





Massachusetts Request for Interest (RFI) Area











Environmental Assessment

- Notice of Availability of an Environmental Assessment for Potential Commercial Wind Lease Issuance and Site Assessment Activities on the Atlantic OCS offshore MA published on November 2, 2012
- Public information meetings in Boston, New Bedford, Vineyard Haven, Nantucket November 13-15, 2012
- 30-day comment period ended December 3,
 2012









Environmental Assessment Comments

- A total of 25 public comments were submitted
- Commenters included private citizens, Federal and State agencies, NGOs, and other stakeholders.
- The majority of the comments focused on marine resources, endangered species, support and opposition, the standard operating conditions, wind energy, and the general process.

Environmental Assessment Next Steps

Based on the nature and extent of comments received, we may:

- Publish a Finding No Significant Impacts (FONSI);
- Revise the EA; or
- Determine that an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is required.

- NREL Draft Assessment Report June 13, 2013
 - BOEM will circulate to Task Force membership for review
- NREL Final Assessment Report July 20, 2013
- NREL Presentation of the Final Assessment Report to the Task Force
- BOEM will consider the Lease Areas delineated by NREL for the draft Proposed Sale Notice

Next Steps

- Next Task Force Meeting to discuss draft
 Proposed Sale Notice TBD (July 2013)
- Proposed Sale Notice
 - Proposed auction details and lease terms and provisions
 - Publish in the Federal Register for a 60-day comment period
- Final Sale Notice
 - Final auction details and lease terms and provisions
 - At least 30 days prior to the auction
