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Interior Department Sets Offshore Energy Leasing Schedule Under One Big Beautiful Bill Act 08/19/2025

WASHINGTON — The Department of the Interior is rolling out a long-term schedule for offshore oil and gas lease sales in the Gulf of America and Alaska’s Cook Inlet, as directed by the One Big Beautiful Bill Act (H.R. 1). By committing to a predictable sale schedule, the Department is delivering on President Trump’s promise to expand American energy production and strengthen U.S. energy independence.

“The One Big Beautiful Bill Act is a landmark step toward unleashing America’s energy potential,” said Interior Secretary Doug Burgum. “Under President Trump’s leadership, we’re putting in place a bold, long-term program that strengthens American Energy Dominance, creates good-paying jobs and ensures we continue to responsibly develop our offshore resources.”

The inclusion of at least 30 lease sales in the Gulf of America underscores the region’s indispensable role in America’s energy ecosystem, accounting for roughly 14–15% of U.S. crude oil production and serving as the linchpin of offshore energy output. These scheduled sales offer the oil and gas sector much-needed clarity and stability, encouraging continued investment in deepwater infrastructure, which is foundational to national energy resilience. The Gulf supports hundreds of thousands of jobs, contributes tens of billions to GDP annually and generates substantial federal and state revenues. The economic and energy-security gains from these sales are both immediate and long-lasting.

INFORMATION TO LESSEES

LEASE EXTENSION REQUESTS: To earn the extension of the initial period, all requests should be submitted from the **Lessee** and not the **Operator**. Please refer the Lease Addendum attached with the subject lease documents. The request should be submitted as soon as practicable, but in no case more than 30 days after spudding a well. The BOEM New Orleans Regional Supervisor for Leasing and Plans will confirm in writing, within 30 days of receiving the **Lessee's** letter, whether the **Lessee** has earned the extension of the initial period and update BOEM records accordingly. The extension of the initial period is not effective unless and until the **Lessee** receives confirmation from BOEM.

Leasing and Plans Important Notice

To process filings as expeditiously as possible, you should submit all documents to the Office of Leasing and Plans (OLP) via email whenever possible.

OLP staff will be available to assist you through email or Microsoft Teams calls. You may submit filings to the sections in OLP as follows:

Adjudication Section – Filings must be submitted either via postal mail, courier service or electronic mail. In-person, hand filings will not be accepted. Electronic submissions must be in PDF format and emailed to the Adjudication Section mailbox at boemadjudication@boem.gov. All questions related to actions processed by the Adjudication Section should also be directed to the Adjudication mailbox.

Leasing and Financial Responsibility Section (LFRS) –

Financial Assurance – All filings must be submitted via postal mail, courier service or electronic mail. Electronic submissions must be in PDF format and emailed to the financial assurance mailbox at boemgulffinancialassurance@boem.gov. All questions related to the actions processed by financial assurance should also be directed to this mailbox.

Oil Spill Financial Responsibility (OSFR) – All filings must be submitted via postal mail, courier service or electronic mail. Electronic submissions must be in PDF format and emailed to the OSFR mailbox at boemosfr@boem.gov. All questions related to the actions processed by OSFR should also be directed to this mailbox.

Lease Sale Coordination – Questions regarding lease sale coordination (e.g., signed bid receipts for mailed in bids), or if you have questions about Notice of Sale packages, please reach out via electronic mail to boemgulfleasesales@boem.gov. Lease sale bids are not accepted by email and should be submitted in accordance with the instructions in the appropriate Final Notice of Sale.

Plans Section – Filings of Exploration Plans, Development Operations Coordination Documents, Development and Production Plans, Surveys and applications for Rights-of-Use and Easement must be submitted via postal mail, courier service or electronic mail. Electronic submissions must be in PDF format and emailed to boemgulffplans@boem.gov. All questions related to the actions processed by the Plans Section should also be directed to this mailbox.
