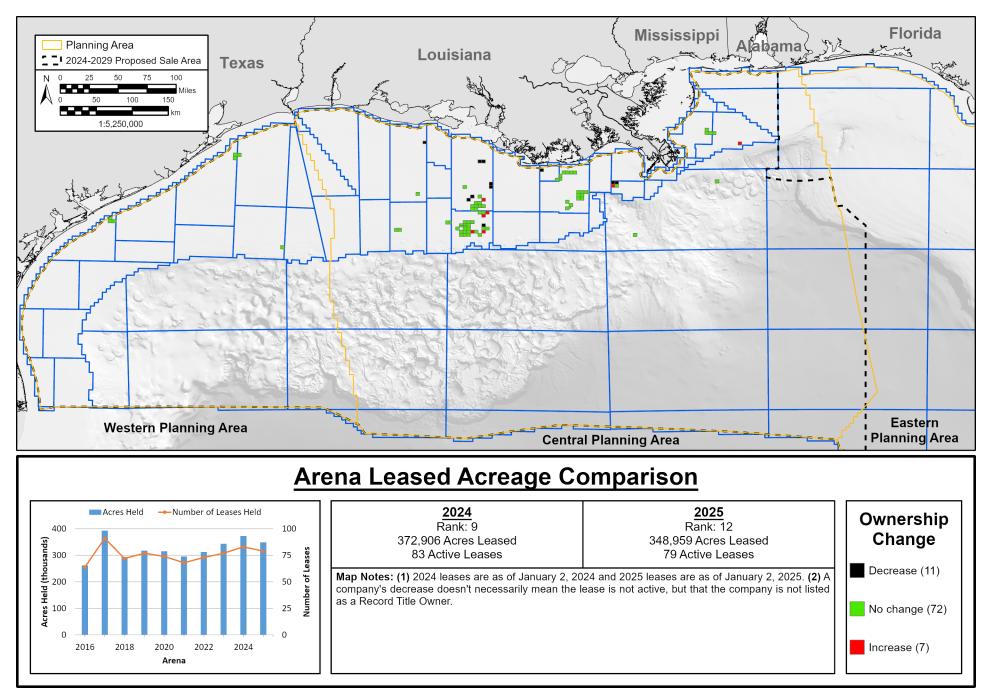


Figure 60. Comparison of Arena's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

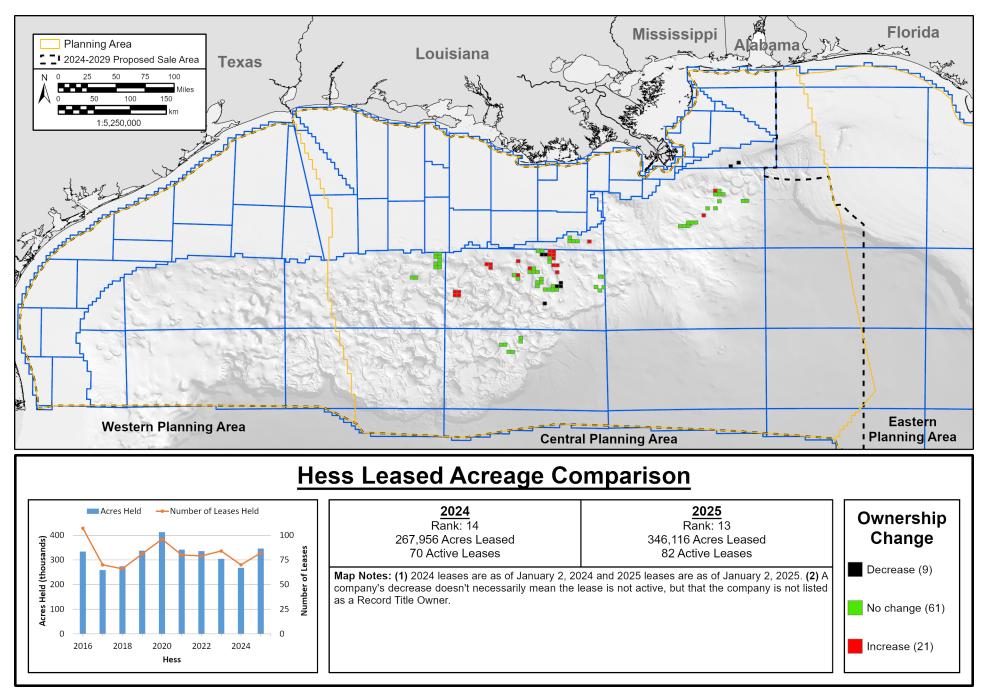


Figure 61. Comparison of Hess' leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

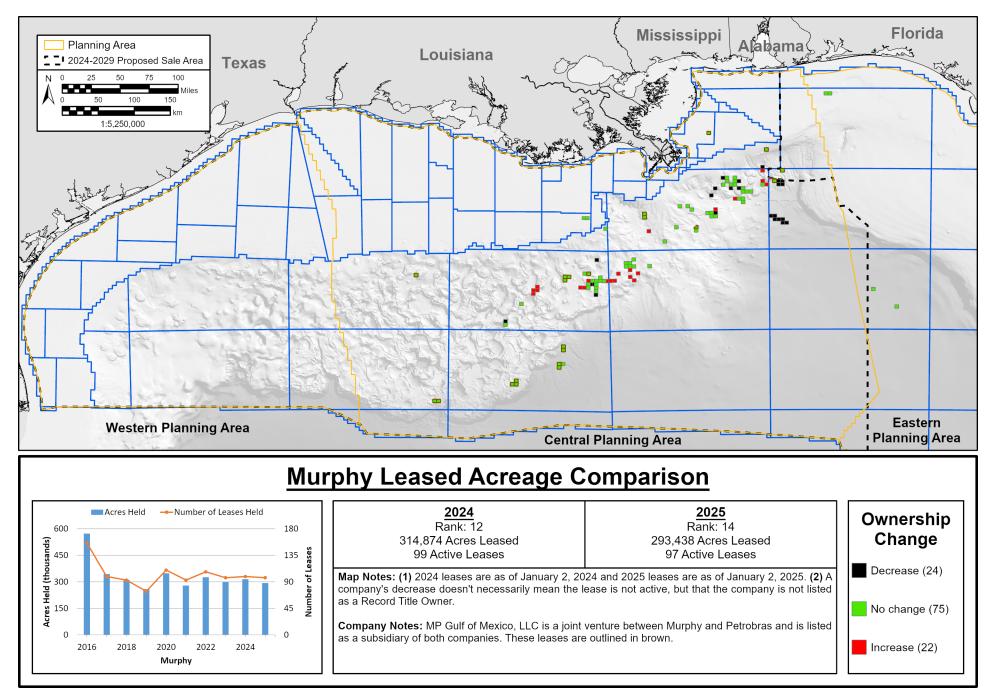


Figure 62. Comparison of Murphy's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

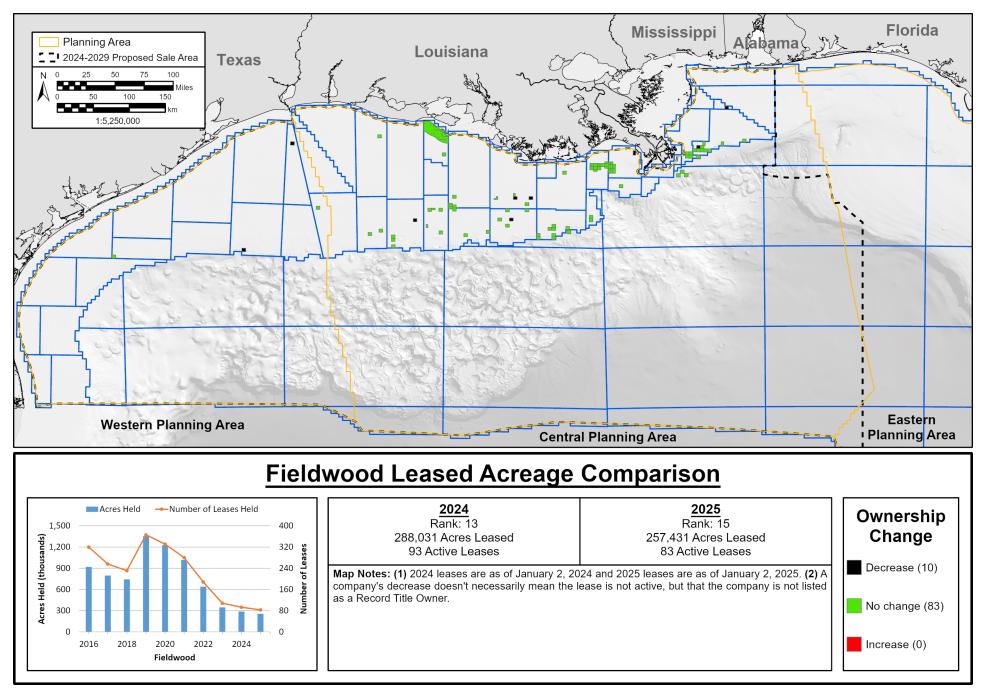


Figure 63. Comparison of Fieldwood's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

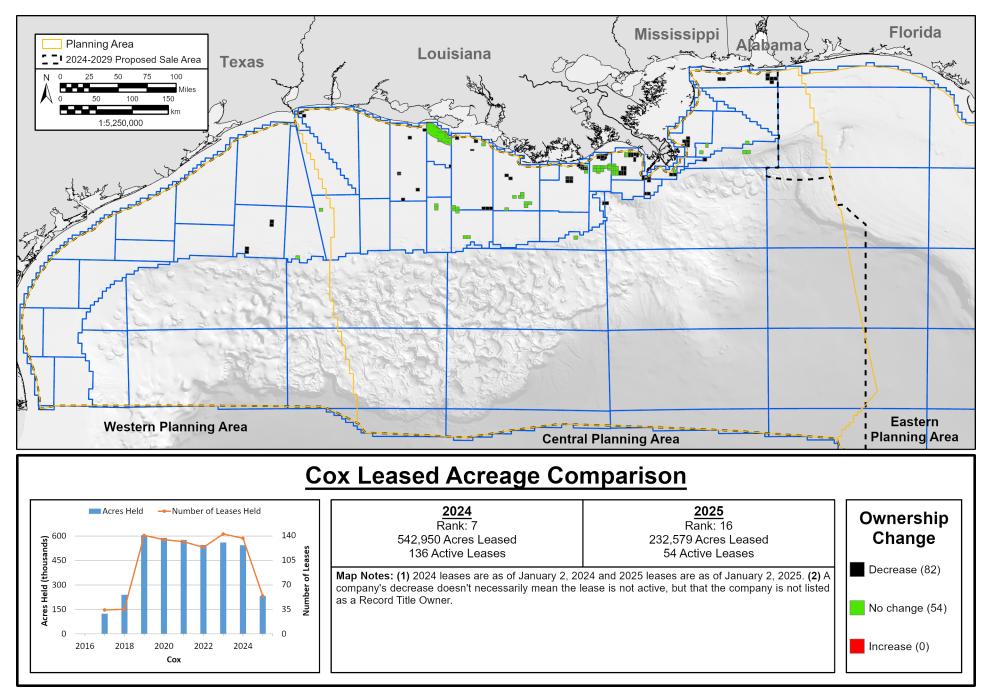


Figure 64. Comparison of Cox's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

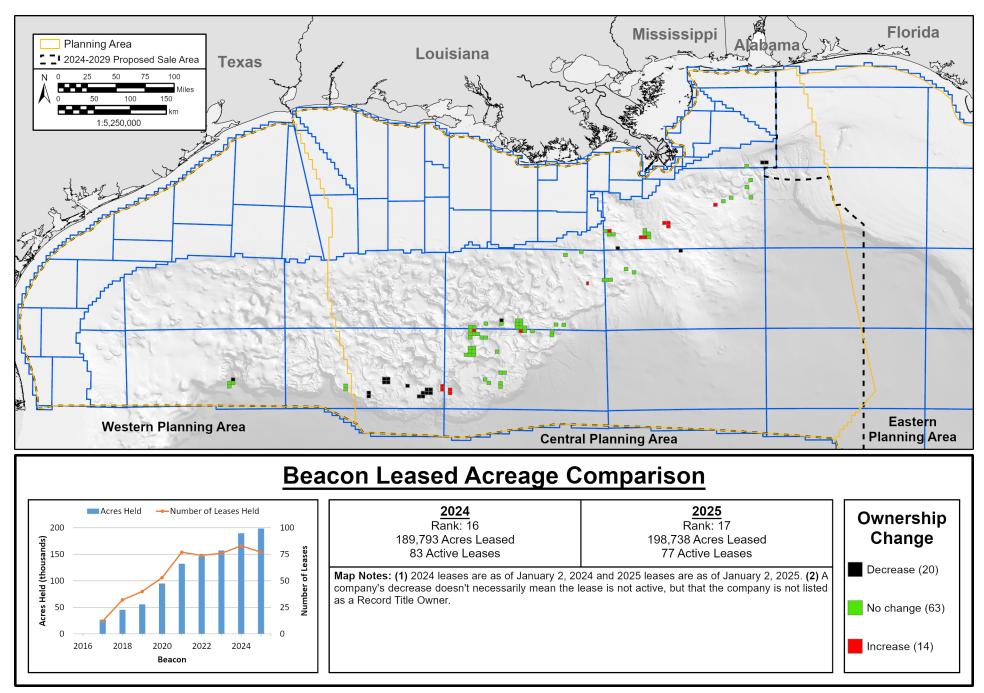


Figure 65. Comparison of Beacon's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

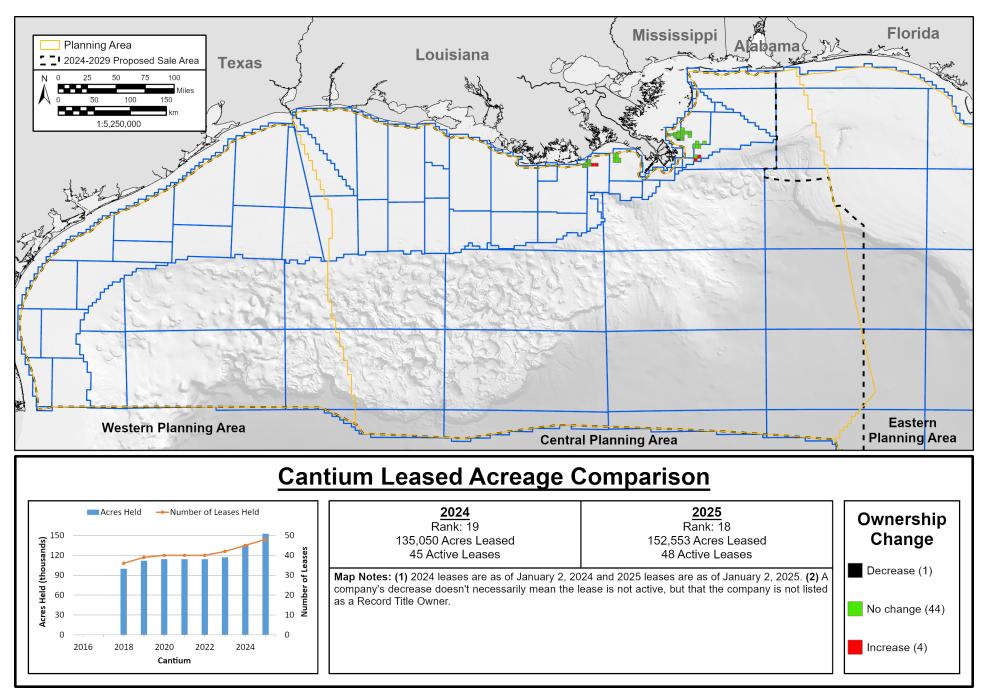


Figure 66. Comparison of Cantium's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

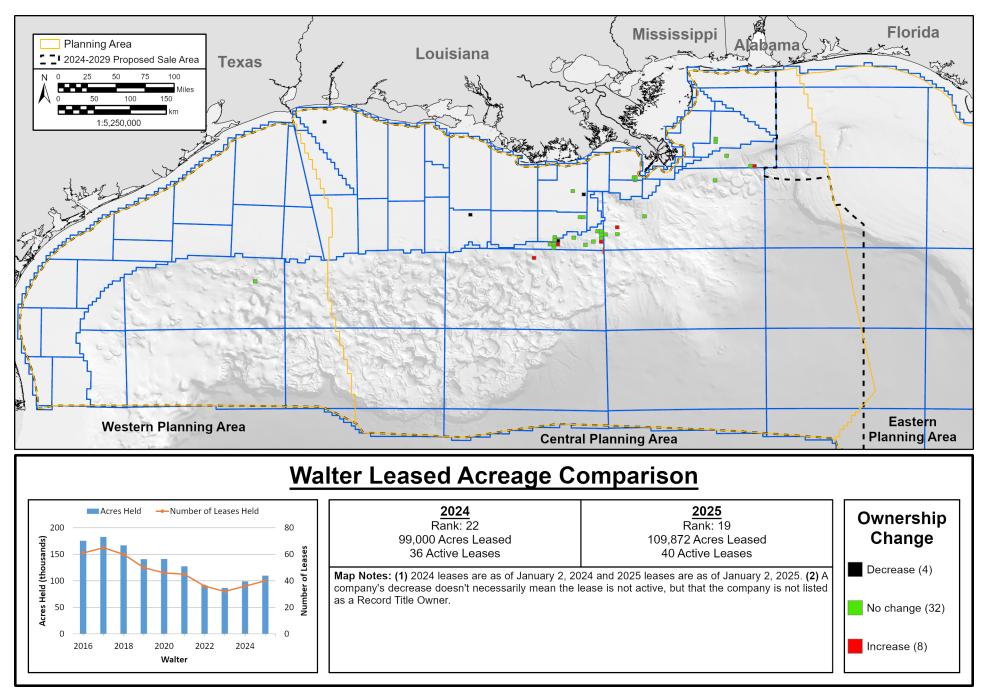


Figure 67. Comparison of Walter's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

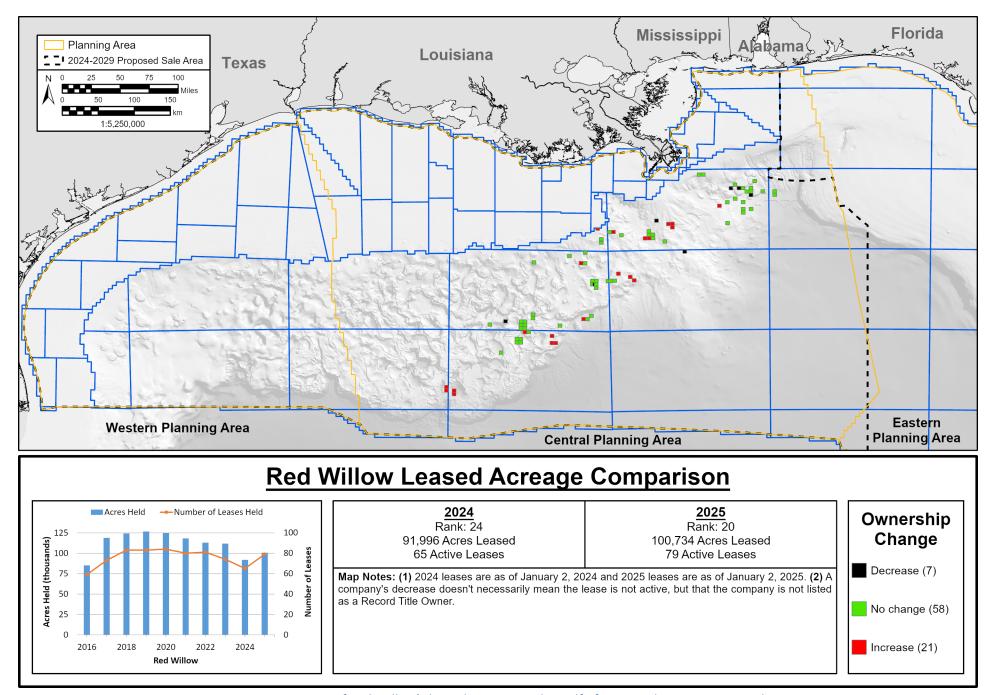


Figure 68. Comparison of Red Willow's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

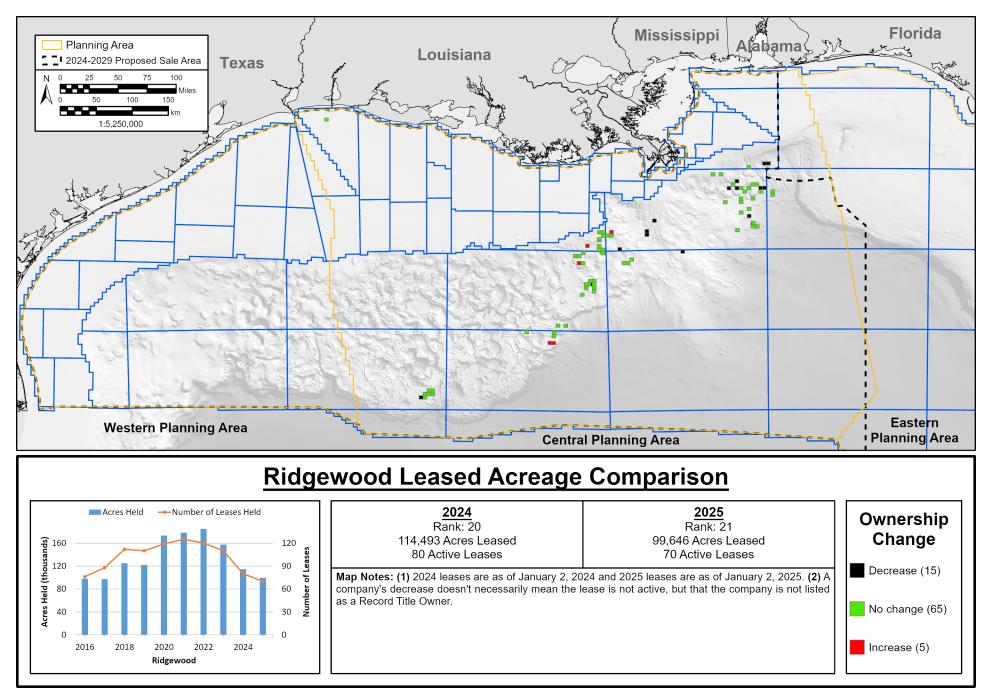


Figure 69. Comparison of Ridgewood's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

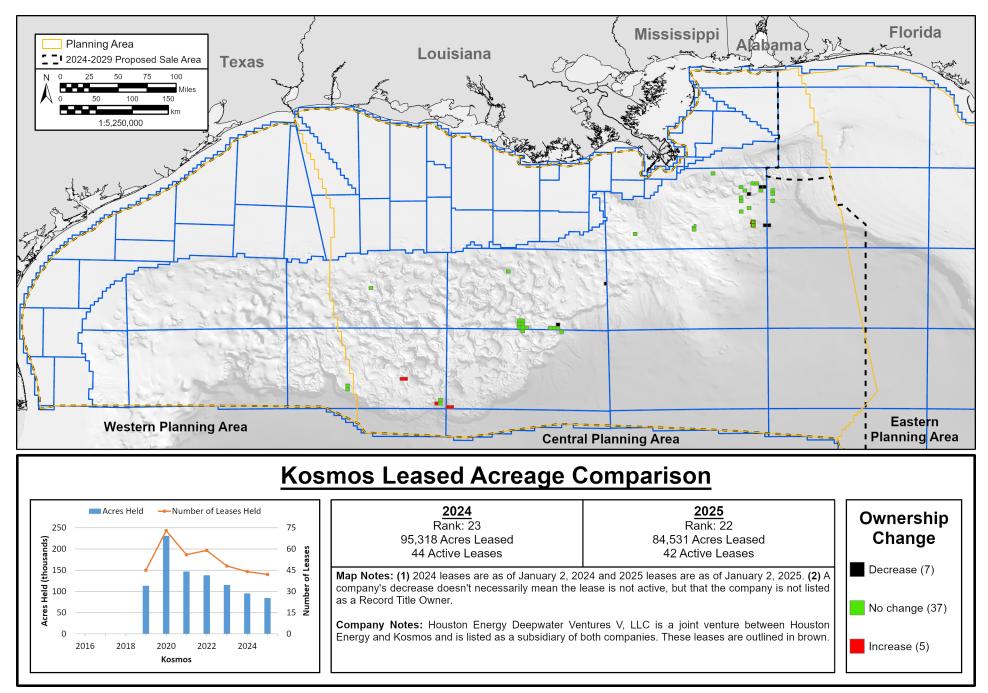


Figure 70. Comparison of Kosmos' leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

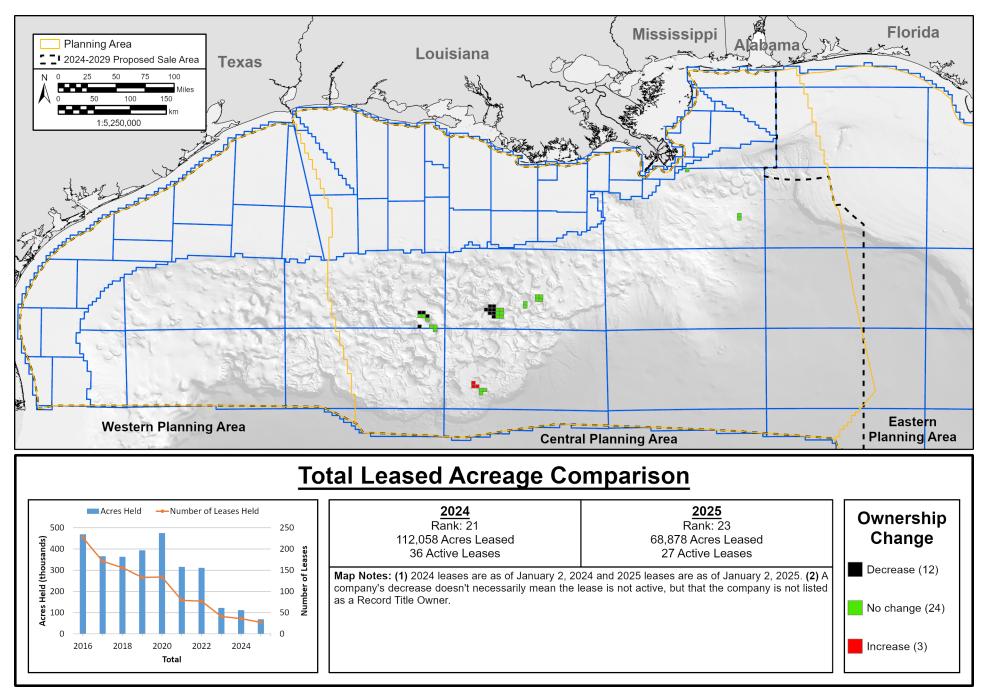


Figure 71. Comparison of Total's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

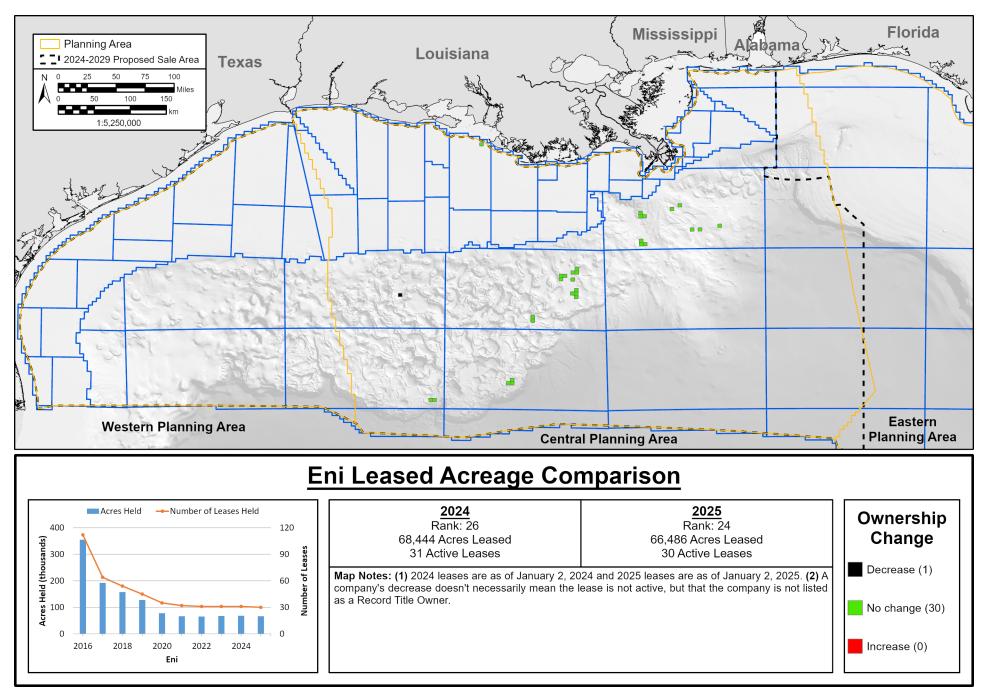


Figure 72. Comparison of Eni's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

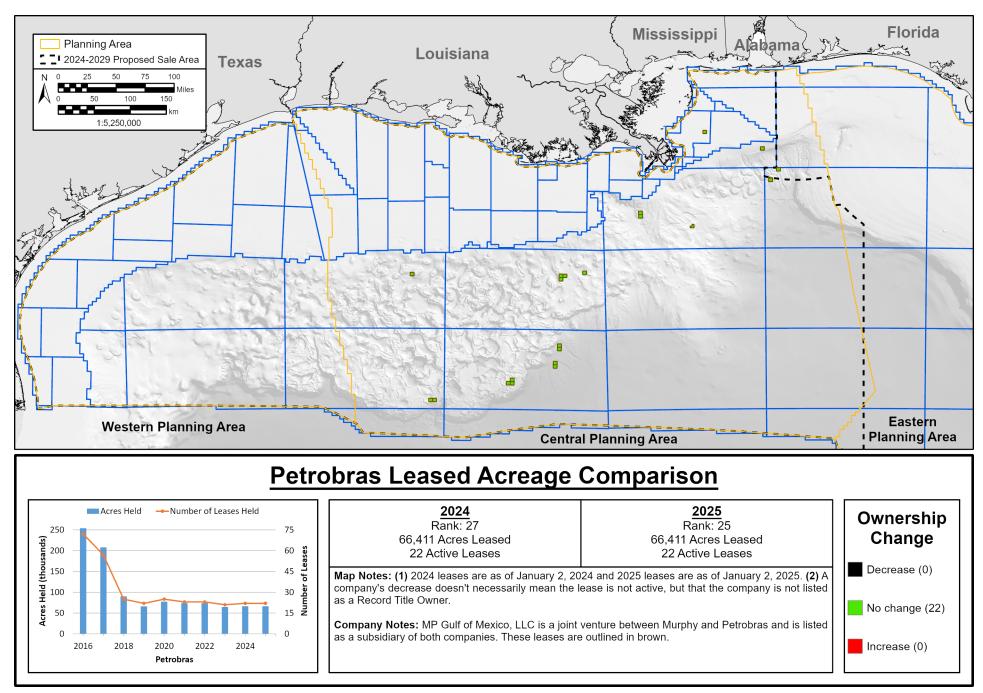


Figure 73. Comparison of Petrobras' leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

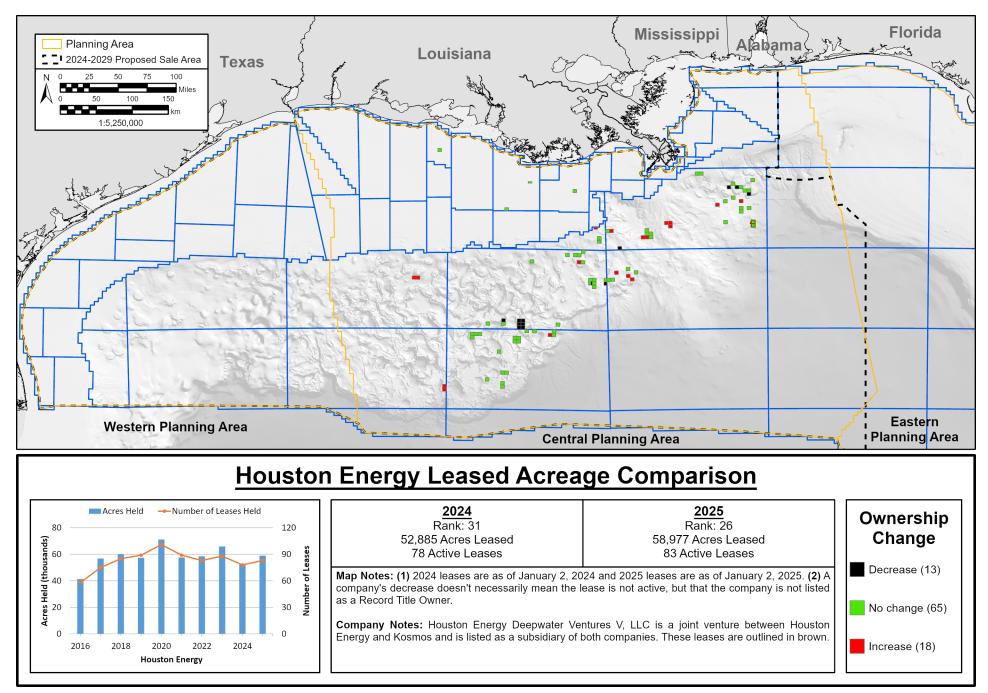


Figure 74. Comparison of Houston Energy's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

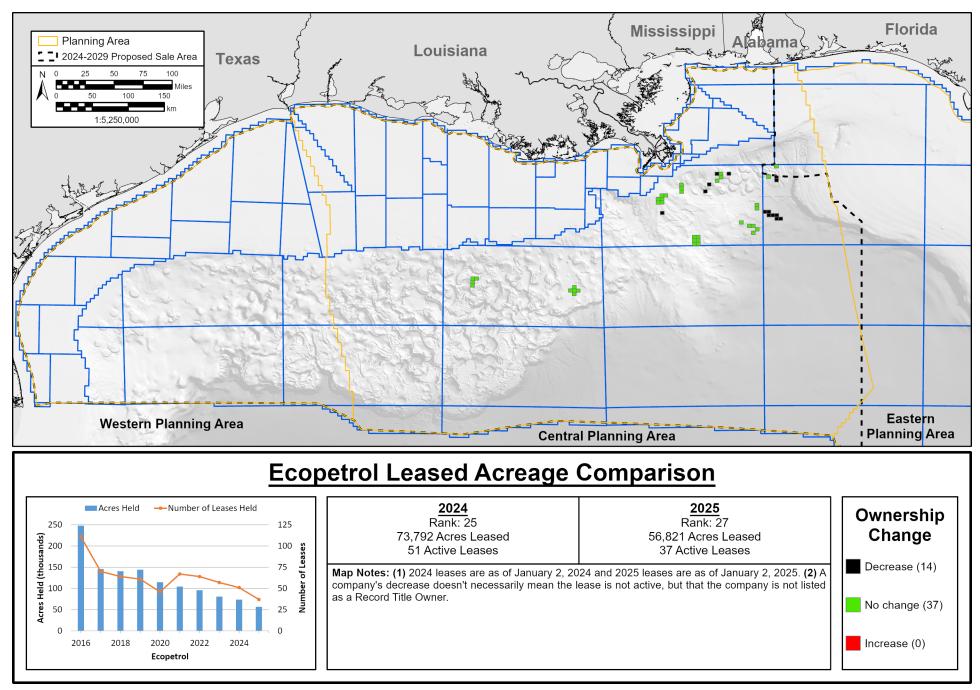


Figure 75. Comparison of Ecopetrol's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

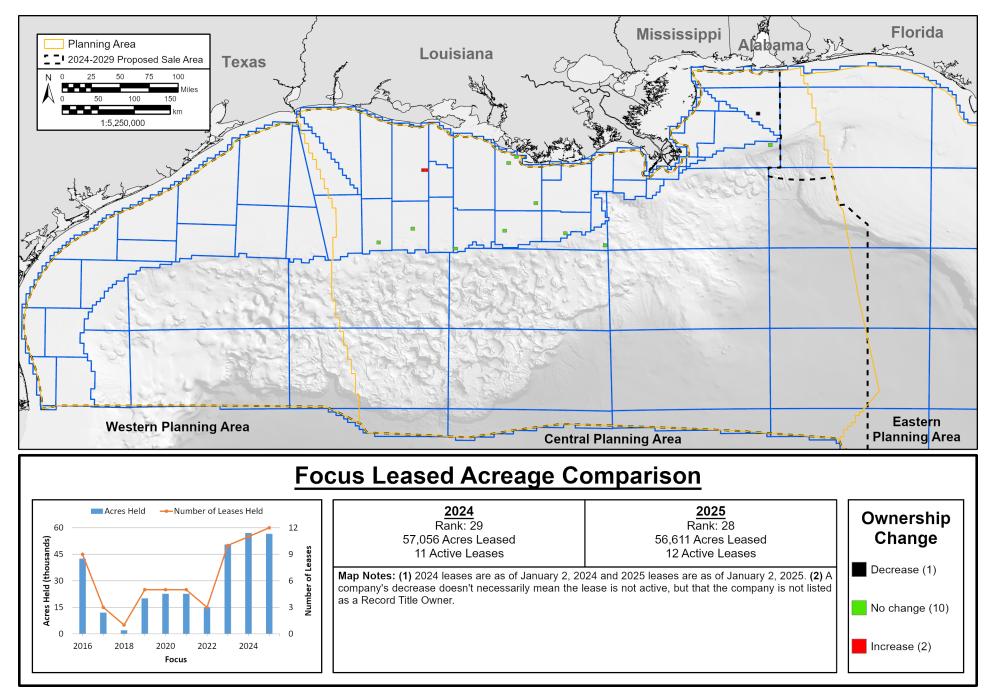


Figure 76. Comparison of Focus' leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

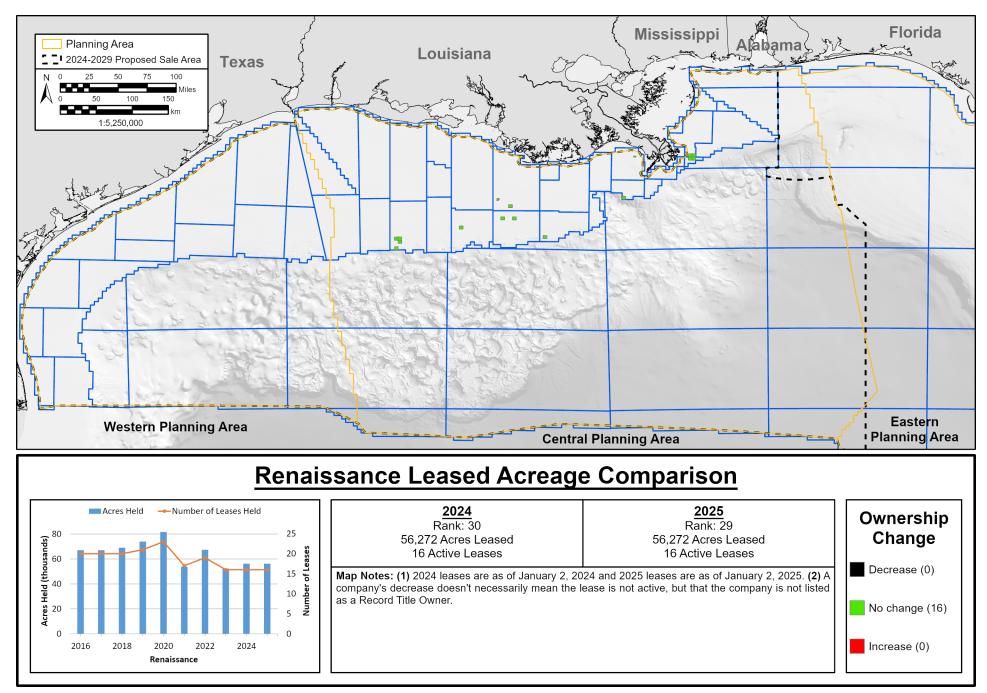


Figure 77. Comparison of Renaissance's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

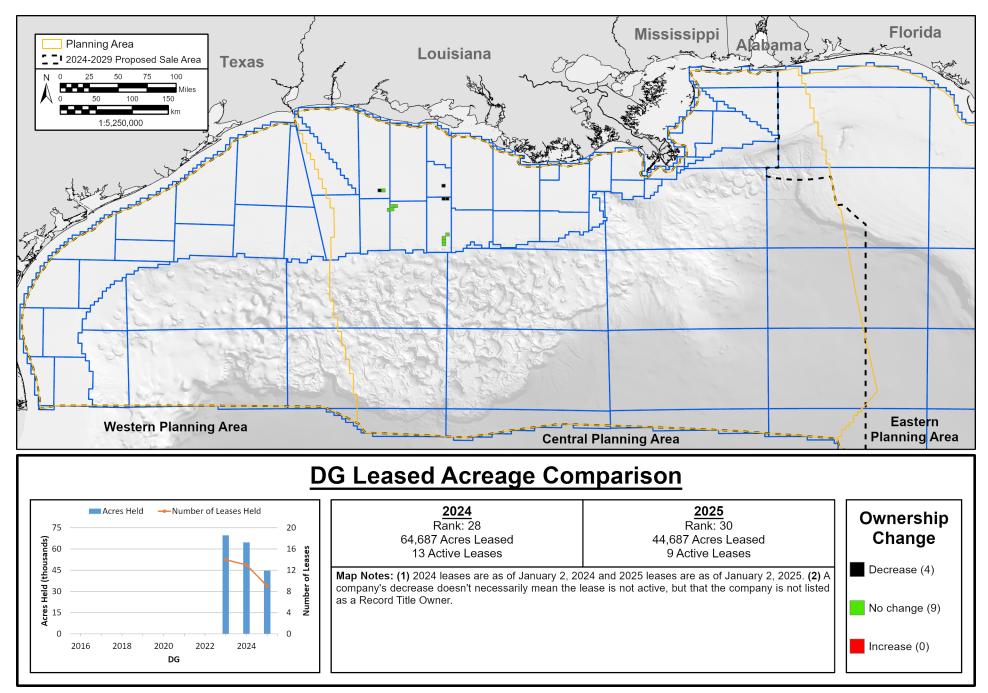


Figure 78. Comparison of DG's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

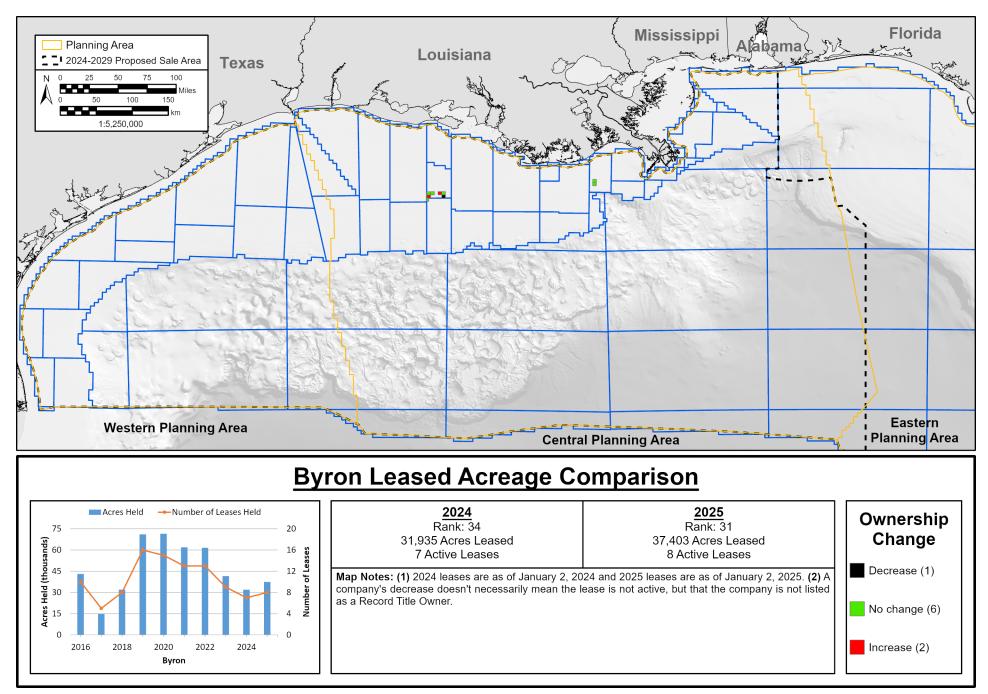


Figure 79. Comparison of Byron's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

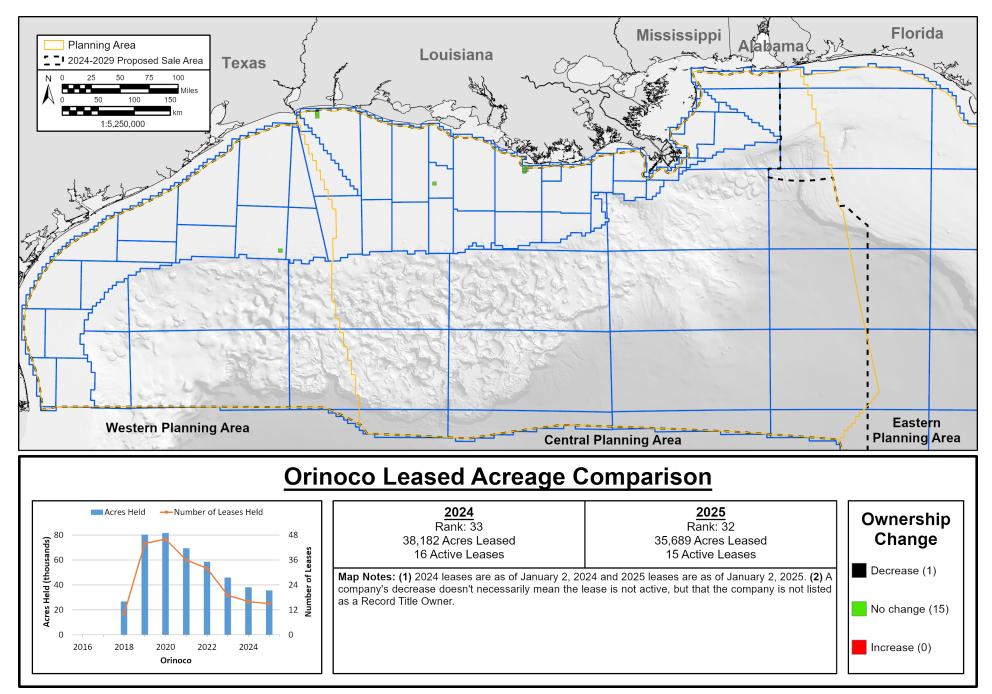


Figure 80. Comparison of Orinoco's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

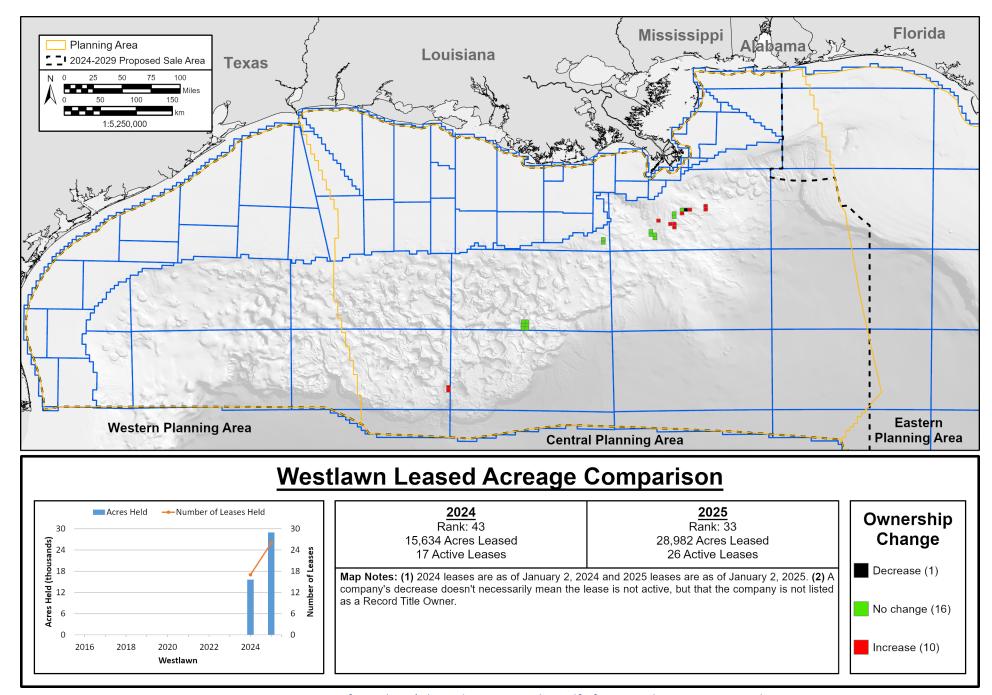


Figure 81. Comparison of Westlawn's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

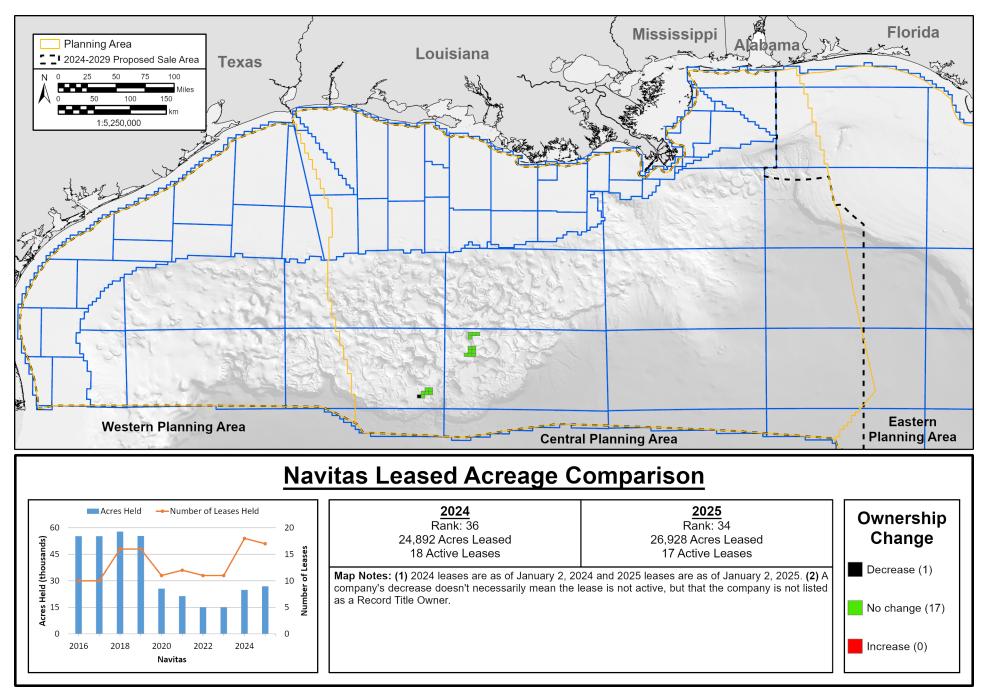


Figure 82. Comparison of Navitas' leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

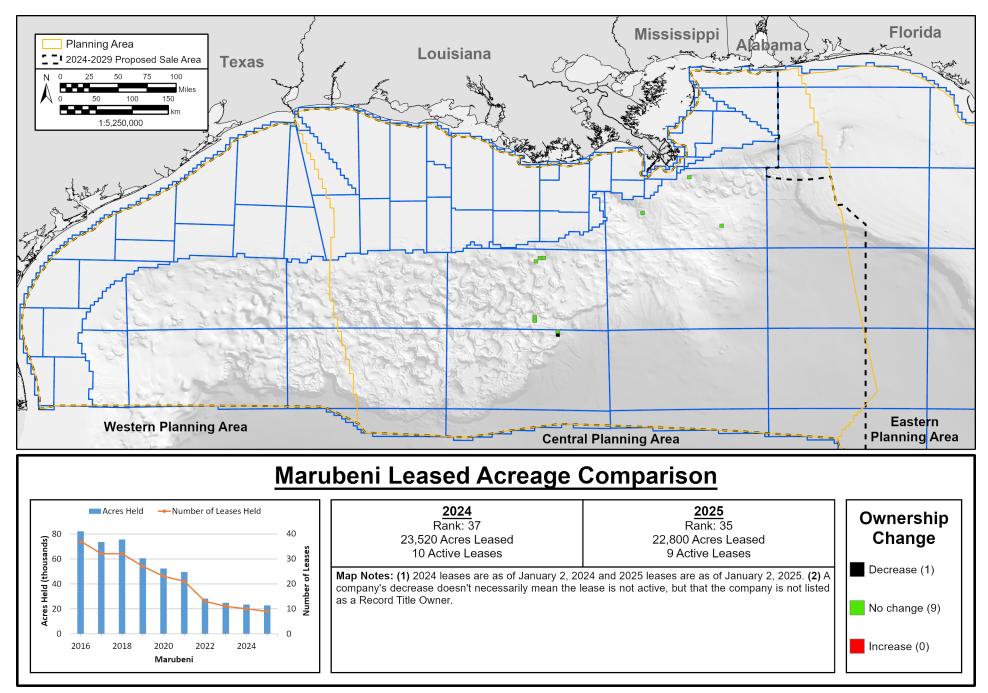


Figure 83. Comparison of Marubeni's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

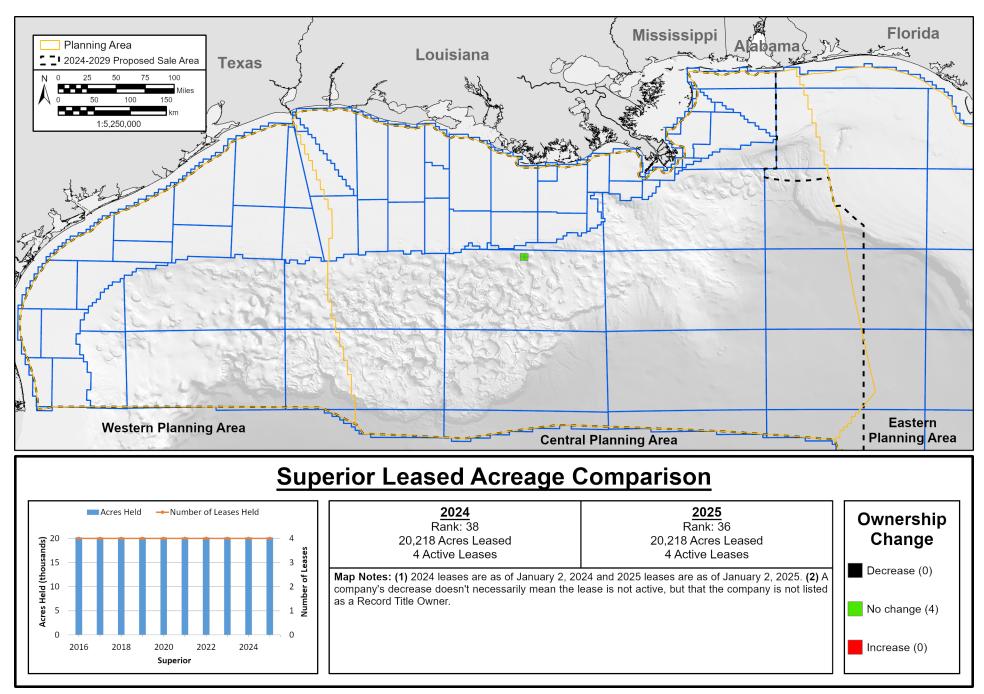


Figure 84. Comparison of Superior's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

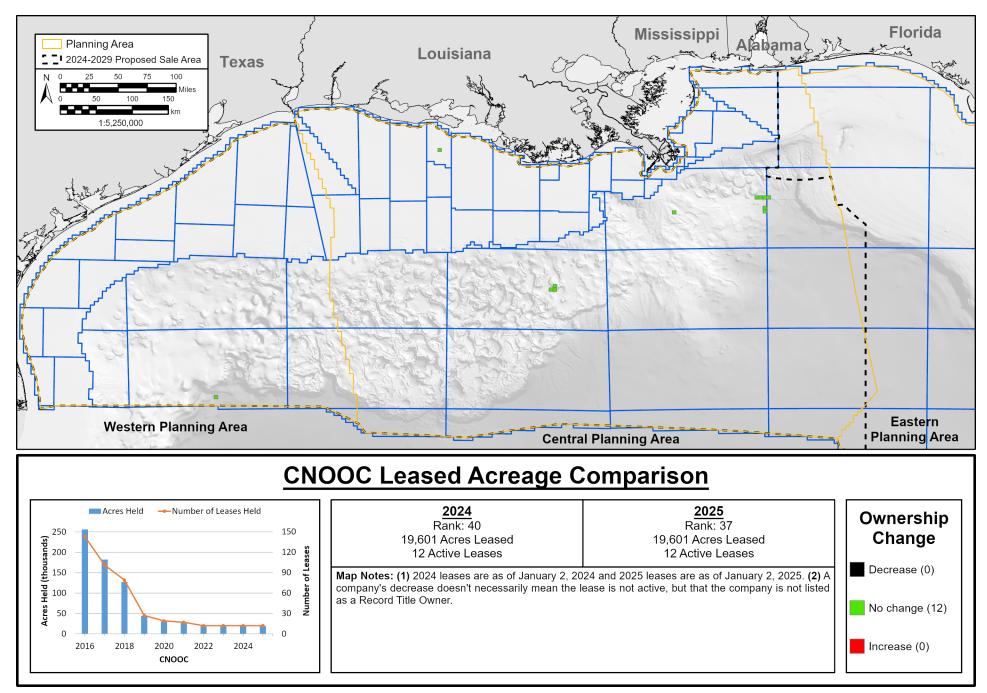


Figure 85. Comparison of CNOOC's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

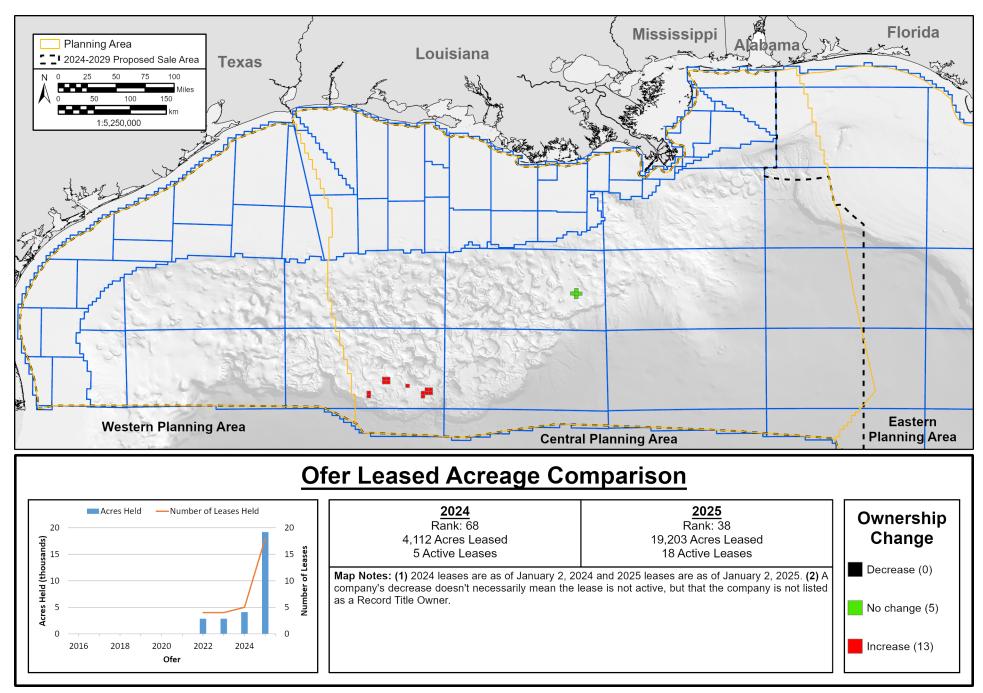


Figure 86. Comparison of Ofer's leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

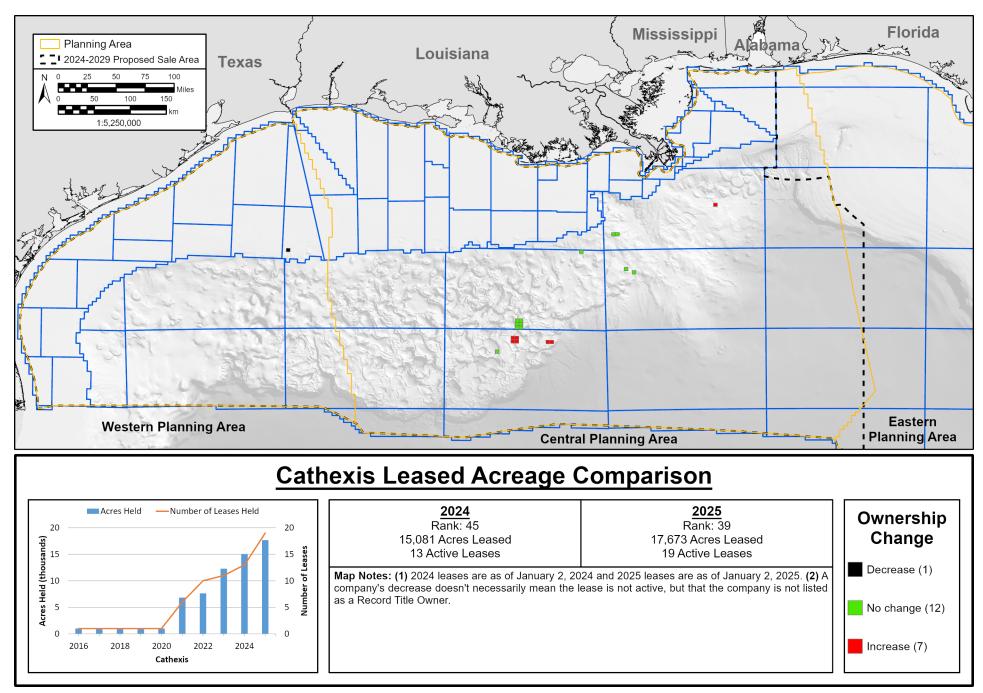


Figure 87. Comparison of Cathexis' leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.

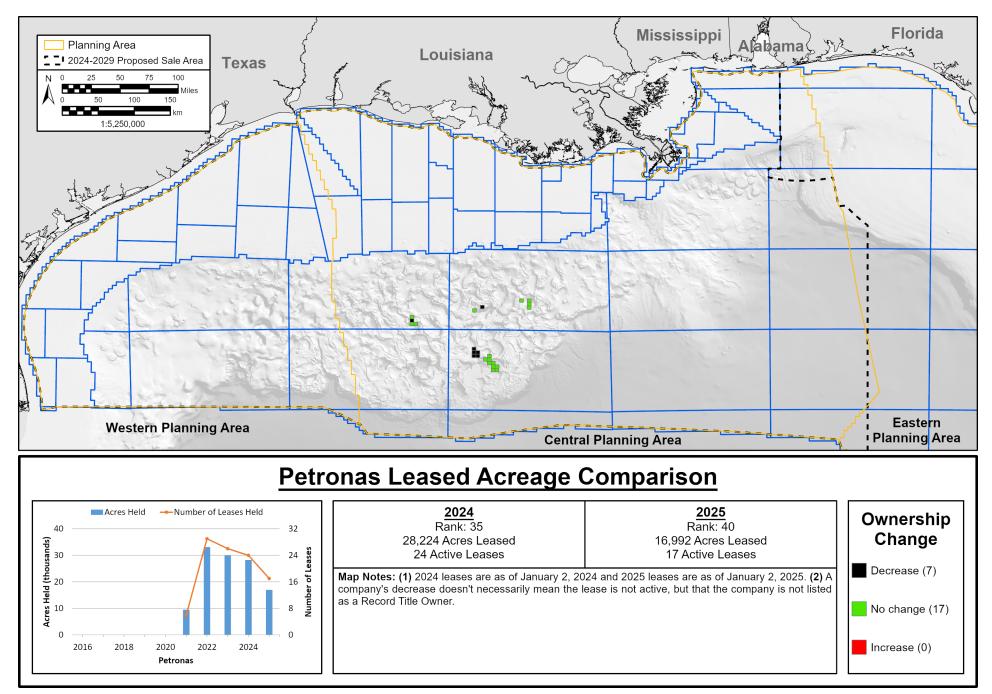


Figure 88. Comparison of Petronas' leased acreage in the Gulf of America between 2024 and 2025.
