AUTHORITY

- PORTS AND WATERWAYS SAFETY
 ACT (PWSA) P.L. 95-474; 33 U.S.C. 1223
- SECRETARY OF DHS
 - "Designate necessary fairways and traffic separation schemes" to "provide safe access routes ... to and from ports or other places... United States."
 - Delegated to the Coast Guard
 - Port Access Study (PARS)



PARS REQUIREMENTS

- REQUIRED WHEN WE CONSIDER
 NECESSITY FOR FAIRWAYS OR
 TRAFFIC SEPARATION SCHEME(S)
- OPTIONAL FOR OTHER ROUTING MEASURES
 - RECOMMENDED ROUTES
 - ANCHORAGE/NO ANCHORAGE AREA
 - ATBA





OBJECTIVES

- DEFINE NEED
- TRAFFIC DENSITY (Present and future)
- FORM/TYPE OF MEASURE
- EXISTING MEASURE: STILL NEEDED?
- MANDATORY USE FOR CERTAIN CLASSES OF VESSELS





STUDY ITSELF

- IDENTIFY STUDY AREA
- NOTICE OF STUDY IN FED REG
 - GEOGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION OF AREA
 - EXPLANATION OF POSSIBLE ACTIONS AND IMPACTS
 - PRESENT ISSUES/QUESTIONS INVITE PUBLIC COMMENT

COLLECT DATA

- VESSEL TRAFFIC CHARACTERISTICS
- FISHING (COMMERCIAL/TRIBAL)
- ACTIVITIES IN AREA (DOD/ACOE)
- OCS RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT
- ENVIRONMENTAL FACTORS
- ECONOMIC IMPACT



- CONSULTATIONS
 - VARIOUS FED AND STATE AGENCIES
 - MARITIME COMMUNITY
 - PORT AND HARBOR AUTH/ASSOC
 - LOCAL CITIZEN GROUPS
- ANALYZE DATA
- RECOMMENDATIONS
- RULEMAKING AND/OR IMO PROCESSES

 - CGHQ (CG-541) DEVELOPS IMO NOTE
 - BACKGROUND/JUSTIFICATION FOR MEASURE
 - ANNEX(ES) TO BE INCLUDED IN SHIPS' ROUTEING GUIDE
 - CHARTLET(S)





IMO PROPOSAL

- INTERAGENCY REVIEW/MEETING(S)
 TO APPROVE NOTE
- NOTE SENT TO NAV FOR TRANSLATION - DISTRIBUTION
- NAV MEETS AND APPROVES NOTE
- NAV FORWARDS TO MSC FOR ADOPTION





IMO PROPOSAL

- MSC ADOPTS NOTE
- MSC SETS IMPLEMENTATION DATE
- ROUTING MEASURE IMPLEMENTED

CG ROLE FOR OREI'S

- Cooperating agency for National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) purposes with the LPA
 - ✓ Develop RECOMMENDED terms and conditions to provide for safety of navigation
 - ✓ Minimize potential impacts on other CG missions (SAR, Marine Safety, Maritime Security, Maritime Mobility, Protection of Natural Resources, National Defense)
- WILL NOT APPROVE/DISAPPROVE PROJECT OR ISSUE PERMIT

- Mitigation Measures








SITE LOCATION

 - Proximity








STRUCTURE
