Little Brutus



Tugs being normally classified by horsepower first then number of engines then length, reduction gearing ratio, and wheel size (propeller diameter). The Little Brutus is a twin-screw 1,000-hp model bow tug, 42 feet long, with 4.5 to 1 reduction through 42” propellers. Cape Henry Launch currently uses this vessel for push boat work, hawser handling and the docking/undocking of ships up to 300 ft long. The Little Brutus is USCG inspected and maintained under requirements for “Towing Vessels” rules 46 CFR.

The Little Brutus underwent a year-long extensive refit finishing up in September of 2012. All running gear and engines were reworked. Extensive replating and reframing were completed allowing for a very solid tug. All piping, wiring, lighting and instrumentation was renewed as well.
