(BPXA) is herein submitting modified information for the Liberty Development Project Development and Production Plan (DPP) in accordance with Minerals Management Service (MMS) request dated September 7, 2007. The request was for the submission of additional information on the Sagavanirtoq (Sag) River Bridge, the Liberty mine site and the ice roads and ice aggregate usage during winter construction.

Enclosed you will find the following information to satisfy the additional information request for the Sag River Bridge upgrade and Liberty mine site:

- Attachment A - Mining and Rehabilitation Plan, Liberty Gravel Mine Site dated August 2007 with accompanying figures (Figures 1 - 6). Attachment A replaces in its entirety the April 2007 DPP ATTACHMENT D;
- Attachment B - Sagavanirtoq River Bridge Upgrade figures (Figures 9-2 through 9-4). Attachment B replaces DPP Figures 9-2 through 9-4;
- Attachment C - Design Basis and Preliminary Construction Plan. This document is being provided for further clarification.


Ice aggregate may be used in conjunction with fresh water to build ice roads. Potential sources for harvesting ice aggregate to be used for ice road construction will be determined once the construction contractor has been selected; bathymetric results are reviewed with the construction contractor; and an optimum ice road route has been

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selected. BPXA intends to notify the Alaska Department of Natural Resources/Office of Habitat Management and Permitting (OHMP) prior to ice road construction with details regarding the optimum ice road routing.
