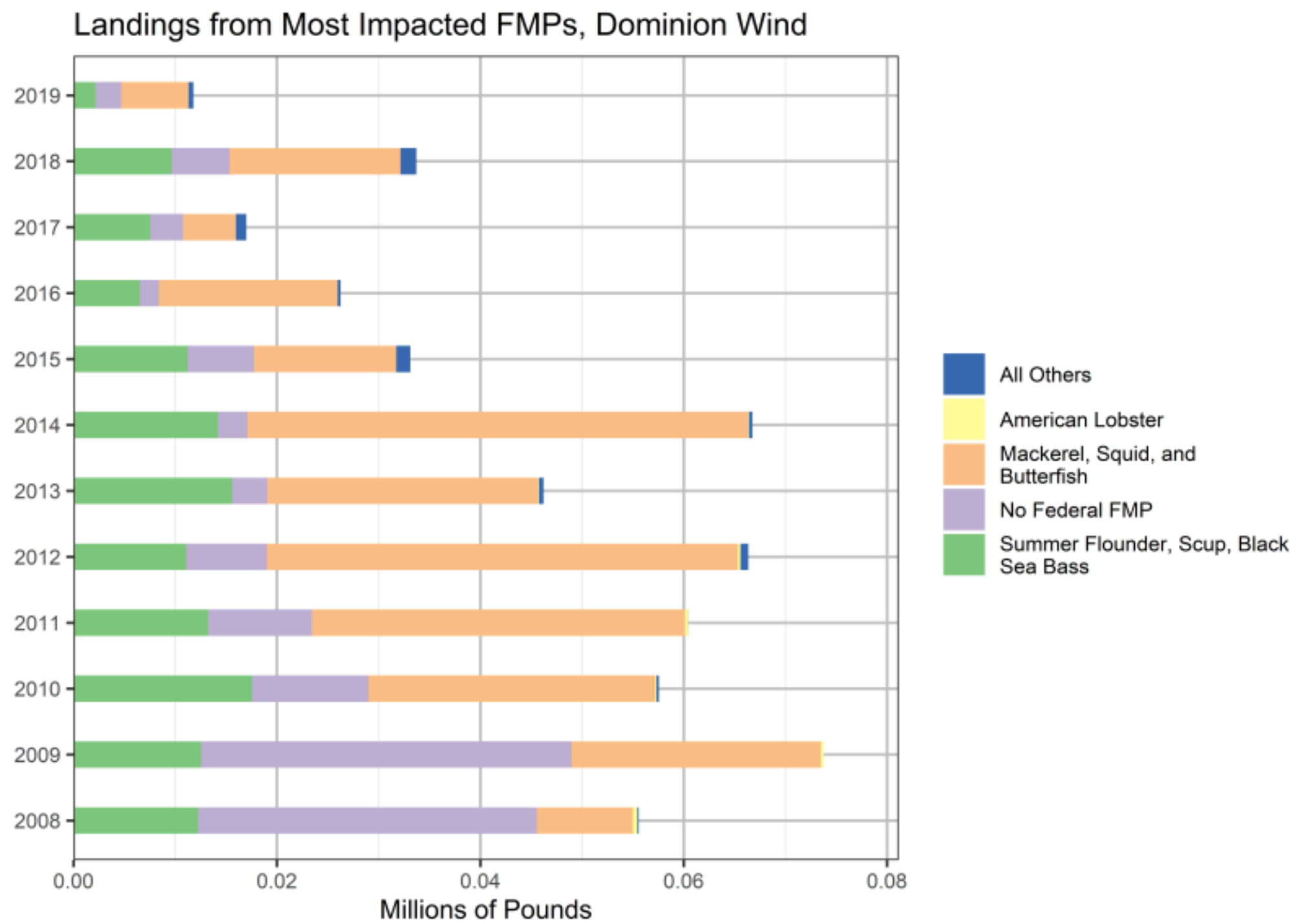

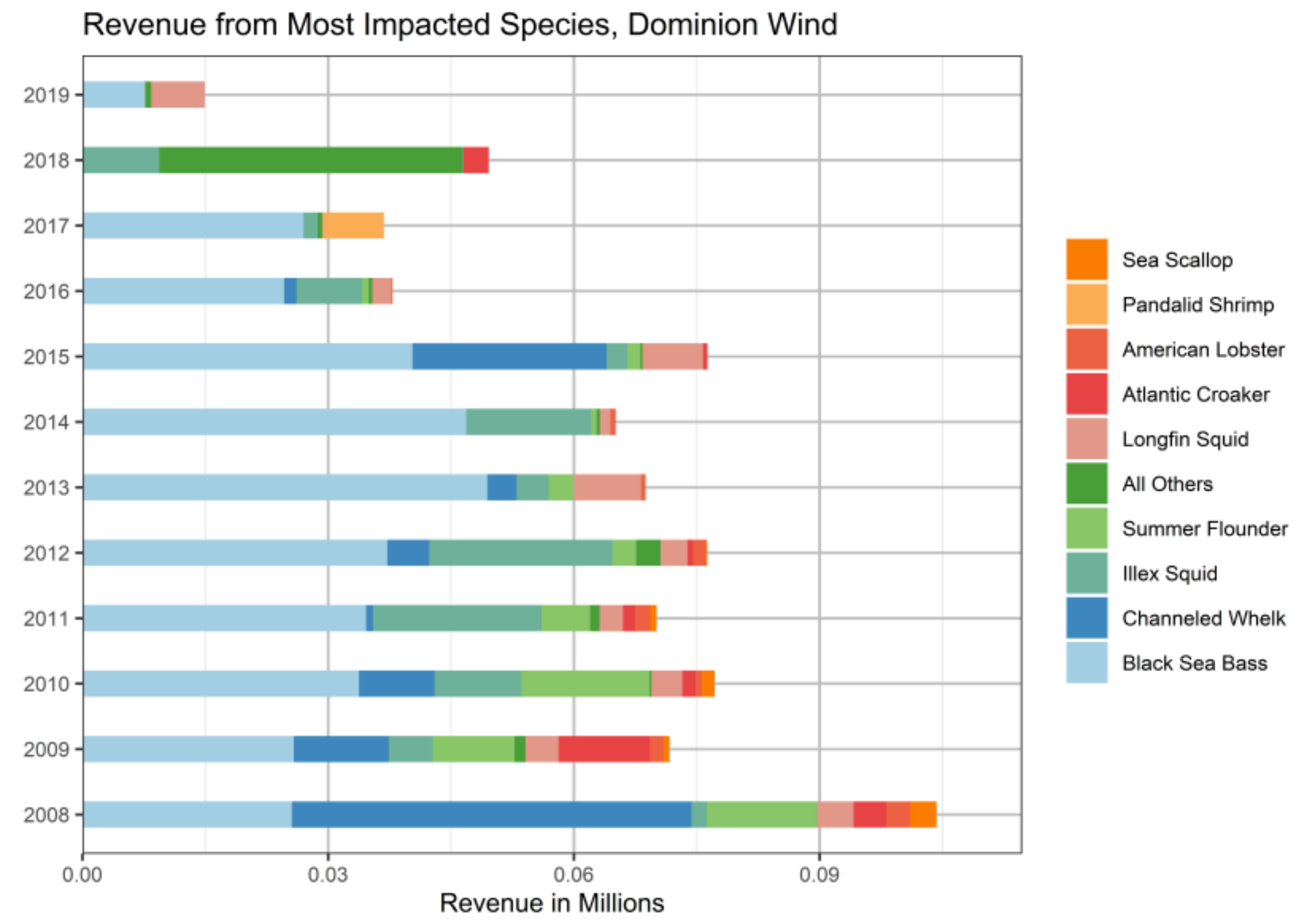
Fishery Landings, Revenue from Ports and Impacted Species

Revenue by Port

The ten most impacted ports (by revenue) are listed in the table. These ports are estimated to receive the most landings from fishing done within the CVOW-C Project Area. The table displays each port's landings breakdown by area and present the cumulative revenue from 2008 to 2019. All numbers have been rounded to the nearest thousand.
