New York Bight Call Area


OASD (Sustainment)

- DoD provided an analysis of the area in December 2020.
- Air Force found compatibility issues for weather radar. Requested that turbines in Hudson South remain below 1,000 feet in total
- North American Aerospace Defense Command (NORAD) requested mitigation efforts for national security long-range-radar
- Dept. of the Navy provided a detailed assessment for the four Call Areas:
 - Fairways North: no areas deemed incompatible
 - Fairways South: no areas deemed incompatible
 - Hudson North: no areas deemed incompatible
 - Hudson South: 37% would be hazardous to military operations




