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Impacts of Recent Hurricane Activity on Historic Shipwrecks in the Gulf of Mexico Outer Continental Shelf

The Bureau of Ocean Energy Management (BOEM), Gulf of Mexico OCS Region, announces the availability of a new study report, *Impacts of Recent Hurricane Activity on Historic Shipwrecks in the Gulf of Mexico Outer Continental Shelf*.

This report presents the findings of a study that was conducted to assess the impacts from Hurricanes Katrina and Rita on known historic shipwrecks in the Gulf of Mexico. Ten sites were selected for investigation based on their proximity to the hurricane paths and on the availability of pre-storm archaeological data.
