

Leading Light Wind has been awarded an offshore wind lease in the New York Bight through the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management leasing process. Led by experienced, global renewable energy developer Invenergy and co-sponsor, New York-based energyRe, development of the project will advance the clean energy transition across the region. Leading Light Wind is targeted for operation in 2030.

Leading Light Wind brings **equitable economic development** and **job creation** to the region, all while generating and delivering clean energy to meet the nation's ambitious climate goals. The project has the potential to generate 2,000 megawatts or more of clean, renewable energy – a critical step in meeting **New York and New Jersey's clean energy goals** of procuring 9,000 megawatts and 7,500 megawatts of offshore wind energy, respectively.
