Planned Activities Scenario

How Does BOEM Assess the Impacts of Planned Activities?

- 1. Analyze the Impacts of the No Action Alternative
- 2. Analyze the Impacts of Each Action Alternative
- 3. Analyze the Impacts of Other Reasonable Forseeable Activities
- 4. Analyze the combined Impacts of each Alternative (No Action and Action Alternatives) when Combined with Impacts from Other Reasonably Forseeable Activities

Ongoing and Planned Activities Include:

- Other offshore wind energy development activities;
- Undersea transmission lines, gas pipelines, and other submarine cables (e.g., telecommunications);
- Tidal energy projects;
- Marine minerals use and ocean-dredged material disposal;
- Military use;
- Marine transportation (commercial, recreational, and research-related);
- Fisheries use, management, and monitoring surveys;
- Global climate change;
- Oil and gas activities; and
- Onshore development activities.

The Draft EIS analyzes the impact of the alternatives alone and in context of other reasonably foreseeable ongoing and planned activities.
