

RESOURCES

Something of value; can refer to physical, biological, or human components.

- AIR QUALITY: Condition or health of the ambient atmosphere
- **WATER QUALITY:** Condition or 2 environmental health of water
- **DEEPWATER BENTHIC COMMUNITIES:** 3 Living organisms and their associated environment that occur on the deep sea floor
- **LIVE BOTTOMS:** Living organisms and their associated environment that occur on, within, or near the seafloor
- **COASTAL & ESTUARINE HABITATS:** Living organisms and their associated environment at the land-ocean interface
- FISH AND INVERTEBRATE RESOURCES: Fish, shellfish, and the habitat needed for federally managed fish
- **BIRDS:** Birds that spend at least part of their lives near the ocean
- **SEA TURTLES:** Turtles that spend most of their lives at sea and come to shore only to lay eggs
- **MARINE MAMMALS:** Mammals that 9 spend all or part of their lives in the ocean

10 **COMMERCIAL & RECREATIONAL**

> **FISHERIES:** Industries and individuals that rely on harvesting fish for their livelihood or enjoyment

- 11 **ARCHAEOLOGICAL & CULTURAL RESOURCES:** A district, site, building, structure, or object of cultural or historical significance in the marine or onshore environments
- 12 LAND USE AND COASTAL **INFRASTRUCTURE:** How communities use natural resources and infrastructure in their region
- 13 **ECONOMIC FACTORS:** Factors impacting economics in the region
- 14 SOCIAL FACTORS INCLUDING **ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE:** Historically marginalized, low-income, or minority communities
- **RECREATIONAL RESOURCES:** Leisure 15 activities or visits to places of interest that contribute to the local economy
- 16 **SARGASSUM & ASSOCIATED COMMUNITIES:** Sargassum and the surrounding habitat
- 17 **BEACH MICE:** Protected mice living on dune habitats
